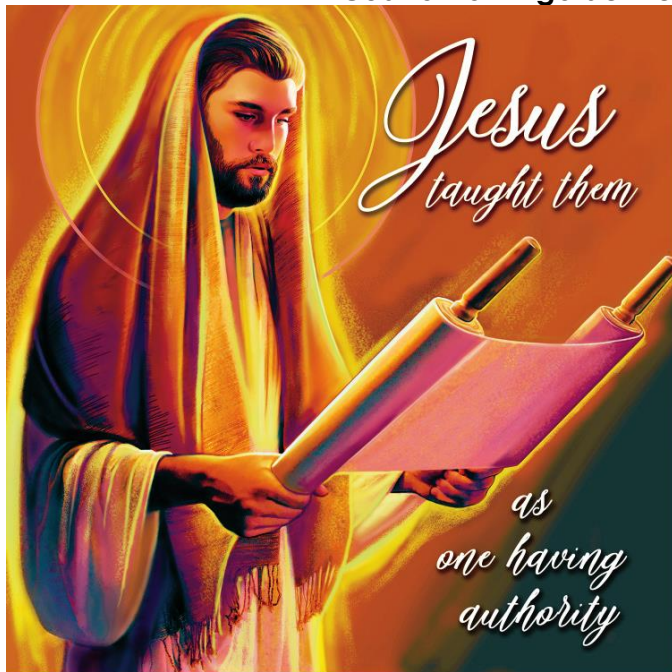

The Pastor's Corner

Catholic Schools Week!

All across the country, parishes are celebrating the educational efforts that allow approximately 1.7 million children to receive a Catholic education, as well as an additional half million in Catholic high schools. Catholic schools form the largest number of nonpublic schools in the country, and here in Yuba City we are able to be a part of this transformative endeavor.

Few things in this life are more exciting than the journey of discovery, the unlocking of and encounter with our extraordinary potential and the wonders of this world. Parents have one of the most marvelous roles in this life of accompanying and guiding their children in this adventure. The Vatican II document *Gaudium et Spes* confirmed this role of parents as the primary educators of their children, particularly in religious education.

The Catholic community, especially in the form of the parish, assists parents in this fundamental responsibility. Few obligations carry more weight for us than the handing on of what we have received: our identity, grounded in tradition--what is handed on--requires us to pass down what was entrusted to us.

Our parish school is at the heart of this endeavor to preserve and foster what we have been given. This task is borne by all of us as parishioners, who share the work of each parent in allowing the Faith to flourish. While we are all familiar with the model of our school operating on a tuition based system, where parents alone carry the cost of educating their children, I want to invite us all to expand our potential by contributing to our children's formation. Many, many more children are not yet being reached because of financial hindrances, and it is within our reach to make Catholic education available to all our children.

With our Adopt-a-Student program, I'd like to ask you to assist in funding our children's education. As little as \$5 a month, or as much as a child's full tuition cost of \$429 monthly, can make the difference between a child sharing the Faith or being shut out. Please go to our parish website www.stisidore-yubacity.org (you can google our parish to find the page) and click on Online Giving at the top of the page. This opens the page where you can select Faith Direct Give Now, which allows you to enroll in recurring giving. Under Recurring Gifts select Parish School Support, where you can designate your monthly contribution. From there you can choose whether to pay by credit card or direct debit from your checking account.

Change a child's life; change the future. Talk with your spouse and decide what you can contribute monthly to make our parish school a source of transformation for our world.

¡Semana de las Escuelas Católicas!

En todo el país, las parroquias están celebrando los esfuerzos educativos que permiten que aproximadamente 1.7 millones de niños reciban educación católica, medio millón adicional son escuelas secundarias católicas. Las escuelas católicas forman el mayor número de escuelas no públicas del país, y aquí, en la ciudad de Yuba, podemos ser parte de este esfuerzo transformador.

Pocas cosas en esta vida son más emocionantes que el viaje del descubrimiento, del desbloqueo y el encuentro con nuestro extraordinario potencial y las maravillas de este mundo. Los padres de familia tienen uno de los roles más maravillosos en esta vida, el de acompañar y guiar a sus hijos en esta aventura. El documento del Vaticano II *Gaudium et Spes* confirmó este papel de los padres de familia como los principales educadores de sus hijos, particularmente en la educación religiosa.

