The Pastor's Corner

In a week or so, we will meet Jesus out in the desert, where the Spirit has led him. Today we find David, not yet a king, out in the desert. While Jesus wrestles with Satan in the wilderness, David is pursued by Saul.

Last Sunday Jesus blessed those who are poor and hungry, but seeing that the barrenness of the desert brings the menace of Satan, the rabid pursuit of an enraged ruler, we feel even less reason to leave our comforts and security for the poverty of the wilderness.

When Lent begins a few days from now, God will call us out to the desert to learn to fight our enemy, but we will quickly discover that God wants to instruct us in chess where we only knew checkers. The tactics we've lived by, the stratagems our society teaches us, our cleverness all leave us flopping helplessly, while God wants to equip us to thrive.

God's counsels seem illogical: "do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." If he didn't have credentials as God, we would dismiss his advice out of hand. Even knowing that he is omniscient, we have trouble applying his guidance to our real life circumstances.

David knew he could trust in the Lord—he recognized he was beloved, cherished by God. Jesus, Son of the Father, wants to awaken us to the truth that we are children of the Most High. Discovering our true identity, out in the desert where we have no risk of confusing divine grace with our creature comforts, we can realize our divine ability. Saul was astonished at David's mercy; we ourselves will be astonished as we love enemies, do good to those who frustrate us, and give expecting nothing back. God has a new scale for us; it's time for us to measure up.

Dentro de aproximadamente una semana, nos encontraremos con Jesús en el desierto, donde el Espíritu lo ha guiado. Hoy encontramos a David, aún no un rey, en el desierto. Mientras Jesús lucha con Satanás en el desierto, David es perseguido por Saúl.

El domingo pasado, Jesús bendijo a los pobres y hambrientos, pero al ver que la esterilidad del desierto trae consigo la amenaza de Satanás, la búsqueda rabiosa de un gobernante enfurecido, tenemos aún menos razones para dejar nuestras comodidades y seguridad por la pobreza del desierto.

Cuando comience la Cuaresma dentro de unos días, Dios nos llamará al desierto para que aprendamos a luchar contra el enemigo, pero pronto descubriremos que Dios quiere instruirnos en el ajedrez donde solo conocemos a las damas. Las tácticas por las que hemos vivido, las estrategias que nuestra sociedad nos enseña, nuestra inteligencia nos deja sin poder hacer nada, mientras que Dios quiere capacitarnos para prosperar.

Los consejos de Dios parecen ilógicos: "haz el bien a los que te odian, bendice a los que te maldicen, ora por los que te maltratan". Si él no tuviera credenciales como Dios, descartaríamos sus consejos de inmediato. Incluso sabiendo que es omnisciente, se nos hace difícil aplicarlo en las circunstancias de la vida real.

David sabía que podía confiar en el Señor; reconoció que era amado y apreciado por Dios. Jesús, el Hijo del Padre, quiere despertarnos a la verdad de que somos hijos del Altísimo. Al descubrir nuestra verdadera identidad, en el desierto, donde no corremos el riesgo de confundir la gracia divina con las comodidades de nuestra criatura, podemos realizar nuestra capacidad divina. Saúl se asombró de la misericordia de David; Nosotros mismos nos asombraremos al amar a los enemigos, hacer el bien a quienes nos frustran y dar sin esperar nada a cambio. Dios tiene una nueva escala para nosotros; Es hora de que nos pongamos a la altura.







TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

When the Roman Empire turned a favorable eye toward the once-persecuted Christians, among the effects was a population explosion in the baptismal font, as Christian sympathizers stepped from the shadows. With more and more people becoming Christians, laws were passed to protect Sunday as a work-free day. Soon, it became possible to celebrate Mass later in the morning, rather than the older custom of gathering before dawn to celebrate Eucharist. Amazingly, despite the increasing numbers of Christians, there was great resistance to adding to the number of worship events; the Eucharist that began as a few friends around a table soon was transformed into a more formal event with throngs crowding a large hall. All the Christians in a city or town would gather around the bishop for the one Sunday Eucharist, and only when the crowds became unmanageable was there an impulse to divide the assembly by splitting off a new bishop and flock.

Now, sixteen hundred years later, many parishes see a need to trim or combine Mass schedules. This is often seen as tough surgery. Yet our forebears in the faith would see it as a gain: a filling up of the Eucharist with a large and vigorous assembly, a fullness of ministry, an opportunity to make the Church more fully visible and stronger for service.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Según san Mateo, una noche mientras los discípulos estaban en la barca de Pedro, Jesús vino hacia ellos caminando sobre el mar. Ellos se espantaron creyendo que era un fantasma de algún pescador pero él los calmó diciendo “¡Ánimo!, que soy yo; no teman”. Debió ser impactante ver al Señor caminar sobre las aguas, especialmente en una época donde las aguas venían consideradas como el caos.

En varias partes de Latinoamérica los fieles celebran a distintos santos con procesiones de barcos sobre ríos o mares. En el Puerto de Paita, Perú se llevan a los santos Pedro y Pablo en una procesión acuática. San Pedro, que fue pescador, está en casa sobre la barca, ya que normalmente son barcas de pescadores las que forman la procesión. Esta procesión reconoce el caos del mar reconociendo a los pescadores, que durante el año perdieron sus vidas en el mar, con guirnaldas lanzadas a la bahía.
