Victimae Paschali Laudes Immolent Christiani. Today the Church includes a thousand year old hymn, a sequence, in her liturgy. *Christians, to the Paschal victim, offer your praises.*

Our prayers today, our rejoicing, our celebration, join in a chorus that has continued through the generations and centuries.

And of course the victory we celebrate tears through the fabric of time: *Mors et vita duello conflixere mirando: death and life have fought in that awe-filled combat.* The events commemorated in this resurrection celebration reach beyond this world's limits because they overthrow our former limit: death itself.

This Easter hymn describes the seemingly mundane items, *sepulcrum, sudarium, vestes: tomb, shroud, napkin,* yet now they are transfused with meaning, a meaning that will endure throughout time into eternity. Our earth, and all that's in it, will never be the same since this revolutionary moment.





Adopt a student information is still available on the parish web site, in the vestibule to the church and in the school office. An easy way to participate is through Faith Direct. St. Isidore Parish and School is increasing awareness of the financial assistance needed by many families who desire a Catholic school education for their children. More than 50 % of our school families cannot afford the full tuition. Hopefully through your prayers and support we can increase our Adopt-a-Student program 100%. Full Time Custodial Position

St. Isidore School is hiring a full time year round 40 hour a week custodian. The custodian will be responsible for 12 classrooms, Bishop Quinn Hall, four large bathrooms, school office, and staff room. Those applying should have some janitorial experience. The position will require a split shift to include early to mid-morning – and afternoon to evening depending on the schedule of the school and the hall. Must be available for on-call during the day if needed. Includes benefits and earned paid time off. Please come by the school office for the necessary application papers.

Part – time Clerical Position Available at St. Isidore School

St. Isidore School has a part time clerical position available – 19 hours a week. 

Good Vibrations on the Way!

Thank you for your patience! We’ve begun improvements on the Church sound system. Recently the entire system was recalibrated by Clarity, our AV resource, and they have made recommendations for improvements.



- ⊕ Upgrade speaking microphones and choir microphones to Omni-directional
- ⊕ Add a new digital audio signal processor
- ⊕ Add a 3-Series room media controller
- ⊕ Install a touch screen controller to store choir and speaking pre-sets
- ⊕ Program pre-sets with individuals and choirs
- ⊕ Install a 32 channel digital rack mount
- ⊕ Install a snake freestanding stage box to clean up cords by choirs

Feria de comida


