





CHILDREN OF THE LIGHT

The future king, David, in today's first reading, is an example of a type of character present throughout the Hebrew scriptures. He is the child born out of place (not the eldest or most favored) who ends up receiving the promise of the covenant. The spirit of God's anointing rushes upon him. In this way, he is similar to the man born blind from today's Gospel. David's family and the blind man's community did not expect the miraculous grace of God's love to work through them. Perhaps they, too, were "blinded" by the expectations and assumptions of those around them. Yet, after being touched by God, they both came to "see" the presence of God's will for them. Both became messengers of God's will. That same Spirit of God's anointing rushed upon us at our baptism; we were given a candle as a sign of our membership in the Body of Christ, the Light from Light. Our vocation, then, is to fulfill that enlightenment, that anointing, as Ephesians tells us, by living as "children of the light."

HIJOS DE LA LUZ

El futuro rey, David, en la primera lectura de hoy, es un ejemplo de un tipo de personaje presente a lo largo de las escrituras hebreas. Es el hijo que nace fuera de lugar (no es ni el mayor ni el preferido) pero a fin de cuentas recibe la promesa de la alianza. El espíritu de Dios lo llena con su unción. En esto, se parece al hombre que nació ciego del Evangelio de hoy. La familia de David y la comunidad del ciego no esperaban que la gracia milagrosa del amor de Dios obrara por medio de ellos. Quizás ellos, también, estaban "ciegos" por las expectativas y suposiciones de los que los rodeaban. Sin embargo, luego de ser tocados por Dios, ambos "vieron" la presencia de la voluntad de Dios para ellos. Ambos se convirtieron en mensajeros de la voluntad de Dios. Ese mismo Espíritu de unción de Dios nos llenó en nuestro bautismo; se nos dio un cirio como símbolo de que somos miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo, la Luz de la Luz. Nuestra vocación, entonces, es cumplir esa iluminación, esa unción, como se nos dice en Efesios, viviendo como "hijos de la luz".

Light. We don't realize how vital it is until we don't have it. When we struggle to find our way across a darkened room, or reach for things lost in the dark, we realize how trapped we instantly become when the lights go out.

I remember when I was a kid we were on an excursion with youth group and our youth minister had a pair of night vision goggles, so as we drove down a nighttime road he switched off the headlights and drove into the darkness. Maybe not smart, or legal, but in that moment of thrill as a passenger you realized, 'saw', what a difference light and dark make, vision and blindness.

Our Gospel passage today of the man born blind shows us what God wants to introduce into our lives. "I am," Jesus tells us today, "the light of the world."

This gift resonates profoundly with the themes of our Lenten season. As with our prayer and fasting, our mercy and almsgiving, we seek to free our minds from the ruts they've become trapped in, this in-breaking light drives out the shadows that roost in our hearts.

There is no better Lenten practice to let in this light, to liberate our souls for revitalization, than the sacrament of confession. The scrutiny and reflection, the admission and absolution this sacrament brings allow the light of grace to radiate into our lives.

This Thursday evening we have our Lenten Penance Service, with priests from around the deanery joining us for the sacrament of confession. If you haven't been to confession yet this season, take advantage of this irreplaceable gift. This is our opportunity to let the light in. Confession is the road to healing, and Jesus comes to bring radiance into our lives.

La luz. No nos damos cuenta de lo vital que es hasta que no la tenemos. Cuando intentamos caminar en una habitación oscura, o encontrar algún objeto en la oscuridad, al instante nos damos cuenta de lo atrapados que estamos cuando no hay luz.

Tal vez no fue inteligente, o legal, pero en ese momento de emoción uno como pasajero se da cuenta, 'Mira', la diferencia que la luz y la oscuridad hacen, la vista y la ceguera.

Nuestro pasaje evangélico de hoy del hombre ciego de nacimiento, nos muestra lo que Dios quiere introducir en nuestras vidas. "Yo soy", nos dice Jesús hoy, "la luz del mundo".

Este regalo concuerdan profundamente con los temas de esta temporada cuaresmal. Como con nuestra oración y ayuno, con nuestra misericordia y con nuestra limosna, buscamos liberar nuestras mentes de las barreras en las que se han quedado atrapadas, esta luz que rompe las tinieblas expulsa las sombras que reposan en nuestros corazones.

No hay mejor práctica cuaresmal para dejar que esta luz entre a rehabilitar nuestras almas que el sacramento de la confesión. El escrutinio y la reflexión, la admisión y la absolución que este sacramento trae, permiten que la luz de la gracia irradie en nuestras vidas.

Este jueves por la noche tenemos nuestro Servicio de Penitencia Cuaresmal, con sacerdotes de las parroquias de alrededor que se unen a nosotros para el sacramento de la confesión. Si aún no te has confesado esta temporada, aprovecha este regalo insustituible. Esta es nuestra oportunidad de dejar entrar la luz. La confesión es el camino hacia la sanación, y Jesús viene a traer resplandor en nuestras vidas .



TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The church slowly developed customs of reserving some portion of the Eucharistic sacrifice for the sake of the dying. Today's custom of placing this portion in a tabernacle for prayer and adoration by the faithful cannot be traced back much beyond the year 1,000, much to almost everyone's surprise. There is simply no historical evidence of the Blessed Sacrament being present in a church for the purpose of having the faithful visit it or pray before it earlier in the church's history. People did visit, of course, but the center of their attention was the altar, symbol of Christ's sacrifice and the touchpoint between heaven and earth. Shrines and devotional altars abounded in medieval churches, but anything we might describe as a Blessed Sacrament chapel would be hard to find.

Amazingly, the Eucharist was first kept in private houses for the purpose of Holy Communion at home. As for church, the custom gradually developed of suspending a vessel shaped like a dove somewhere in the church, often over the altar. In the hovering bird, a few hosts, enough to satisfy the pastoral needs of the dying, would be secreted. The priest would lower the dove on a pulley as needed, but it wasn't a focus of devotion by visitors to the church. It was simply a way of reassuring bishops who were nervous about safeguarding the Eucharist. The dove solution caught on in England and France after Crusaders came in contact with the custom in their travels in the Orthodox East.-Rev. James Field, Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Esta semana recordamos el nacimiento de uno de nuestros propios héroes: César Estrada Chávez, quien nació en Arizona en 1927 y falleció en Los Ángeles, California en 1993. El racismo y la injusticia de su tiempo, obligaron a él y su familia a salir de su natal Arizona, pues sus padres perdieron sus tierras a causa de unos malhechores. En 1938 el destino lo llevó a Los Ángeles, al barrio "Sal, si puedes".

Con la ayuda de Dolores Huerta y otras personas, en 1962 fundó el movimiento sindical de campesinos que daría a luz a *United Farm Workers* para protestar por las injusticias que nuestro pueblo sufría en los viñedos, situación que bien puede describirse como barbarie. Muchos se unieron a la "huelga" y al boicoteo de uvas bajo la bandera roja del águila azteca y el estandarte de Guadalupe. De esta manera, con símbolos de nuestro origen indígena y religioso, César nos enseñó que "Sí se puede" salir adelante.

En dos ocasiones, en 1972 y en 1988 respectivamente, debido a que algunos compañeros del movimiento querían incurrir en la violencia para salir adelante, César hizo un ayuno de 24 y 36 días respectivamente. De esta manera exhortó una vez más a todo el movimiento de que sólo mediante el trabajo, la fe y el sacrificio se pueden lograr las cosas. ¡Sí se puede!
