

The Pastor's Corner

Our last Sunday—the last in Ordinary Time before Lent begins with Ash Wednesday this week. Now we can consider what our Lenten practices will be this year. What will be our special prayer, intentional penance, additional works of mercy and generosity?

The forty days we begin present an opportunity for God to transform us and, we believe, our prayer, fasting and almsgiving can transform other's lives as well. Here at Saint Isidore we witness that particularly in our Lenten practice of 40 Days for Life, taking the days of Lent to pray in front of our local abortion clinic.

We believe that intercession can transform the heart of another. Jesus in our Gospel today tells us, "You have heard that it was said, You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy. But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." In our society today, there is no greater persecution than the violence against the unborn, the practice of abortion taking the life of an innocent victim. Jesus calls us to recognize that our prayer can transform any heart, even the heart of one set against the weak and vulnerable.

You can sign up with 40 Days for Life to spend an hour this Lent praying in front of the local Planned Parenthood clinic. And you also can join us at church every Friday at 3:00, when for these weeks of Lent we will walk in Eucharistic Procession through the streets to our local clinic, where we can pray with Jesus in the Eucharist before returning to the church by 5:00.

Let this Lent be a time of transformation, not only for you in your prayer, fasting and almsgiving, but also for others and our society as your prayers effectively bring about change. We believe in the power of prayer; Jesus teaches us that we are required to pray, especially for those who persecute others. This Lent, take up with your brothers and sisters here in the parish the particular prayer for life, life for all.

Nuestro último domingo-- el último domingo del tiempo Ordinario antes de que comience la Cuaresma con el Miércoles de Ceniza esta semana. Ahora podemos considerar cuáles serán nuestras prácticas cuaresmales este año. ¿Cuál será nuestra oración especial, penitencia intencional, obras adicionales de misericordia y generosidad?

Los cuarenta días que comenzamos presentan una oportunidad para que Dios nos transforme y, creemos, nuestra oración, ayuno y limosna también pueden transformar la vida de los demás. Aquí en San Isidro lo presenciamos particularmente en nuestra práctica cuaresmal de 40 Días por la Vida, tomando los días de Cuaresma para orar frente a nuestra clínica local de aborto.

Creemos que la intercesión puede transformar el corazón de otro. Jesús en nuestro Evangelio hoy nos dice: "Habéis oído que se dijo: Amarás a tu prójimo y odiarás a tu enemigo. Pero yo les digo que amen a sus enemigos y oren por los que los persiguen." En nuestra sociedad actual, no hay mayor persecución que la violencia contra el no nacido, la práctica del aborto que se lleva la vida de una víctima inocente. Jesús nos llama a reconocer que nuestra oración puede transformar cualquier corazón, incluso el corazón de uno contra los débiles y vulnerables.

Puede inscribirse a 40 Días Por La Vida para que pase una hora esta Cuaresma rezando frente a la clínica local de Planned Parenthood. Y también puede unirse a nosotros en la iglesia todos los viernes a las 3:00 pm, cuando durante estas semanas de Cuaresma caminaremos en Procesión Eucarística por las calles hasta nuestra clínica local, donde podremos orar con Jesús en la Eucaristía antes de regresar a la iglesia a las 5:00 pm.

Que esta Cuaresma sea un tiempo de transformación, no sólo para ustedes en su oración, ayuno y limosna, sino también para los demás y nuestra sociedad, ya que sus oraciones provocan efectivamente el cambio. Creemos en el poder de la oración; Jesús nos enseña que estamos obligados a orar, especialmente por aquellos que persiguen a los demás. Esta Cuaresma, retomemos con nuestros hermanos y hermanas de la parroquia la oración particular por la vida, por la vida para todos.



Across the entire world, Catholic bishops on the first Sunday of Lent will welcome those sent by the parish to gather together with their godparents and sponsors in what is known as the *Rite of Election* and *Call to Continuing Conversion*. The *Rite of Sending*, which will be celebrated at the Sat. Vigil Mass on Feb. 29, offers the parish community an opportunity to acknowledge the spiritual progress the catechumens and candidates have made in RCIA, express approval of their election or recognition, and send them forth to our bishop with assurance of the parish's care and support. To send a catechumen or candidate to the bishop means that a parish has discerned that the person is ready to enter the Catholic Church (or if baptized, to make their Profession of Faith and/or complete their Sacraments of Initiation).

In Sacred Scripture, the Book of Revelation makes reference to a "Book of Life," in which are written the names of those who have chosen to follow the Lord Jesus and be baptized. Those who are already baptized, as Catholics or in other denominations, had our names written in the Book of Life at our Baptism. In this Rite, those preparing for Baptism are invited to come forward and sign a book, called the "Book of the Elect" as a sign of their desire to be numbered among the chosen of God. Please continue to keep all of our inquirers, catechumens and candidates in your prayers!

Please be aware that there will be a couple rows reserved for the catechumens and candidates and their sponsors/godparents at the Vigil Mass on Feb. 29 on the left side of the church toward the front.

If you or someone you know is thinking about becoming Catholic, desires to complete their Sacraments of Initiation, or would like to know what the Catholic Church teaches, please call the office at 530-673-1573, check us out online at stisidore-yubacity.org, or email Helen Gomez at hgomez@stisidore-yubacity.org for more information.
