The Pastor's Corner

What a strange account.

Our first reading opens with the description that when Saul arrived in Jerusalem he tried to join the disciples, but they were all afraid of him. Saint Paul, one of the two princes of the Church of Rome, author of half of the New Testament, chief of the missionaries to spread the Gospel to the world—he has trouble being accepted by the Christian community.

With the hindsight of 2,000 years this of course seems ludicrous. In the moment, however, Saul, soon to be Paul, faces the same challenges we do. We don't get to decide how others receive us, and more significantly, how God may test us for our growth.

Jesus confirms this in the Gospel today. With the image of the vine, he describes the pruning God will introduce into our lives. Branches that don't bear fruit are removed completely, while the ones that do are pruned to grow more abundantly.

What is the pruning God is doing in your life? Is it like the newly converted Saul/Paul, who has to endure the rejection or critique of those he would want to be his friends? Is it a different trial you didn't anticipate but now are burdened with?

With Paul we can seek to accept these trials from the Lord. And we can pray for a Barnabas—someone God sends us to open the door that was closed, to lift away what we struggled to carry.

Saint Paul, pray for us to accept the pruning God sends our way.

El Rincón del Pastor

Que suceso tan extraño

La primera lectura comienza con la descripción de cuando Pablo llegó a Jerusalén y trató de unirse a los discípulos, pero todos le tenían miedo. San Pablo, uno de los dos príncipes de la Iglesia de Roma, autor de la mitad del Nuevo Testamento, jefe de los misioneros para difundir el Evangelio al mundo, tiene problemas para ser aceptado por la comunidad cristiana.

Con la retrospectiva de 2000 años, esto, por supuesto, parece ridículo. En el momento, sin embargo, Pablo quien se convertiría en Saulo, enfrenta los mismos desafíos que nosotros. No podemos decidir cómo nos reciben los demás, y más significativamente, cómo Dios puede ponernos a prueba para nuestro crecimiento.

Jesús confirma esto en el Evangelio de hoy. Con la imagen de la vid, él describe la poda que Dios introducirá en nuestras vidas. Las ramas que no dan fruto se eliminan por completo, mientras que las que sí dan fruto se podan para crezcan abundantemente.

¿Cuál es la poda que Dios está haciendo en tu vida? ¿Es como el recién convertido Saúlo / Pablo, que tiene que soportar el rechazo o la crítica de aquellos a quienes quisiera que fuesen sus amigos? ¿Es una prueba diferente que no anticipaste pero que ahora estás cargando con ella?

Con Pablo podemos tratar de aceptar estas pruebas del Señor. Y podemos orar por un Barnabas, alguien a quien Dios envía para que nos habra las puertas que estaban cerradas, para que podamos llevar nuestras cargas. San Pablo, ruega por nosotros para que aceptemos la poda que Dios nos envía.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In medieval times, one country, Scotland, linked its economy to the liturgy. Four holy days of the church calendar were keyed to the legal year. On these days, rents were due, clergy and servants were paid, and contracts and leases would begin or end. The term days were Pentecost (called Whitsunday), the Feast of Saint Martin on November 11 (Martinmas), the Feast of the Presentation on February 2 (Candlemas), and August 2 (Lammas), a harvest festival. On Lammas day, the first loaf of bread from the summer wheat harvest was given to the village priest. After the Reformation, which swept the Catholic festivals away, the term days were gradually detached from the old feasts. It was only in 1990 that the term days were anchored on the 28th of February, May, August, and November. Today the old Scottish universities are the last hold-outs, still naming their terms or semesters after the old festivals. Scottish students today may not know about the liturgical year, but they still call the fall term Martinmas, and the spring session Candlemas.
