The Pastor's Corner

How quickly time flies by! Here at the Sixth Sunday of Easter we are drawing near to Pentecost, the culmination of the Easter Season.

And our readings today point to the fruit of our Easter immersion. John in the second reading describes what the fullness of love looks like: "In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as expiation for our sins."

How amazing to discover that the fulfillment of everything is the recognition of how much God loves us. Our life is meant to be a journey of discovery, and how marvelous that what we are discovering isn't some landmark, some mineral or artifact, but this encounter with an Infinite God who loves us infinitely.

It's because of this encounter that Christians are so evidently known by this singular trait: they love effortlessly and limitlessly. Because they have discovered this surging tide of God's love, they now swim in this love, spontaneously extending it to others.

The most obvious indicator that a person has arrived, has truly entered into the practice of the Faith, is the evidence of their love for others, rendered in a myriad of ways as the myriad of human needs, of human hearts, are encountered.

As we notice still the limitations on our love, we can ask that God reintroduce his love for us, that we immerse again in the heart of it all.

¡Qué rápido pasa el tiempo! Ya estamos en el sexto domingo de Pascua, nos acercamos a Pentecostés, la culminación de la temporada de Pascua.

Y nuestras lecturas de hoy señalan el fruto de nuestra inmersión de Pascua. Juan en la segunda lectura describe cómo es la plenitud del amor: "En esto consiste el amor: no porque hayamos amado a Dios, sino porque él nos amó y envió a su Hijo como expiación por nuestros pecados".

Qué sorprendente descubrir que el cumplimiento de todo es el reconocimiento de cuánto nos ama Dios. Nuestra vida debe ser un viaje de descubrimiento, y cuán maravilloso es que lo que estamos descubriendo no sea un hito, un mineral o artefacto, sino este encuentro con un Dios infinito que nos ama infinitamente.

Es por este encuentro que los cristianos son tan evidentemente conocidos por este rasgo singular: aman sin esfuerzo y sin límites. Debido a que han descubierto esta marea creciente del amor de Dios, ahora nadan en este amor, extendiéndolo espontáneamente a otros.

El indicador más obvio de que una persona ha llegado, ha entrado verdaderamente en la práctica de la Fe, es la evidencia de su amor por los demás, expresada de múltiples maneras a medida que se encuentran la gran cantidad de necesidades humanas, de corazones humanos.

Al darnos cuenta de las limitaciones de nuestro amor, podemos pedirle a Dios que reintroduzca su amor por nosotros, que nos sumerjamos nuevamente en el corazón de todo.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In ancient Rome, the beautiful month of May was dedicated to the goddess Flora, the patroness of flowers and new life. May 1 was considered the beginning of abundant growth, and a day for public festivals aimed at expelling winter. Even after Christianity took hold, the customs of the pagan feast lingered behind. Long ago, there was a thirty-day devotion to Mary, sometimes called "Lady Month," which began on August 15. By the eighteenth century, the custom of assigning devotions to months of the year was developing. June, for example, was the month of the Sacred Heart, and October was for the Holy Rosary. Beginning with the Jesuit Order in Rome and spreading throughout the world, May has been celebrated as the month of Mary, the Blessed Mother, for more than two hundred years. That was a welcome remedy to some enduring pagan practices, such as maypole dancing and the crowning of the May Queen. Some historians say that in ancient times the May Queen was actually a human sacrifice. Devoting May to Mary is undoubtedly a better thing to do.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Durante la Última Cena, Jesús dijo a sus apóstoles: "Yo soy la vid, ustedes son los sarmientos" (Juan 15:5). Jesús añade que los sarmientos (ramas) que permanecen en él, dan mucho fruto. Según la agricultura, la vid es una parra, es decir, una planta perenne de ramas frondosas.

Una parte importante de la vid son las hojas. Es obvio que una vid tiene hojas, pero Jesús no las menciona, prefiere enfocarse en los sarmientos. Las partes de la vid son las raíces, tronco, sarmientos, hojas, flores y fruto. Según esta división Jesús sería el tronco, pero él dice ser la vid completa.
