

## The Pastor's Corner

Our last Sunday! Our last Sunday before we begin our season of Lent, time of grace and renewal. As we ponder what our fast and abstinence will be this year, what our almsgiving and charity will look like, our readings today suggest our fast might not be only from food. In terms of what's nourishing us, we may also want to think about what's pouring into our minds. Sirach gives us an accessible image: "When a sieve is shaken, the husks appear; so do one's faults when one speaks." The chattering of a fool is a familiar theme in the Old Testament; perhaps it's in verbiage we'll find some of our Lenten abstinence.

In our tech-laden world, a major share of the thoughts and images that stream into us aren't self-generated but come from our screens and devices. Without even realizing it, we learn what to think, and what way to think it from the babble that comes from outside. What if we were to take a 40 fast from streaming messaging, and create some interior space for a different voice to reach us?

What if for the next 40 days, you disconnected from all screens? Unless, as Eric Barker worded it, not using it would get you fired, divorced, or cause the people you love to spontaneously burst into flame, what if you removed the apps from your phone, unplugged the TV, disconnected the browser, and went analog?

Something that wouldn't have even occurred to our grandparents as meriting a Lenten treatment, for us causes feelings of panic and quickened heart rate. If this Lenten detox causes even a twinge of uncertainty, that's probably your indication that this is the penance for you. Create space for a new discovery this Lent: rediscover a part of yourself that's buried under the barrage, and let the Holy Spirit in.



## El Rincón Del Pastor

¡Último domingo! Nuestro último domingo antes de comenzar la temporada de Cuaresma, tiempo de gracia y renovación. Mientras reflexionamos sobre cuál será nuestro ayuno y abstinencia este año, y que será nuestra limosna y caridad, las lecturas de hoy sugieren que nuestro ayuno podría no ser solo de comida. En lo que respecta a lo que nos nutre, es posible que también queramos pensar en lo que se está vertiendo en nuestras mentes. Siracide nos da una imagen accesible: "Al agitar el cernidor, aparecen las basuras;/ en la discusión aparecen los defectos del hombre ". La plástica de un tonto es un tema familiar en el Antiguo Testamento; tal vez sea en nuestro platicar donde encontraremos algo de nuestra abstinencia de Cuaresma.

En nuestro mundo cargado de tecnología, una gran parte de los pensamientos e imágenes que se transmiten no se generan de forma automática, sino que provienen de nuestras pantallas y dispositivos. Sin darnos cuenta ese titubeo nos enseña que pensar y de qué manera pensar. ¿Qué pasaría si ayunáramos 40 días de no leer mensajes y lo remplazáramos con un espacio interior para escuchar una voz diferente?

¿Qué pasaría si durante los siguientes 40 días, se desconectara de todas las pantallas? A menos que, como lo expresó Eric Barker, el no usarlo lo despediría del trabajo, se divorciaría o causaría que las personas que ama espontáneamente estallaran en llamas, ¿qué sucedería si eliminaras las aplicaciones de su teléfono, desconectara el televisor, desconectara el navegador y te mantuviera sin tecnología?

Algo que ni siquiera se les habría ocurrido a nuestros abuelos como merecedor de un tratamiento de Cuaresma, para nosotros causa sensación de pánico y ritmo cardíaco. Si esta desintoxicación de Cuaresma causa incluso una punzada de incertidumbre, probablemente sea tu indicación de que esta es la penitencia para ti. Crea espacio para un nuevo descubrimiento en esta Cuaresma: redescubre una parte de ti mismo que está enterrada bajo la barrera y deja que entre en ti el Espíritu Santo.

### TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Many Catholics who are not active in the Church will still seek out ashes this Wednesday. Likewise, many Jews who are not otherwise observant will follow the Day of Atonement, Yom Kippur, with great exactness, fasting and refraining from work and entertainment. People customarily dress in white as a symbol of purity and a reminder of God's promise that our sins will be made white as snow. While the overture to Ash Wednesday for Christians may be a festive Mardi Gras celebration, for Jews it is the New Year feast of Rosh Hashanah. Ten days before the Day of Atonement to God, people are expected to repair breaks in human life. These are days for offering forgiveness and seeking to repair harmed relationships with family, friends, or coworkers. Everyone is expected to seek out someone and "clear the air" by asking for understanding for any mean words or thoughtless deeds in the past year.

Perhaps the ashes you receive will be invested with deeper meaning if you follow a similar plan. This year, Rosh Hashanah will be September 29, and Yom Kippur October 8. A conversation with some Jewish friends or neighbors about their experience of a season of repentance may be a blessing on your Lent.




