JESUS' MINISTRY SUMMARIZED

The story of the raising of Lazarus from the dead is the single longest story (apart from the Passion) in the Gospel of John. In it we find a summary of most of Jesus' ministry. We see his very human nature as he is moved by Martha and Mary's sorrows and as he himself weeps at the tomb of Lazarus. He is the wisdom of God's Word made flesh as he explains to his followers that the death of Lazarus will serve as a sign of the glory of God. He crowns the miracles he works in John's Gospel (which began with the most "human" miracle of making new wine at Cana's wedding) by raising Lazarus from the dead—a "preview," if you will, of his own death and resurrection to come. This portrait of Jesus reminds us, as we near the end of our Lenten journey, that he is with us, knows us, understands us in every moment of our lives. He knows the joy of our human feasting, he knows the sorrow of our weeping. As we prepare to walk with him through the days of Holy Week, we are filled with faith that—through Christ—God's glory will be with us in every moment of our lives and—with Christ—in our life everlasting. RESUMEN DEL MINISTERIO DE JESÚS

El relato de cómo Lázaro revivió de entre los muertos es el relato más largo (además de la Pasión) en el Evangelio según san Juan. En él encontramos un resumen de la mayor parte del ministerio de Jesús. Vemos su naturaleza humana cuando se commueve con la tristeza de Marta y de María y cuando él mismo llora frente a la tumba de Lázaro. Es la sabiduría de la Palabra de Dios hecha carne cuando le explica a sus seguidores que la muerte de Lázaro servirá como una señal de la gloria de Dios. Corona los milagros que obra en el Evangelio según san Juan (que comenzó con el milagro más "humano" de hacer más vino en la boda de Caná) reviviendo a Lázaro de entre los muertos; un "avance", por así decirlo, de su propia muerte y resurrección por venir. Este retrato de Jesús nos recuerda, mientras estamos cerca del fin de nuestro viaje de Cuaresma, que él está con nosotros, nos conoce, nos comprende en cada momento de nuestra vida. Conoce la alegría de nuestras celebraciones humanas, conoce la tristeza de nuestro llanto. Mientras nos preparamos para caminar con él en los días de Semana Santa, tenemos fe de que —por Cristo— la gloria de Dios estará con nosotros a cada momento de nuestra vida y —con Cristo— en nuestra vida eterna.

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Lazarus!" To hear the name is already to know Jesus' invocation: "Come out!"

Today's miracle arrives at a critical moment in Jesus' ministry: in a few days, as we'll see, Jesus will arrive at his hour, and he will lay down his life for his friends. Like the rest of humanity, he will pass into the valley of the shadow of death. By commanding Lazarus to return from the dead, Jesus reveals he is sovereign over life and death. Jesus' invasion of the netherworld is one he has already mapped out and confirmed he can assail and overcome.

Today we often deny that we are afraid of death. Our society, since it has no horizon after death, requires that we ignore and push away our swiftly arriving annihilation. A glimpse behind the veil, however, reveals we are a culture paralyzed by what we cannot overcome.

Contemporary consumerism reveals a generation addicted to any tonic that keeps us looking young. It isn't death alone that terrifies us, it is any reminder that we are gradually fading, that we are dwindling into extinction. The not millions but billions spent each year on cosmetics, diets, skin and hair care, hints that we are people terrified of even glimpsing our decline.

As Jesus establishes himself as the Lord of life and death, and being himself the Way by which we traverse these dynamics, he calls us to a new vision of ourselves and this world. Jesus' disciple doesn't need a fake veneer. Instead of compulsively pursuing the distracted behavior of those who can't allow eternity to echo in their lives, we are called to walk with wisdom and grace, knowing that with Lazarus we are assured of the fullness of life.

"¡Lázaro!" Oír el nombre ya es conocer la invocación de Jesús: "¡Salid!"

El milagro de hoy llega en un momento crítico en el ministerio de Jesús: en pocos días, como veremos, Jesús llegará a su hora, y dará su vida por sus amigos. Como el resto de la humanidad, el pasará por el valle de la sombra de la muerte. Al ordenarle a Lázaro que regrese de entre los muertos, Jesús revela que es soberano sobre la vida y la muerte. La invasión de Jesús al inframundo es una que ya ha recordado y confirmó que puede afligir y vencer.

