The Pastor's Corner

So early in our Lenten season, only the Second Sunday of Lent, and we already hear the glorious account of Jesus' transfiguration. If we picture Lent as a season of penance and the desert, why does the Church present the radiance of Christ's heavenly splendor?

As Catholics, we seek to be bearers of the cross, ready to offer up our sufferings, and even pursuing penance for ourselves. But our love of the cross, our affinity with suffering, does not come from a valuing of suffering in and of itself, but rather a recognition that it's in the cross that Christ's victorious love shines through.

In this world, the only way true love can be expressed is through suffering. But we absolutely don't see suffering as a good thing in itself, or otherwise Hell would be an ideal place. In the next world, it's superabundantly clear that love flourishes in a realm without suffering, that suffering swirls in a domain without love. It's only in this life that the two are commingled, and as Jesus reveals, that love can only be accessed through suffering.

And so the experience of the Transfiguration this early in the Lenten season ensures that we recognize the purpose of our trials, the reason for our fasts. We deliberately seek out affliction, choosing fasts and deprivations for ourselves, but it is for the purpose of letting our hearts be transfigured by love, for the purpose of aligning ourselves with the cross of victory.

Jesus calls us to accompany him up the high mountain. This mountain, either today's mountain of radiance, or the hill of Golgotha, allows us to experience the love of Christ, and be readied for full immersion in that love.

El Rincón del Párroco

Tan temprano en nuestra temporada cuaresmal, sólo el segundo domingo de Cuaresma, y ya oímos el relato glorioso de la Transfiguración de Jesús. Si imaginamos la Cuaresma como una temporada de penitencia y el desierto, ¿por qué la Iglesia presenta el resplandor del esplendor celestial de Cristo?

Como católicos, buscamos ser portadores de la Cruz, dispuestos a ofrecer nuestros sufrimientos, e incluso persiguiendo la penitencia por nosotros mismos. Pero nuestro amor por la Cruz, nuestra afinidad con el sufrimiento, no viene de una valoración del sufrimiento en sí mismo, sino más bien de un reconocimiento de que está en la cruz que el amor victorioso de Cristo brilla.

En este mundo, la única manera en que el amor verdadero puede ser expresado es a través del sufrimiento. Pero absolutamente no vemos el sufrimiento como algo bueno en sí mismo, o de lo contrario el infierno sería un lugar ideal. En el próximo mundo, es superabundantemente claro que el amor florece en un reino sin sufrimiento, que el sufrimiento es remolinos en un dominio sin amor. Es sólo en esta vida que los dos están mezclados, y como Jesús revela, que el amor sólo se puede alcanzar a través del sufrimiento.

Y así, la experiencia de la Transfiguración a comienzos de la temporada de Cuaresma asegura que reconozcamos el propósito de nuestras pruebas, la razón de nuestros ayunos. Buscamos deliberadamente aflicción, escogiendo ayunos y privaciones para nosotros mismos, pero es con el propósito de dejar que nuestros corazones sean transfigurados por el amor, con el propósito de alinearnos con la Cruz de la victoria. Jesús nos llama a acompañarlo hasta la montaña alta. Esta montaña, ya sea la montaña de resplandor de hoy, o la colina de Gólgota, nos permite experimentar el amor de Cristo, y ser preparado para la inmersión completa en ese amor.

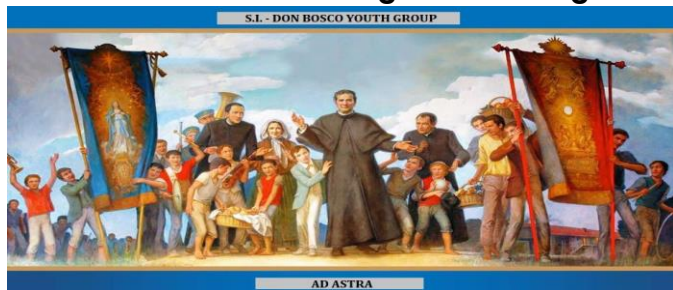

RCIA: Full of Excitement!

Discernment is now over for those who have spent a year or more in the Catechumenate- They have found themselves turning away from sin, their relationship with God has grown, they understand and believe the truths taught by the Catholic Church, and they are longing to receive the *Sacraments of Initiation- Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist*. We have heard their excitement, especially about receiving Jesus in the Eucharist! (Do we still have this excitement?) This weekend at the 5 pm Mass the unbaptized will go through the Rite of Sending. This is an opportunity for our parish community to express our approval of those in our RCIA Catechumenate. We will send all candidates forth to the Rite of Election (for the unbaptized) and the Call to Continuing Conversion (for those already baptized in other faiths) the next day, the 18th. These candidates will be with our bishop at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament in Sacramento. The unbaptized will now be called the Elect, those that are baptized have already been chosen/elected. This now marks the beginning of their final, more intense preparation for the sacraments of initiation needed to be in full communion with the Catholic Church. They will enter into the period of PURIFICATION AND ENLIGHTENMENT which will end with them receiving their sacraments at the Easter Vigil.
