The Pastor's Corner

Jesus is pretty great. And the difference he makes for us is pretty great. But although we may believe in him and appreciate the good things he does for us, we can view his words and works as spectators, sitting back in gratitude as he does all the heavy lifting.

And it is absolutely true that Jesus does the heavy lifting. Saving the world is kind of a big deal. But rather than see his actions as a historic highlight, do we recognize that what he does is a template for us? How he lives, what he does, is a model for how we are to live, in addition to redefining the history of the world.

When we see Jesus really humble in becoming a human being, when we see him being destroyed in the death of the cross, when we see him triumphing in glory, we are seeing the way that we also are called to live. Jesus dies on the cross not so we don't have to, but so we recognize it when it comes. He's not the sole person to rise, but all of us rise with him.

So when Jesus says today he wants to set the world on fire, and how this will cause division, we don't just sit back and watch, rather, we also want to set the world on fire, and we live out loud with the enthusiasm of our savior, recognizing this will turn some people off. We aren't called to live muted lives, spectators in the background: we are at the heart of the action.

His story is our story. Today in Hebrews we hear: "Consider how he endured such opposition from sinners, in order that you may not grow weary and lose heart." Everything he says and does is for our example—we know him, and we follow him.

Jesús es muy grande. Y la diferencia que él hace para nosotros es bastante grande. Pero, aunque podamos creer en él y apreciar las cosas buenas que hace por nosotros, solo vemos sus palabras y sus obras como espectadores, sentados en gratitud, mientras que él hace todo el trabajo pesado.

Y de hecho es absolutamente cierto que Jesús hace el trabajo pesado. Salvar al mundo es algo grande. ¿Pero en lugar de ver sus acciones como algo histórico, acaso reconocemos que lo que El hace es un patrón para nosotros? Cómo vive, lo hace, es un modelo de cómo debemos vivir, además de redefinir la historia del mundo.

Cuando vemos a Jesús realmente humilde al convertirse en un ser humano, cuando lo vemos siendo destruido en la muerte de la Cruz, cuando lo vemos triunfando en la gloria de Jesús, observamos la manera en la cual nosotros también estamos llamados a vivir. TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In recent weeks, we have reviewed how the Churches of East and West have enriched one another, and this past Thursday's solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary was born in the Eastern Church. It is a gift from the ancient Church of Jerusalem, a commemoration of the death of Mary, and a feast charged with a deep sense of the Resurrection. Mary, the first disciple, is the first to share fully in Christ's victory over death. In the tradition of the East, August 15 is the "Dormition of the Theotokos," or the "Falling Asleep of the God-bearer." There is no shadow of death or gloom in the theology, since this is seen as a transformation of Mary's life into a heavenly and immortal existence. There is a sense in the tradition that she who made earth heavenly and exalted the human race by her faithfulness is glorified today.

A persistent legend among Orthodox Christians tells how all the disciples, except Thomas, who was preaching in India, were present at Mary's death and burial, and sat by the tomb for three days. On the third day, Thomas saw Mary's body rising to heaven. She greeted him as "my friend," and he was escorted by angels to proclaim her assumption to the others, who then realized her tomb was empty. Thus Thomas, the one who expressed doubt at the resurrection of Christ, received a gift from Mary: the chance to proclaim resurrection faith to the disciples.
