SEND OUT YOUR SPIRIT

Last week we heard that, following the Ascension, the disciples, Mary, and other followers of the Lord retreated to the upper room in prayer. This week we hear that, while praying in that room, the Holy Spirit comes upon them. Jesus' post-Resurrection promise, recounted in today's Gospel, is fulfilled: the power of the Holy Spirit comes upon Jesus' followers. Saint Paul tells us that all of us, in some way, are given gifts of the Holy Spirit, gifts that can be used to spread the Good News. Today is one of the Church's greatest festivals. Let us carry the refrain of the responsorial psalm with us throughout the coming week: "Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth!" (Psalm 104:30).

Saturday at 10:00am the Diocese of Sacramento ordained three new men to the presbyterate. The new Fathers: Andres Emmanuelli, Edgardo Garcia and Joshua Sia will now be serving in parishes across the diocese in their new ministry *in persona Christi*, as representatives of Jesus in our local communities.

This extraordinary step forward in their lives, and this marvelous blessing for the Church, comes about through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. As we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the 50th day since Jesus' resurrection when the Holy Spirit is poured out upon us in abundance, we see these charisms at work in a special way in this new priestly ministry.

In our Sacraments, we invoke the Holy Spirit in a particular way, both through the laying on of hands and through anointing. When we celebrate the Eucharist, we call down the Holy Spirit upon the bread and wine for consecration into the living presence of Jesus through the extending of the priest's hands over the offerings; when we celebrate Baptism the infant (or adult) is anointed over the heart before Baptism and on the crown of the head after; and of course at Confirmation the person is anointed on the forehead for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit; in the Sacrament called Anointing, the Anointing of the Sick, the person is anointed on both the forehead and palms of the hand to ask for the strength of the Holy Spirit.

In the Sacrament of Holy Orders, when a man is ordained a priest both of these actions are present; in fact, ordination can be referred to as the laying on of hands. The actual moment the man becomes a priest occurs when the bishop places his hands on the man's head, calling down the Holy Spirit in a way that creates a permanent seal, like a stamp, on the soul, similar to Baptism and Confirmation, which leave a seal on the soul that lasts into eternity. The priest's hands are also anointed with Chrism, the same holy oil used in Baptism and Confirmation, manifesting the work of the Holy Spirit that will be accomplished through those hands.

We have the privilege this weekend of joining with Father Andres Emmanuelli as he celebrates a Mass of Thanksgiving here at Saint Isidore's at 5:00pm on Sunday. The word Eucharist itself means thanksgiving, so it's a marvelous gift for us to be with Father Andres as he fulfills the words of the Psalmist: "How can I repay the Lord for all the great good done for me? I will raise the cup of salvation and call on the name of the Lord."

This Pentecost we join in thanksgiving for the graces, charisms, the Holy Spirit has poured out upon us, and we ask the Holy Spirit to enable us to live more fully the gifts he has given us.



Este sábado a las 10:00 am la Diócesis de Sacramento ordenó a tres nuevos hombres al presbiterio. Los nuevos Sacerdotes Andrés Emmanuelli, Edgardo García y Joshua Sia estarán sirviendo en las parroquias de la diócesis en su nuevo ministerio *in persona Christi*, como representantes de Jesús en nuestras comunidades locales.

Este extraordinario paso en sus vidas, y una maravillosa bendición para la Iglesia, se produce a través del derramamiento del Espíritu Santo. Al celebrar el Domingo de Pentecostés, el 50º día desde la resurrección de Jesús cuando el Espíritu Santo es derramado sobre nosotros en abundancia, vemos estos carismas trabajando de manera especial en este nuevo ministerio sacerdotal.

En nuestros Sacramentos, invocamos al Espíritu Santo de una manera particular, tanto por la imposición de manos como por la unción. Cuando celebramos la Eucaristía, invocamos al Espíritu Santo sobre el pan y el vino para la consagración a la presencia viva de Jesús mediante la extensión de las manos del sacerdote sobre las ofrendas; Cuando celebramos el Bautismo el niño (o adulto) es ungido sobre el corazón antes del Bautismo y despues en la frente; por supuesto en la Confirmación la persona es ungida en la frente para el derramamiento del Espíritu Santo; En el Sacramento llamado Unción, la Unción de los Enfermos, la persona es ungida tanto en la frente como en las palmas de la mano para pedir la fuerza del Espíritu Santo.

En el Sacramento del Orden Sacerdotal, cuando un hombre es ordenado sacerdote, están presentes ambos actos; De hecho, la ordenación puede ser referida como la imposición de manos. El momento en que el hombre se convierte en sacerdote ocurre cuando el obispo pone sus manos sobre la cabeza del hombre, llamando al Espíritu Santo de manera que crea un sello permanente, como un sello, en el alma, similar al Bautismo y la Confirmación, que dejan Un sello en el alma que dura una eternidad. Las manos del sacerdote también son ungidas con Crisma, el mismo aceite sagrado usado en el Bautismo y la Confirmación, manifestando la obra del Espíritu Santo que se realizará a través de esas manos.

