



THE RICHNESS OF LIFE IN CHRIST

Today we have the beautiful story of the woman promised a child, the wonderful exhortation about life in Christ, and a powerful instruction from Jesus. An embarrassment of riches? Not if we take Jesus' words about "welcome" to heart. The many challenges and blessings offered to us today by Elisha, Paul, and Jesus should be cause for rejoicing, and welcomed heartily into our lives. And, like the great treat that they are, they should be enjoyed and shared generously with others.

Today's reading from Romans was chosen very early in the liturgical life of the Church to be the sole apostolic instruction received by candidates for baptism at the Easter Vigil. This illustrates its importance as a core belief, and as a means of comprehending the story of the Resurrection. Christ's resurrection is not merely a story about something that he underwent once upon a time, but it is our story, the story of how we joined the other members of the one Body of Christ, the church. We were not only dead, but we were buried; not ultimately buried, but raised to eternal life with Christ.

LA RIQUEZA DE LA VIDA EN CRISTO

Hoy tenemos la preciosa historia de la mujer a quien se le promete un hijo, una maravillosa exhortación a la vida en Cristo y una poderosa enseñanza de Jesus. ¿Demasiadas riquezas en una sola dosis? No, si tomamos las palabras de Jesus sobre "Ser acogedores" de corazón. Los muchos retos y bendiciones que hoy nos ofrecen Eliseo, Pablo, y Jesus deben ser causa de regocijo, y debemos acogerlos de corazón en nuestras vidas. Y, como el gran regalo que son, deben ser disfrutados y compartidos generosamente con los demás. La lectura de hoy tomada de la carta a los romanos fue seleccionada en los comienzos de la vida litúrgica de la Iglesia como instrucción apostólica que debían recibir los candidatos al bautismo durante la Vigilia de Pascua. Esto da una idea de su importancia como creencia central, y como medio para entender la historia de la resurrección. La resurrección de Cristo no es solamente la historia de algo por lo que el paso una vez hace tiempo, sino que es nuestra historia, la historia de cómo nos unimos a los otros miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia. No solo estábamos muertos, sino resucitados a la vida eterna en Cristo.

The Land of the Free. Few things are more identifiable with America than freedom. "It's a free country," is an expression that both locals and internationals could recognize as being distinctively American.

Significantly, Saint Paul recognizes freedom as being constitutive as to why Jesus introduces his redemption into the world. "It is for freedom that Christ has set us free," he writes in his letter to the Galatians.

If freedom is so important, both to Americans and to Christians, what is it we're free from?

For Americans what we were reacting against was tyranny: oppression wielded by a human party which diminished or destroyed our capacity to live as humans.

For Christians, we also are freed from tyranny, but we see this oppression coming from a different source, from a malignant spiritual presence which seeks to destroy our capacity to live as humans in the image of our Creator. The experience of this oppression often springs up from within us, as we find ourselves battling tendencies and compulsions that bend us away from our potential. Saint Paul again is the one who laments, "For I do not do what I want, but I do what I hate."

Unfortunately, both as Americans and as Christians, it could be diagnosed that we have lost sight of the presence and source of tyranny, and so run the risk of losing our freedom as well. As Americans, if we see tyranny as coming from an ermine robed monarch across the Atlantic, or even as coming solely from governmental figures, we can be completely vulnerable to domineering forces emerging from society, commercialism or media. As Christians, if with our secular peers we forget about the existence of the one Jesus called the Prince of this World, we can be completely vulnerable to manipulation from a preternatural intelligence only too happy to exploit our illusion.

As we celebrate Independence Day this week, we can remember how Saint Paul finished his announcement of freedom: "For freedom Christ set us free; so stand firm and do not submit again to the yoke of slavery." Stand firm: maintaining independence, living in the authentic freedom Christ has won for us, requires our dedicated effort. As participants in American society today, we can witness to both the struggle for and the value of freedom.



El país de la libertad. Pocas cosas son más identificables con América que con la libertad. "Es un país libre", es una expresión que tanto los de aquí como los de otros países distintivamente pueden reconocer como estadounidense.

Significativamente, San Pablo reconoce la libertad como fundamental al por qué Jesús introdujo su redención al mundo. "Cristo nos ha liberado para que seamos libres", escribe en su carta a los Gálatas.

Si la libertad es tan importante, tanto para los estadounidenses como para los cristianos, ¿de qué estamos libres?

Los estadounidenses reaccionábamos en contra de la tiranía: la opresión ejercida por un partido humano que disminuyó o destruyó nuestra capacidad de vivir como seres humanos.

Para los cristianos, también fuimos liberados de la tiranía, pero vemos esta opresión procedente de una fuente diferente, de una presencia espiritual maligna que busca destruir nuestra capacidad de vivir como seres humanos a imagen de nuestro Creador. La experiencia de esta opresión brota seguido desde el fondo de nuestro corazón, ya que nos encontramos luchando contra tendencias y compulsiones que nos alejan de nuestro potencial. San Pablo es de nuevo el que se lamenta: "Porque no hago lo que quiero, sino que hago lo que odio".

Por desgracia, tanto estadounidenses como cristianos, se podría diagnosticar que hemos perdido de vista la presencia y la fuente de la tiranía, y corremos el riesgo de perder nuestra libertad también. Como estadounidenses, si vemos que la tiranía proviene de un monarca vestido con armiño a través del Atlántico, o incluso como proveniente únicamente de figuras gubernamentales, podemos ser completamente vulnerables a las fuerzas dominantes queemanan de la sociedad, el mercantilismo o los medios de comunicación. Como cristianos, si con nuestros compañeros seculares nos olvidamos de la existencia del Jesús llamado Príncipe de este mundo, podemos ser completamente vulnerables a la manipulación de una inteligencia sobrenatural que es feliz solo destruyendo nuestra ilusión.

Cuando celebremos el Día de la Independencia esta semana, recordemos cómo San Pablo terminó su declaración sobre la libertad: " Para ser libres nos libró Cristo. Manteneos, pues, firmes y no os dejéis oprimir nuevamente bajo el yugo de la esclavitud". Mantenerse firme: mantener la independencia, vivir en la auténtica libertad que Cristo ha ganado para nosotros, requiere de nuestro esfuerzo y dedicación. Como participantes en la sociedad estadounidense de hoy, podemos ser testigos tanto de la lucha como el valor de la libertad.




