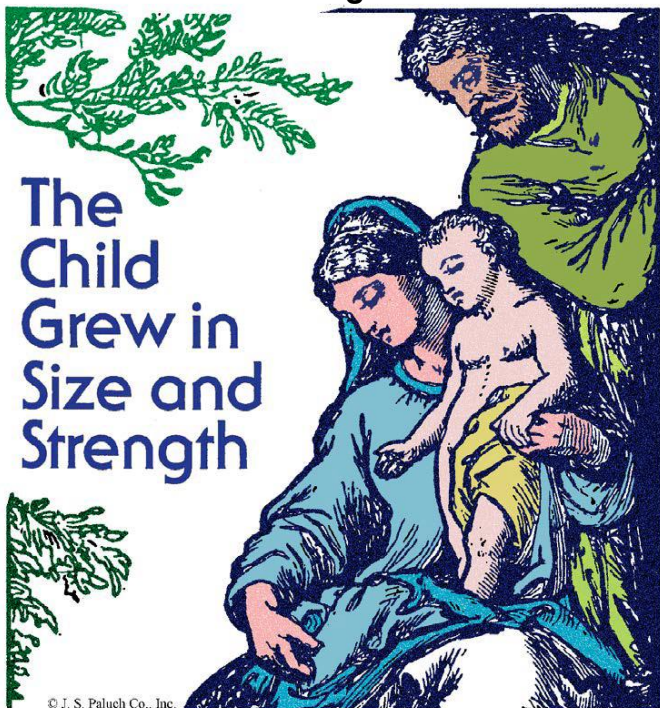

The Pastor's Corner

Glory to God in the Highest! And Peace to his people on earth!

The angelic choirs which eternally stand in rank before the throne of God now break into our world. They thunder with the revelation of Christ's presence. We were used to darkness, we were used to the slow oblivion that caused us to forget about the radiance of heaven. But God has not been dormant, nor his legions before his throne.

And the mystery to which the angels call us is humble, simple, and almost missable. They call us into the presence of a family, a family which can become our own.

This year, our final day is the Solemnity of the Holy Family. As we witness mother and child, husband and wife, proclaimed by the angel hosts to the shepherds, we see God's intention reconfirmed to renew all things by means of the family.

The family was God's original creation, as he formed the first couple, male and female, and instructed them, "Be fertile and multiply, fill the earth and subdue it." The family, with all of its trials, with its joys and sorrows, remains God's primary template for bringing grace into our world.

As we arrive at this final day of the year, and the flinging wide of new beginnings, we discover that our God's plans for us are renewed in the light of his Son, a Son who redeems all parents, a Son who becomes brother to all.

In Genesis 15:5, God instructs Abram to look up to the stars and count them, if he can. God draws Abram's vision to the most immense to reveal to him the purpose of the most close at hand, his own family and descendants. Beginning this new year, we can look to the vast grandeur of God's plan and perceive how he is working through what is closest to us: bringing miracles to our homes and loved ones.