Tenemos el privilegio este fin de semana de unirnos al Padre Andrés Emmanuelli mientras celebra una misa de Acción de Gracias aquí en San Isidro a las 5:00 pm del domingo. La palabra Eucaristía en sí significa acción de gracias, por lo que es un maravilloso regalo para nosotros estar con el Padre Andrés mientras cumple las palabras del salmista: "¿Cómo puedo pagar al Señor por todo el bien que a hecho por mí? Salvación y invocar el nombre del Señor ".

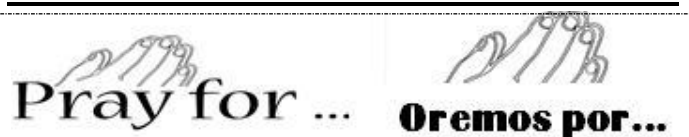

2018 Pilgrimage to Rome and Mediterranean Cruise

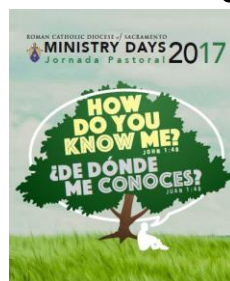

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

What is Catechesis of the Good Shepherd?



The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a distinct approach to children's faith formation in which children as young as 3 can cultivate deep, lifelong relationships with Christ and the Church. Originating in Rome in the 1950s, this approach engages children using age-appropriate, hands-on materials based on Sacred Scripture and Liturgy. Young children learn best by actively engaging their bodies and all of their senses. In the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, they work with simple, beautiful materials in a room prepared for them called the "atrium". Children from 3 to 12 can immerse themselves in this quiet, retreat-like environment.

La Catequesis del Buen Pastor es un acercamiento distinto a la formación de la fe de los niños en la cual los niños pequeños de 3 años en adelante pueden cultivar relaciones profundas y duraderas con Cristo y la Iglesia. Originado en Roma en la década de 1950, este enfoque involucra a los niños utilizando materiales apropiados para su edad, prácticas basadas en la Sagrada Escritura y la Liturgia. En la Catequesis del Buen Pastor, trabajan con materiales sencillos y bellos en una sala preparada para ellos llamada "atrio". TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Today, the languages of the whole world arise to God in a Pentecost of praise. In some American dioceses, the Mass is offered every Sunday in more than thirty different languages, including the silent praise of American Sign Language. Fifty years ago, the landscape of liturgy was very different. It was grounded firmly in Latin, which is to the present day still the official language of the Roman Rite. Very few people were fluent in Latin, even though in those days Latin was far more widely studied in school. Nevertheless, almost every Catholic was competent in the responses and chants of Latin since it is not difficult to pronounce. The clergy were normally minimally competent in Latin, since much of seminary education was conducted in that language.

When the Second Vatican Council was convened, all of the debate and daily work of the council was to be in Latin. In the first session in 1962, Boston's Cardinal Richard Cushing continually complained about it, and threatened not to return in 1963 if something wasn't done. He convinced the fathers when he rose to speak in fairly fluent Latin in an unforgettable Boston twang. The next year, he returned, but with a simultaneous translation system funded by the people of Boston. The ordinary everyday language of the people, the vernacular, had arrived at the Vatican via Boston!

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

El día 9 de junio del año 1597, falleció el jesuita José de Anchieta proveniente de las Islas Canarias, España. Este santo “apóstol de Brasil” fue beatificado en 1980 gracias a sus grandes esfuerzos humanitarios, literarios y evangelizadores en Brasil. Llegó a Brasil en 1553 donde aprendió Tup, el idioma de los nativos. Ensañaba a los indígenas, evangelizándolos con la doctrina cristiana y educándolos en historia, filosofía y medicina. Eventualmente fundó el colegio jesuita de Sao Paulo de Piratinminga donde tuvo la audacia de educar, junto a los hijos de los nativos, los hijos de los portugueses. Para este esfuerzo escribió muchos libros y manuales, cosa que le mereció ser el primer escritor en Brasil.

Además de ser un escritor prolífico, este misionero dedicó su vida a predicar el Evangelio en Brasil, país que cruzó a pie, fundando pueblos y escuelas para los indígenas cristianos. Estos le llamaban el “santo volador” por la velocidad con que caminaba. Su celo por el Evangelio lo motivaba a seguir caminando. Como dice el profeta Isaías: “Que hermosos son los pies del que trae buena nuevas”

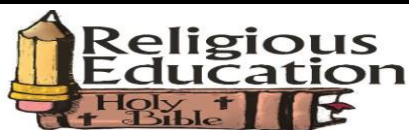
