





There was a while, I think it was in the '90's, when airlines would charge you for headphones, and make the jacks in the seat armrest incompatible with any headphone cable except theirs.

As a passenger, if you didn't want to fork over the \$2 or \$5 they were demanding, you were left watching without sound the lively film they were screening with no way to quite follow what was happening.

We've come a long ways with portable electronics and inflight movies, so it's rare today that you're stranded 35,000 feet up without entertainment. That feeling isn't too hard to recall, however, the dissociation that comes from not being able to follow the story.

"Whoever has ears ought to hear," Jesus tells us today. He recognizes clearly that there is a high risk that we could be looking dumbly on, without realizing what is happening before our eyes. Jesus assumes it's more likely than not that we won't catch what's being offered us--his summary is pretty pessimistic: "Gross is the heart of this people, they will hardly hear with their ears, they have closed their eyes, lest they see with their eyes and hear with their ears."

A primary contrast, however, between Jesus' assessment and passengers' experience of film deprivation in the unfriendly skies, is that often the reason we miss the main feature, the message that could change our life, is because we're distracted with some other entertainment we've been caught by. The confined traveler would desperately like to be included in the story they're obviously missing, but Jesus is dealing with folks who don't even notice what they've lost.

Maybe the main thing to learn from Jesus today is how important it is to want to be in, to hear, to discover. If, like the sky high trekker, we clearly knew what we were missing, we could attune ourselves, eagerly seek to receive what our Creator is sharing with us to change our lives.

If, however, you and I continue on as we always have, content to be caught up with the small stuff, engrossed with what's in front of our noses, as Jesus saw, we'll never understand, we'll never be converted, and we'll never be healed.

Jesus nos dice hoy "El que tenga oídos, que oiga", el reconoce claramente que hay un alto riesgo de que podamos estar mirando tranquilamente, sin darnos cuenta de lo que sucede a nuestro alrededor. Jesús asume que es más probable que no captemos lo que se nos ofrece - su resumen es bastante pesimista: "porque el corazón de este pueblo se ha vuelto insensible y con dificultad oyen con sus oídos; y han cerrado sus ojos; de otro modo, verían con los ojos y oirían con los oídos."

Sin embargo, un contraste principal entre la evaluación de Jesús y la experiencia de los pasajeros de la privación de la película en las alturas hostiles es que a menudo la razón por la que perdemos la característica principal, el mensaje que podría cambiar nuestra vida, es porque estamos distraídos con otros entretenimientos. El viajero confinado quisiera desesperadamente ser incluido en la historia que está obviamente se está perdiendo, pero Jesús está tratando con gente que no se ha dado cuenta de lo qué han perdido.

Tal vez lo principal para aprender de Jesús hoy es lo importante que es querer estar, oír, descubrir. Si, al igual que cuando estábamos en las alturas, claramente sabíamos lo que estábamos perdiendo, podríamos sintonizar nosotros mismos, ansiosamente buscan recibir lo que nuestro Creador está compartiendo con nosotros para cambiar nuestras vidas.

Sin embargo, si tú y yo no cambiamos, y continuamos siendo igual sin ver lo que tenemos delante de nuestras narices, como Jesús vio, nunca entenderemos, nunca seremos convertidos, Y nunca seremos sanados.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Two centuries ago, Archbishop John Carroll worried that Americans would not appreciate the linguistic veil over our worship, and asked that the liturgy in the new United States be in English, not Latin. How did our liturgy come to be in Latin in the first place? In the first century, the dominant language in the regions where the church first flourished was Greek. Today in much of the world, almost everyone speaks at least a bit of English. Recently, the European Union even considered making English its official language, a curious proposal since only two English-speaking countries are members.

Just as English is a unifying language today, it was hard to function in the ancient world without a smattering of Greek. Even the word "Eucharist" comes from the Greek for "thanksgiving." For a long time, Greek was the language of worship, even in Rome. Slowly, society in the west shifted to a bias for Latin and against Greek. Latin first appeared in public prayer at the end of the second century, in the colonial outposts of North Africa. Soon, Latin became the language of culture, and so as fixed prayer forms were written, they were transmitted in Latin. From Rome and Africa, over the next four centuries, the new liturgical language of Latin spread north to Gaul and Britain.


