

A third week with parables!

Jesus continues his attempt to sneak into our hearts by using a different way of teaching: a parable, by creating a mental image, invites us into a new understanding. As a deeper part of our souls resonates with his images, it can break down the barriers we have to change.

As with last Sunday, each of his three parables this week give us a glimpse into the Kingdom of Heaven. Jesus is attempting to pull us into the awareness that something extraordinarily valuable is present, something priceless is at stake.

As with last week, his parables warn us that the consequences of missing the call are grim. Last week in his parable of the wheat and the weeds, he described how the weeds are gathered to be burned. Today again, in the parable of the net thrown into the sea, he describes how what is bad is thrown away: "Thus it will be at the end of the age. The angels will go out and separate the wicked from the righteous and throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth."

The Kingdom of Heaven, the mystery he invites us into, transforms our experience today, and redefines our destiny 'at the end of the age.' By grounding us in the eternal now, by allowing the eternal Spirit to enter our hearts today, we experience the same grace that will carry us into eternity. Tragically, and this is the disaster Jesus is attempting to deflect from us, if we collapse inwards today, if we become the gods of our own little worlds, our inability to stretch now will be fatal in eternity.

Jesus invites us to embrace a gift that allows us to let go of everything else. Today, while we still have the opportunity, we can learn to see as Jesus does. Everything is worth losing for this treasure; everything is lost if we lose this treasure.



Tercera semana con paráboas!

Jesús continúa su intento de infiltrarse en nuestros corazones usando una manera diferente de enseñar: una parábola, creando una imagen mental, Jesus nos invita a una nueva comprensión. Mientras que una parte profunda de nuestras almas resuena con sus imágenes, estas pueden romper las barreras que tenemos que cambiar.

Al igual que el domingo pasado, cada una de sus tres parábolas esta semana nos dan una visión del Reino de los Cielos. Jesús quiere que ágamos conciencia y nos demos cuenta de que algo extraordinariamente valioso está presente, algo inestimable está en juego.

Al igual que en la semana pasada, sus parábolas nos advierten que las consecuencias de ignorar el llamado son serias. La semana pasada en su parábola del trigo y las malas hierbas, él describió cómo las malas hierbas se juntan para ser quemadas. Hoy en día, en la parábola de la red lanzada al mar, él describe cómo lo malo es desecharlo: "Lo mismo sucederá al final de los tiempos: vendrán los ángeles, separarán a los malos de los buenos y los arrojarán al horno encendido. Allí será el llanto y la desesperación."

El Reino de los Cielos, el misterio al que nos invita, transforma nuestra experiencia de hoy y redefine nuestro destino «al fin del mundo». Al fundamentarnos en lo eterno ahora, al permitir que el Espíritu eterno entre hoy en nuestros corazones, experimentamos la misma gracia que nos llevará a la eternidad. Trágicamente, y este es el desastre que Jesús está intentando alejar de nosotros, si fracasamos hoy en día, si nos convertimos en los dioses de nuestros pequeños mundos, nuestra incapacidad de ceder ahora será fatal en la eternidad.

Jesús nos invita a abrazarnos de un don que nos permite dejar ir todo lo demás. Hoy, que aún tenemos la oportunidad, podemos aprender a ver como Jesús lo hace. Vale la pena perder todo por este tesoro; Todo está perdido si perdemos este tesoro.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The achievement of the late 1960s and early 1970s in enriching the "euchology" or "words of thanksgiving" available in the Church's prayer is important on many levels. Ecumenically, it means that the Latin Rite now reflects the wealth of the East in having more than one prayer available to the Church. Pastorally, it actually acknowledges the place of the assembly in prayer, which is particularly clear in the Masses with Children. In fact, the traditional prayers of the Eastern Church served as models for our new prayers.

In the East, what we call the Eucharistic Prayer is called the *anaphora*, and there are three main families of *anaphora*. Each family has a different "recipe" for arranging the usual parts of these prayers. All *anaphora* have "intercessions" included, but the Churches of Antioch place them toward the end of the prayer, Alexandria prefers them at the beginning before the "Holy, Holy," and Syria puts them at the very end. One branch of the Syrian family is unique in not mentioning the words of Jesus at the Last Supper. The Roman Canon we once prayed exclusively has some connection with the Alexandrian family, but once the signal for creativity was given, all the wealth of every prayer tradition was on the table, and our Sunday Mass has been greatly enriched.

Esta semana celebramos la fiesta de la Virgen de Copacabana. Copacabana es la capital de Manco Cápac, Bolivia. En dicho lugar, un descendiente de los reyes incas, Francisco Tito Yupanqui buscó esculpir una imagen de la Candelaria. Su primera imagen fue colocada en la iglesia por su párroco, pero llegó un nuevo párroco quien la sacó del templo por tosca y fea. El pobre de Tito viajó a Potosí, Bolivia, donde emprendió cursos de escultura. Con el tiempo esculpió otra imagen de la Candelaria. Esta vez estudió varias imágenes de María y mandó ofrecer una Misa a la Santísima Trinidad pidiéndole la inspiración necesaria para esculpir una imagen digna de la Virgen. Los años de práctica en su arte, unidos a su devoción, le ayudaron a esculpir una imagen fina y bella que en 1583 fue colocada en su propio santuario.

La Virgen de Copacabana tiene uno de los primeros santuarios marianos en América Latina. Curiosamente, se celebra el 5 de agosto, día que María hizo nevar en la antigua ciudad de Roma, Italia, para mostrar dónde deseaba tener su primer templo.
