The Pastor's Corner

The Church's calendar reverses chronology in her calendar with the arrival of the Magi commemorated following Herod's response after their departure. Epiphany, which we celebrate today, marks the light of Christ reaching to the world as the wise men bring their offerings to the newborn king, while on December 28th each year Herod's rage is marked in his slaughtering the infants of Bethlehem.

The Octave of Christmas illuminates the birth of the Church with a series of commemorations. The second day of Christmas is always devoted to the protomartyr Stephen, first to give his life for Jesus, while the third day, December 27th, celebrates the evangelist we read Christmas morning, John who gives us the theme of light breaking into our darkness. And as we celebrated last Sunday, the Holy Family forms the basis for each of our families, cornerstone of the Church.

So with the Church having honored the Holy Innocents of the fourth day of Christmas, December 28th, we arrive now at Epiphany and the Magi's arrival already aware of the shadow looming over Bethlehem. Yet even in this bitter cruelty of Herod the hand of God is discernible: as the angel guides Joseph to rescue the mother and infant, so also the infants still unable to speak nevertheless become the first to witness to Jesus. You and I who are able to speak, who volitionally can make the choice to testify to Jesus, can take inspiration from those chosen by God to witness to him even before they were aware.

We want our words to testify to Christ; we want our actions to reveal his presence in the world. But recognizing that our ability to witness comes from the same God who, as the Mass declares on the 28th, grants justification even to those who lack understanding, allows us to draw from the true source of grace, instead of mistakenly relying on our own efforts.

El Rincón Del Pastor

El calendario de la iglesia invierte la cronología en su calendario con la conmemorada llegada de los Reyes Magos seguida por la respuesta de Herodes después de su partida. Epifanía, que celebramos hoy, marca la luz de Cristo alcanzando al mundo mientras los Reyes Magos traen sus ofrendas al rey recién nacido, al mismo tiempo que el 28 de diciembre de cada año es marcado con la ira de Herodes en su matanza de los inocentes de Belén.

La octava de Navidad ilumina el nacimiento de la iglesia con una serie de conmemoraciones. El segundo día de Navidad siempre está dedicado al protomártir Esteban, primero en dar su vida por Jesús, mientras que el tercer día, el 27 de diciembre, celebra al evangelista que leemos la mañana de Navidad, Juan, que nos da el tema de la luz en nuestra oscuridad. Y como celebramos el domingo pasado, la Sagrada Familia constituye la base para cada una de nuestras familias, el pilar de la iglesia.

Así que con la iglesia que honra a los santos inocentes del cuarto día de la Navidad, el 28 de diciembre, llegamos ahora a la Epifanía y llegada de los Reyes Magos ya conscientes de la sombra que se cierne sobre Belén. Sin embargo, incluso en esta amarga残酷 de Herodes es discernible la mano de Dios: como el ángel guía a José para rescatar a la madre y al niño, así también los niños que aún no hablan son los primeros en presenciar a Jesús. Tú y yo que somos capaces de hablar, que voluntariamente podemos tomar la decisión de testificar a Jesús, podemos tomar la inspiración de los elegidos por Dios a ser testimonios incluso antes de que fueran conscientes.

Queremos nuestras palabras para testificar a Cristo; queremos nuestras acciones para revelar su presencia en el mundo. Pero reconociendo que nuestra capacidad de ser testigos viene del mismo Dios que, como declara la Misa el día 28, otorga justificación incluso a quienes carecen de comprensión, nos permite tomar de la verdadera fuente de gracia, en lugar de confiarnos erróneamente en nuestros propios esfuerzos.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Monday of this week is Christmas Day in Russia and in much of the Orthodox world. This curious difference in schedule has a lot to do with how calendars have been developed and changed over the years. In the year 45 B.C. Julius Caesar gave the empire his Julian Calendar, with the winter solstice on January 6. This put an end to a system in which officials called “pontiffs” were able to tweak the calendar by adding extra days in as needed. He invented two new months at that time, December and January; and in order to correct the mess the pontiffs had made, forced a year of 445 days on the empire in what he named “The Last Year of Confusion.” The new months varied in number of days according to a complex schedule, but the calendar was still off by nearly twelve minutes a year, and lost a full day every 130 years.

Pope Gregory XIII reformed the calendar in 1583, but not everyone appreciated his efforts. England held out for two hundred years. The year 1700 was a leap year in England, but not in France; they were eleven days apart! George Washington was really born on February 11; when the Gregorian calendar was finally adopted in the English colonies shortly before the Revolution, he had to move his birthday to February 22. Now the calendars are thirteen days apart, which accounts for Russia’s Julian calendar Christmas. And Caesar thought he had brought confusion to an end!

Did you know money is mentioned in the Bible 800 times?

Is tithing mentioned in the Old Testament or is it an Old Testament practice of the law? What is the purpose of tithing? There are many questions around tithing and giving money to the church and God's Word has plenty to say about it! Money is mentioned over 800 times in the Bible! God knew money would be something we would hold tightly to and place a lot of importance on. The following Bible verses should help you decide how you can thank God for what He has blessed you with.

Genesis 14:19-20

19 and he blessed Abram, saying, "Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth. **20** And praise be to God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand." Then Abram gave him a tenth of everything.


Mark 12:41-44

41 Jesus sat down opposite the place where the offerings were put and watched the crowd putting their money into the temple treasury. Many rich people threw in large amounts. **42** But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a few cents. **43** Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. **44** They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything—all she had to live on."

Give, and it will be given to you. Good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap. For with the measure you use it will be measured back to you."

As cited in the Catechism (No. 2043), the Precepts of the Church maintain that each person has the duty to support the material needs of the Church. Of course a person fulfills this obligation according to his abilities. The Code of Canon Law also states, "The Christian faithful are obliged to assist with the needs of the Church so that the Church has what is necessary for divine worship for apostolic works and works of charity end for the decent sustenance of ministers" (No. 222). However, the Church does not mandate a "tithe" as such of any percentage of income or other resource. We are stewards of God's gifts and each one of us are held accountable for the usage of them. At the beginning of this new year, take time to examine your usage of the gifts God has given you.






