


THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Χριστὸς ἀνέστη! Άληθῶς ἀνέστη!

Christos anesti! Alithos anesti!

Christ has risen! Indeed he has risen!

The ancient Paschal greeting that comes to us from the Eastern Church, the exuberant Easter acclamation, tells us the source of our joy.

To discover how profound a joy has been unleashed on us, perhaps it would help to pause for a moment to remember what our burdens are, what is it that weighs us down.

In bringing forward everything that fatigues us, that frightens us that keeps us discouraged and beaten down, we can see it in the new light of this morning and witness what this new illumination introduces.

We need to look at a snapshot from the Gospels that can be easily passed by: the Evangelists describe the women coming to the tomb in the early morning, which becomes the context of the first Easter announcement. In the buoyancy of how the story ends, we can forget how the women approached the garden cemetery. They knew they were drawing near to death, to the greatest sorrow the world had ever seen. They had the resolve to face what the apostles couldn't approach, to walk step by step to the most painful reality ever to be, knowing that when they arrived they wouldn't even be able to accomplish what they'd set out for, to anoint Jesus' body which lay behind the massive stone rolled across the entrance to the tomb.

You and I need that same resolve to face, to walk toward what is heaviest and grimmest in our lives, so that in those darkest shadows we can hear the voice of the same angel who greeted the women: "Do not be afraid!"

This message is so essential for us to hear that Jesus immediately plagiarizes the angel when he greets the women: "Do not be afraid." God knows, the angelic witnesses to Jesus' triumph know, that what we need is this word of freedom. "Do not be afraid."

Tomorrow will bring us new concerns, new things to be afraid of: today is our moment to seal our identity in victory. We are those who have nothing to fear, who will never have anything to fear, because life has destroyed all darkness.

El antiguo saludo pascual que nos llega desde la Iglesia oriental, la eufórica aclamación pascual, nos dice la causa de nuestra alegría.

Para descubrir el gozo profundo que se ha desatado sobre nosotros, tal vez ayudaría pausar por un momento para recordar cuáles son nuestras cargas, qué es lo que nos pesa.

Al sacar todo lo que nos fatiga, lo que nos asusta, lo que nos desanima y hace que nos derrotemos, podemos verlo bajo la nueva luz de esta mañana y ser testigos de lo que esta nueva iluminación introduce.

Necesitamos mirar el panorama de los Evangelios los cuales fácilmente podemos pasar por alto: los Evangelistas describen a las mujeres que vienen a la tumba en la madrugada, lo cual se convierte en el contexto del primer anuncio de Pascua. En la manera de cómo termina la historia, podemos olvidarnos de cómo las mujeres se acercaron al jardín del cementerio. Sabían que se acercaban a la muerte, a la mayor tristeza la cual el mundo jamás había visto. Tenían la determinación de hacer frente a lo que los apóstoles no podían afrontar, caminar paso a paso hacia la realidad más dolorosa que jamás hubiera sucedido, sabiendo que cuando llegaran ni siquiera podrían cumplir lo que se habían propuesto, ungir el cuerpo de Jesús que estaba detrás de la gigantesca piedra a la entrada de la tumba.

Tú y yo necesitamos la misma determinación para caminar y enfrentar lo más pesado y más desagradable en nuestras vidas, de modo que en las sombras más oscuras podamos oír la voz del mismo ángel que saludó a las mujeres: "¡No tenga miedo!"

Este mensaje es tan esencial para que podamos escuchar que Jesús inmediatamente imita al ángel cuando saluda a las mujeres: "No tengáis miedo". Dios sabe, los testigos angélicos del triunfo de Jesús saben, que lo que necesitamos es esta palabra de libertad. "No tengas miedo."

El mañana nos traerá nuevas preocupaciones, nuevas cosas que temer: hoy es nuestro momento de sellar nuestra identidad en el triunfo. Somos de esos que a nada le temen, los cuales nunca tendrán nada que temer, porque la vida a destruido la obscuridad.



Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

ALLELUIA! HE IS RISEN!

As we ponder the events of the Triduum with the children in the atrium, one of the scriptures that we listen to is the account of the Last Supper. As we listen, we prepare a small table for the Passover meal that Jesus shared with His apostles. The children share with me what they heard in the scripture: "This is my Body", "This is my Blood", "Many. His blood will be poured out for many.", "Chalice! Like we see at Mass!". The children in the atrium can enter into the historical event of the Last Supper, and then link it with the liturgy of Holy Mass. As we light the candles on the tiny replica of the altar, we proclaim the Good News, "Christ has died. CHRIST IS RISEN!"

Los niños en el atrio pueden entrar en el acontecimiento histórico de la Última Cena, y luego vincularlo con la liturgia de la Santa Misa. Al encender las velas en la diminuta réplica del altar, proclamamos la Buena Nueva, "Cristo ha muerto. ¡CRISTO HA RESUCITADO!"

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Easter is nearly three weeks later this year than last. Why does the date wobble around the calendar so? The way of calculating the date was set by the Emperor Constantine in 325. The decision ended a very bitter controversy in the church. Some people wanted to synchronize the Pasch with Passover on the fourteenth day of the Jewish month Nissan, and their opponents wanted it after the Passover was complete, on the Sunday after the first full moon of springtime. The ecclesiastical rules do not exactly connect with the astronomical rules. The emperor squashed the hopes of the quartodecimans, as the fans of 14 Nissan were called, and chose Sunday. The traditional rule is that Easter is the first Sunday after the first ecclesiastical full moon that occurs on or after the vernal equinox, the fourteenth day of the new moon, and later than March 21. Thus, Easter wobbles between March 22 and April 25.

The actual tables and methods for computing the date are extraordinarily detailed, with subtle variations and mind-bending exceptions and charts with "golden numbers," "dominical letters," and "epacts" measuring leap years. In 1954 and 1962 the ecclesiastical calculations actually overrode the astronomical new moons and bumped Easter back a month! Today, there is a movement in the World Council of Churches (Protestants and Orthodox) for all Christians to combine their celebrations, based on the star charts for the Jerusalem skies. In principle, the Catholic Church is open to an ecumenical agreement on a fixed date for Easter, but we desire a unanimous decision from the World Council. —Rev. James Field, Copyright © J. S. 

Recuerdo con alegría la costumbre de colorear los cascarones el sábado de Gloria para que la coneja nos los escondiera para la Pascua. Al día siguiente, después de Misa nos reuníamos a buscar cascarones y romperlos sobre la cabeza de quien se arrimará, para bañarlos con el confeti multicolor.

La costumbre de celebrar la Pascua con cascarones decorados es una bella tradición. Esta costumbre muestra que todas las naciones pueden agregar a la Iglesia cristiana tradiciones propias de su cultura, ya que Jesucristo dio su vida por todas ellas. Es justo celebrar la Resurrección del autor de la vida con símbolos de fecundidad y todos los colores del gozo.


Divine Mercy Group

¡Diario de 33 días hacia un Glorioso Amanecer!

Debes estar en el día 5 ó 6 del estudio de San Louis de Montefort, el primer gran profeta de la Consagración Mariana. 
