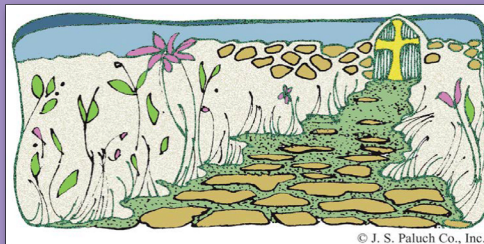

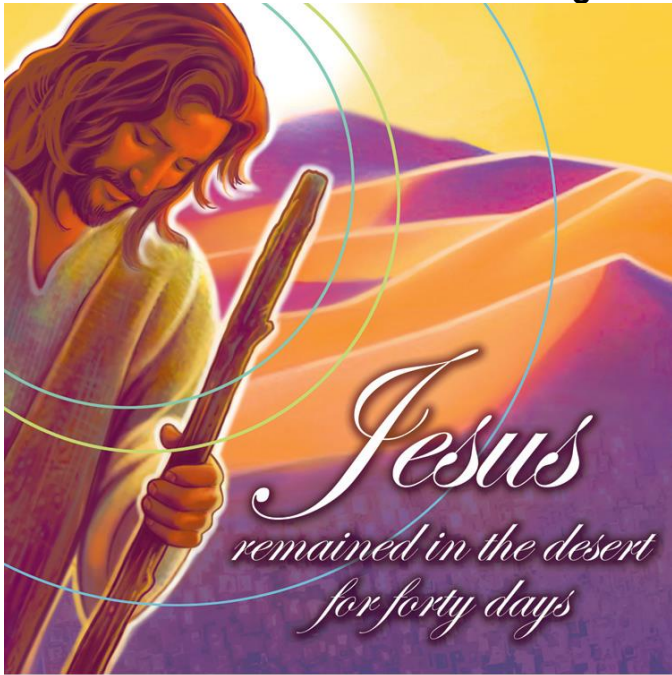

The Pastor's Corner

The First Sunday of Lent!

We enter some of the most valuable days of the year. We have extraordinary potential for change, according to God's message to us. We see this in Jesus' words today at the outset of Mark's Gospel. His call to change is a call to become capable of something much more than we currently are: the Kingdom of God is at hand.

One of the things that most limits our ability to change is our inability to see what comes next: we forget there's an arriving kingdom and think that what we know is all there is. Maybe we don't need to change a whole lot if this is it: we're relatively well adapted for this world and its ways.

But if there's something much more before us, we can stretch to reach our new potential.

We catch a glimpse of this in our second reading, where our first pope describes Jesus' elevation from this world, Christ, "who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers subject to him." This reference to the angels, like we discussed here last week, together with the majestic beings of heaven that we can't even imagine, reminds us there's a world beyond our experience, beyond our current limits.

We have extraordinary potential for change, and we can tap into it in these Lenten days of conversion. Determine your Lenten practice now, your penance, your almsgiving, your prayer. Invest in these days to draw closer to your true potential.

¡El Primer Domingo de Cuaresma!

Ingresamos a algunos de los días más valiosos del año. Tenemos un extraordinario potencial para el cambio, de acuerdo con el mensaje de Dios para nosotros. Vemos esto en las palabras de Jesús hoy al comienzo del Evangelio de Marcos. Su llamado al cambio es un llamado para ser capaz de algo mucho más de lo que somos en la actualidad: el Reino de Dios está cerca.

Una de las cosas que más limita nuestra capacidad de cambiar es nuestra incapacidad de poder ver qué es lo vendrá después: olvidamos que hay un reino que llega y pensamos que lo que ya sabemos es todo lo que hay. Tal vez no necesitemos cambiar mucho si esto es todo: estamos relativamente bien adaptados para este mundo y sus formas.

Pero si hay algo mucho más por delante, podemos estirarnos para alcanzar nuestro nuevo potencial.

Vemos esto en nuestra segunda lectura, donde nuestro primer Papa describe la elevación de Jesús de este mundo, Cristo, "que ha ido al cielo y está a la diestra de Dios, con ángeles, autoridades y poderes sujetos a él." Esta referencia a los ángeles, como discutimos aquí la semana pasada, junto con los seres majestuosos del cielo que ni siquiera podemos imaginar, nos recuerda que hay un mundo más allá de nuestra experiencia, más allá de nuestros límites actuales.

Tenemos un potencial extraordinario para el cambio, y podemos aprovecharlo en estos días de Cuaresma, de conversión. Determina tu práctica de Cuaresma ahora, tu penitencia, tu limosna, tu oración. Invierte en estos días para acercarte a tu verdadero potencial.

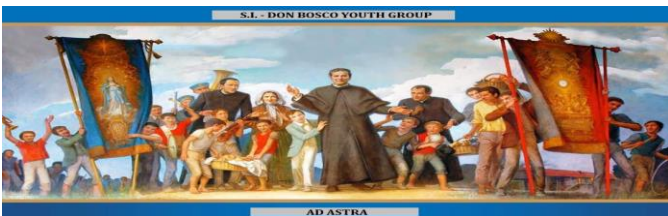

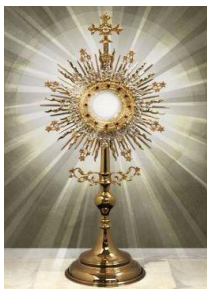

RCIA: Full of Excitement!

Discernment is now over for those who have spent a year or more in the Catechumenate- They have found themselves turning away from sin, their relationship with God has grown, they understand and believe the truths taught by the Catholic Church, and they are longing to receive the *Sacraments of Initiation- Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist*. We have heard their excitement, especially about receiving Jesus in the Eucharist! (Do we still have this excitement?) This weekend at the 5 pm Mass the unbaptized will go through the Rite of Sending. This is an opportunity for our parish community to express our approval of those in our RCIA Catechumenate. We will send all candidates forth to the Rite of Election (for the unbaptized) and the Call to Continuing Conversion (for those already baptized in other faiths) the next day, the 18th. These candidates will be with our bishop at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament in Sacramento. The unbaptized will now be called the Elect, those that are baptized have already been chosen/elected. This now marks the beginning of their final, more intense preparation for the sacraments of initiation needed to be in full communion with the Catholic Church. They will enter into the period of PURIFICATION AND ENLIGHTENMENT which will end with them receiving their sacraments at the Easter Vigil. 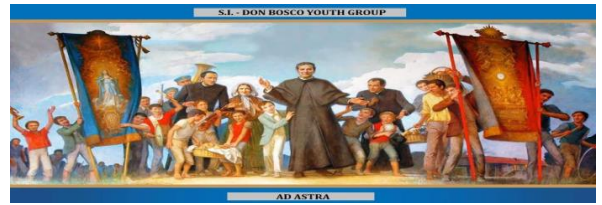
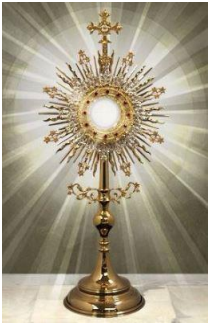