La comunidad católica, especialmente en la parroquia, ayuda a los padres de familia en esta responsabilidad fundamental. Pocas obligaciones tienen tanto peso para nosotros como la de entregar lo que hemos recibido: nuestra identidad sólida en tradición, lo que se transmite o se nos entrega de generación en generación— requiere que también pasemos lo que se nos fue encomendó.

Nuestra escuela parroquial está en el corazón de este esfuerzo para preservar y fomentar lo que se nos ha dado. Esta tarea es asumida por todos nosotros como feligreses, quienes compartimos el trabajo de cada padre de familia al permitir que la fe florezca. Si bien, todos estamos familiarizados con el modelo de nuestra escuela que opera en un sistema basado en matrículas, donde solo los padres cargan con el costo de educar a sus hijos, quiero invitar a todos y cada uno de ustedes a expandir nuestro potencial contribuyendo a la formación de nuestros hijos. Muchos, muchos más niños aún no han sido registrados debido a obstáculos financieros, y está a nuestro alcance en nuestras manos hacer que la educación católica esté disponible para todos.

Con nuestro programa Adopt-a-Student (Adopte a un estudiante), me gustaría pedirle que ayude a financiar la educación de nuestros hijos. 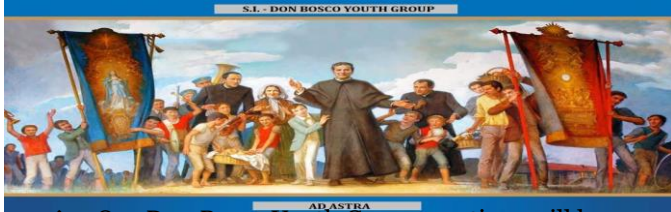

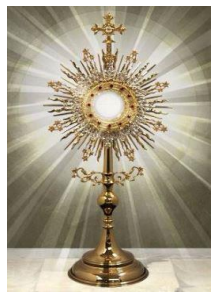

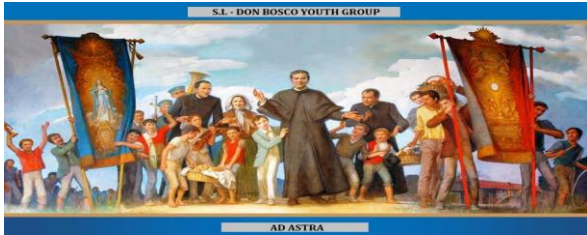

CONFIRMACIÓN PARA ADULTOS

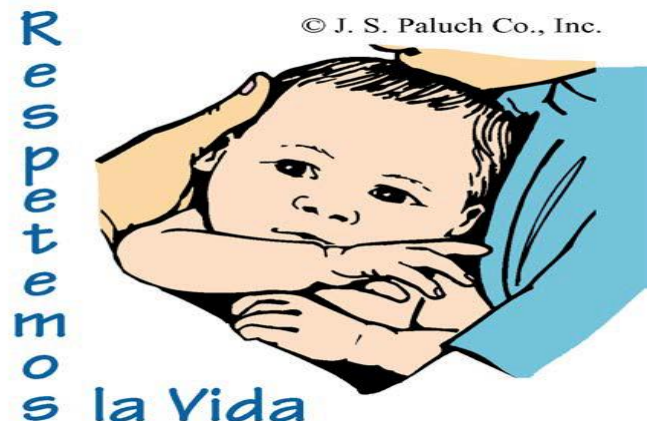

Influenza; suspension of cup & other precautions

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has indicated that the incidence of flu and flu-like illnesses has reached a level requiring that we take action to mitigate the possibility of infection at Mass. In order to protect the health and well-being of everyone, Bishop Soto has issued the following directives:

- The use of the Communion cup is suspended temporarily.
- Receive the Body of Christ in the hand (although receiving on the tongue is permitted)
- Do not shake hands. Offer the sign of the Peace to those around you with a simple nod, saying "peace be with you."
- Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion are reminded to cleanse their hands with an alcohol-based antiseptic before and after administering Holy Communion. This also applies to those who take Holy Communion to the home-bound.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and other Holy Days does not apply to those who are sick. If you are sick, stay home and take care of yourself. Thank you for your patience and understanding during this time. And pray for those who are sick. The administration of Holy Communion in both kinds will resume as soon as the Bishop deems it safe and prudent to do so.
