The Pastor's Corner

This week we pray for the protection of human life. Tomorrow, January 22nd, the United States marks 45 years since the Supreme Court legalized abortion across our country, and in the intervening years, almost 60 million children have been killed in this country.

That's a lot of blood on our hands. Haunted by the ghosts of 60 million children not allowed to live--what a terrible reality. We are afraid today of war with a nuclear power, war with North Korea, which could send warheads into our most populous cities. If Kim Jong Un were to succeed beyond the wildest possibilities of his arsenal and kill the entire population of California, he still would not have slaughtered as many people as we have ourselves--he'd have to find 20 million more people to annihilate.

I tell you, brothers and sisters, the time is running out. These words from Saint Paul today ring eerily prescient as we recognize how much guilt we bear, and how little we have done in recompense. You will have to face each of these children before you enter into their home, the home of the Eternal Father. We do not want to arrive in their presence still unrepentant, but must act now.

This week we will march in Washington D. C., we will walk in San Francisco, we will gather in solidarity across our country in defense of life--can you be there?

This Lent, every single day that our abortion clinic in Yuba City is open we will be standing in front praying--can you be there?

60 million children were killed in silence because they had no voice, and their voice can only be found in us--can you be there?

Esta semana estaremos orando por la protección de la vida humana. Mañana, 22 de enero, Estados Unidos cumple 45 años desde que el Tribunal Supremo legalizó el aborto en todo el país, y en los años transcurridos, casi 60 millones de niños han sido asesinados en este país.

Se ha derramado mucha sangre inocente. 60 millones de niños a los que no se les ha permitido vivir, ¡qué terrible realidad! Actualmente nos encontramos un poco aterrorizados por las amenazas de guerra con Corea del Norte que podría enviar bombas nucleares a nuestras ciudades más pobladas. Si Kim Jong llevara a cabo su amenaza y matase a toda la población de California, no equivalía el número de niños asesinados por el aborto. Tendría que encontrar 20 millones de personas más para aniquilar.

Les digo, hermanos y hermanas, que se acaba el tiempo. Estas palabras de San Pablo hoy suenan misteriosamente proféticas a medida que reconocemos cuánta culpa tenemos, y lo poco que hemos hecho para prevenir estas muertes. Algun día tendremos que enfrentar a cada uno de estos niños antes de entrar al hogar del Padre Eterno. No queremos llegar a su presencia sin habernos arrepentido, debemos actuar ahora.

Esta semana marcharemos en Washington D. C., caminaremos en San Francisco, nos reuniremos en solidaridad en todo nuestro país en defensa de la vida. ¿Pueden estar allí?

En esta Cuaresma, estaremos orando por el fin del aborto frente a la Clínica de abortos en nuestra ciudad de Yuba City ¿pueden estar allí?

60 millones de niños fueron asesinados en silencio porque no tenían voz, y su voz solo se puede encontrar en nosotros. ¿Pueden estar allí?

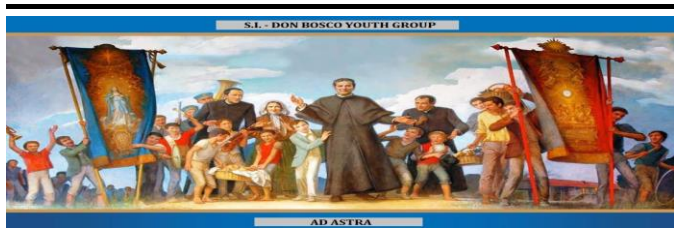
Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

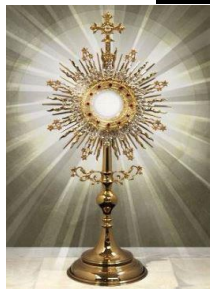

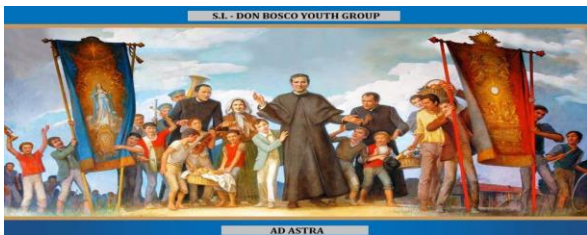
Catequesis el Buen Pastor

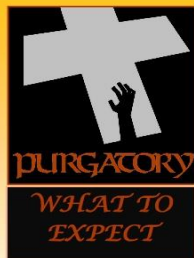
