



Information Guide to choose a Sponsor for Confirmation

All Sponsors are to be in "good standing" with the Catholic Church.

Sponsors for Confirmation Candidates Must:

- Be in "Good Standing" in the Church living a life in harmony with the faith (receiving Communion and reconciliation regularly)
- Be attending Holy Mass every weekend and days of obligation.
- Be baptized, received Communion, and be Confirmed
- If married, must be married in the Catholic Church. Cannot be living with a partner.
 - If married, must turn in application with copy of marriage certificate
- Accompany the child through the whole process of preparation of the Sacraments (attend Parent/Sponsor Sacrament classes, and assist in candidate's service project, and have an active role in the candidate's faith development.)
- Not be a father or mother of the candidate
- A witness to the faith
- Guide to parish life
- A witness to the discernment of readiness of the candidate to receive the sacrament of confirmation
- Model of Christian living
