

The Pastor's Corner

Reading the Bible. That's something that Christians do. We could ask: do we actually read the Bible? If so, why?

It would seem important for a believer to read from the Scriptures to learn about God, and to learn what God plans for this world. And those are valid reasons. But when we listen to our second reading from Mass today, our passage from Hebrews describes a very different scenario. Rather than us reading the Bible to learn about God, approaching the Word of God allows that Word to scrutinize us: "Indeed the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart."

We would read the Bible, according to this understanding, to allow the light of God to reveal what's inside of us. Rather than just us learning about God, we are the ones being revealed, brought to the light, both in what's comfortable and in what's awkward or painful.

This would show why it's so important to begin reading the Bible today. Rather than waiting till our death, when suddenly everything is brought to light, we should start our housekeeping now, cleaning out the junk that's buried in our souls.

LA ESQUINA DEL PASTOR

Leer la Biblia. Esto es algo que los cristianos hacemos. Podríamos preguntarnos: ¿realmente leemos la Biblia? Si es así, ¿por qué?

Pareciera importante para un creyente leer las Santas Escrituras para aprender acerca de Dios y para darnos cuenta de sus planes para este mundo. Estas son razones muy válidas. Pero cuando escuchamos nuestra segunda lectura de la Misa hoy, el pasaje de Hebreos nos revela algo muy diferente. En lugar de nosotros leer la Biblia para aprender acerca de Dios, nos acercamos a la palabra de Dios, misma palabra que nos permite analizarnos a nosotros mismos: "De hecho la palabra de Dios es viva y eficaz, más cortante que cualquier espada de doble filo, penetrante incluso entre alma y espíritu, articulaciones y médula, capaz de discernir reflexiones y pensamientos del corazón".

Leeremos la Biblia de acuerdo a este entendimiento, para permitir que la luz de Dios revele lo que nosotros llevamos dentro. En lugar de sólo aprender acerca de Dios, somos nosotros mismos los que estamos siendo revelados, traídos a la luz, en lo que es cómodo e incómodo o doloroso.

Esto demuestra por qué es tan importante comenzar a leer la Biblia hoy. En lugar de esperar hasta nuestra muerte, cuando de repente todo es sacado a la luz, debemos comenzar nuestra limpieza ahora, y limpiar la basura que tenemos entierra en el alma.



The Gabriel Project Needs You!

Many women faced with crisis pregnancies are abandoned by their families, the fathers of their babies and their communities. More and more, they are poor and in their teens. Some are homeless. Most feel afraid. For too many reasons, abortion seems the only answer. Churches and pro-life service groups have sought ways to expand their embrace of women in crisis pregnancies. Now comes a way they can do so together ... a way to combine the special power of prayer with a commitment to service - The Gabriel Project!

The Gabriel Project is a church-based outreach whose volunteers offer assistance to women and families facing difficult or crisis pregnancies. Participating churches will "advertise" this commitment by placing a "Sign of Hope", with its "800" number Helpline, which assures any woman that the local Christian community cares for her and is prepared to offer immediate and practical help with her pregnancy. Callers to the Helpline are referred to the nearest appropriate church coordinator. The coordinator and the church volunteers - "Angels"- work with local community resources to meet the mother's needs.

El Proyecto Gabriel es un proyecto de la iglesia cuyos voluntarios tienen el compromiso de ofrecer asistencia a las mujeres y a familias afrontando embarazos difíciles o de crisis. We cannot shrink from the wisdom of God, or from the word that has the power to penetrate our hearts and minds. Jesus, the living word of God, the embodiment of wisdom, has strong, deeply penetrating words for the rich young man who comes to him seeking answers to his most profound questions. Just when the young man thought he had done enough to fulfill God's commands, more was asked of him. This is no less true for us.