Hoy en día, a menudo negamos que le tenemos miedo a la muerte. Nuestra sociedad, puesto que no tiene horizonte después de la muerte, requiere que ignoremos y demoremos nuestra aniquilación. Un vistazo detrás del velo, sin embargo, revela que somos una cultura paralizada por lo que no podemos superar.

El consumismo contemporáneo revela una generación adicta a cualquier tónico que nos mantenga jóvenes. No es la muerte sola la que nos aterra, es un recordatorio de que estamos gradualmente desapareciendo, que estamos disminuyendo en extinción. Los no millones, pero miles de millones gastados cada año en cosméticos, dietas, cuidado de la piel y el cabello, indica que somos gente aterrorizada de incluso vislumbrar nuestro propia declinación .

A medida que Jesús se establece a sí mismo como el Señor de la vida y la muerte, y siendo él mismo el Camino por el cual atravesamos estas dinámicas, es que nos llama a tener una nueva visión de nosotros mismos y de este mundo. El discípulo de Jesús no necesita la apariencia falsa. En vez de perseguir compulsivamente la conducta distraída de aquellos que no pueden permitir que la eternidad haga eco en sus vidas, estamos llamados a caminar con sabiduría y gracia, sabiendo que con Lázaro estamos seguros de la plenitud de la vida.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The church slowly developed customs of reserving some portion of the Eucharistic sacrifice for the sake of the dying. Today's custom of placing this portion in a tabernacle for prayer and adoration by the faithful cannot be traced back much beyond the year 1,000, much to almost everyone's surprise. There is simply no historical evidence of the Blessed Sacrament being present in a church for the purpose of having the faithful visit it or pray before it earlier in the church's history. People did visit, of course, but the center of their attention was the altar, symbol of Christ's sacrifice and the touchpoint between heaven and earth. Shrines and devotional altars abounded in medieval churches, but anything we might describe as a Blessed Sacrament chapel would be hard to find.

Amazingly, the Eucharist was first kept in private houses for the purpose of Holy Communion at home. As for church, the custom gradually developed of suspending a vessel shaped like a dove somewhere in the church, often over the altar. In the hovering bird, a few hosts, enough to satisfy the pastoral needs of the dying, would be secreted. The priest would lower the dove on a pulley as needed, but it wasn't a focus of devotion by visitors to the church. It was simply a way of reassuring bishops who were nervous about safeguarding the Eucharist. The dove solution caught on in England and France after Crusaders came in contact with the custom in their travels in the Orthodox East.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Esta semana recordamos el nacimiento de uno de nuestros propios héroes: César Estrada Chávez, quien nació en Arizona en 1927 y falleció en Los Ángeles, California en 1993. El racismo y la injusticia de su tiempo, obligaron a él y su familia a salir de su natal Arizona, pues sus padres perdieron sus tierras a causa de unos malhechores. En 1938 el destino lo llevó a Los Ángeles, al barrio "Sal, si puedes".

Con la ayuda de Dolores Huerta y otras personas, en 1962 fundó el movimiento sindical de campesinos que daría a luz a *United Farm Workers* para protestar por las injusticias que nuestro pueblo sufrió en los viñedos, situación que bien puede describirse como barbarie. Muchos se unieron a la "huelga" y al boicoteo de uvas bajo la bandera roja del águila azteca y el estandarte de Guadalupe. De esta manera, con símbolos de nuestro origen indígena y religioso, César nos enseñó que "Sí se puede" salir adelante.

En dos ocasiones, en 1972 y en 1988 respectivamente, debido a que algunos compañeros del movimiento querían incurrir en la violencia para salir adelante, César hizo un ayuno de 24 y 36 días respectivamente. De esta manera exhortó una vez más a todo el movimiento de que sólo mediante el trabajo, la fe y el sacrificio se pueden lograr las cosas. ¡Sí se puede!
