

Like the mystery of the Trinity, the real presence of the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist can never be fully understood, but can only be believed. Just as the Israelites in the desert were invited to put their trust in God's word to them, we are invited to trust wholly in the word of Jesus. In today's Gospel Jesus promises to give us a share in his very own flesh and blood, and a share in eternal life besides. Blood is poured and flesh is broken,
Yet in either wondrous token
Christ entire we know to be.

Whoso of this food partakes,
Does not rend the Lord nor breaks;
Christ is whole to all that taste.

Today is one of the rare liturgies of the year, like Easter and Pentecost, which has a sequence as a part of the readings. Entitled Lauda Sion, it speaks of today's feast day of the Body and Blood of Christ. In the two stanzas selected above, the sequence sings of this extraordinary mystery that our sharing in the Eucharist means a sharing in the fullness of Jesus in his risen life.

Thousands are, as one, receivers,
One, as thousands of believers,
Eats of him who cannot waste.

In these lines, we see the reason why we call the reception of Jesus' body and blood 'communion': to receive the Eucharist is to be brought into union with Jesus and with every other person who has received him.

Even as we recognize we ourselves are flawed and sinful as we approach the altar, we realize that in being united with Catholics around the world, we are united in our brokenness as well. But as Saint Paul reminds us in First Corinthians 11:29, "whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord unworthily will have to answer for the body and blood of the Lord."

Bad and good the feast are sharing,
Of what divers dooms preparing,
Endless death, or endless life.

Life to these, to those damnation,
See how like participation
Is with unlike issues rife.

If we unite mortal sin to the Body of Christ, we make our own condition worse. A solemnity like today draws back into focus how awesome, in the original sense of the word, this encounter is. We are united, without filter or buffer, to the Living God, the same God who stretched out the heavens and rules over the flood, who rained down the manna and drew up Elijah in chariots of fire. This gift of Jesus' Body and Blood calls us already now to let go of our small horizons and to enter the life of freedom.



Su sangre es nuestra bebida;

Hoy es una de las raras liturgias del año, igual que Semana Santa y Pentecostés, ya que hay una secuencia como parte de las lecturas. Titulada Lauda Sión, habla del día de la fiesta de hoy del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. En las dos estrofas seleccionadas anteriormente, la secuencia canta el misterio extraordinario Eucarístico del cual somos participes y el significado de la plenitud que tenemos en la vida del Jesús resucitado.

Puede ser tan sólo uno
el que se acerca al altar,
o pueden ser multitudes:
Cristo no se acabará.

Aun cuando reconocemos que somos imperfectos y pecadores al acercamos al altar, nos damos cuenta de que al estar unidos con los católicos alrededor del mundo, estamos unidos también en nuestro quebrantamiento. Pero como San Pablo nos recuerda en 1 Corintios 11:29: "El que come el pan o bebe de la copa del Señor indignamente, tendrá que responder por el cuerpo y la sangre del Señor".

Lo comen buenos y malos,
con provecho diferente;
no es lo mismo tener vida
que ser condenado a muerte.

A los malos les da muerte
y a los buenos les da vida.
¡Qué efecto tan diferente
tiene la misma comida!

Si unimos el pecado mortal al Cuerpo de Cristo, empeoramos nuestra condición. Una solemnidad como la de hoy vuelve a enfatizar cuán impresionante, en el sentido original de la palabra, es este encuentro. Estamos unidos, sin filtro, al Dios vivo, el mismo Dios que extendió los cielos y gobierna sobre el diluvio, que llovió el maná y levantó a Elías en carros de fuego. Este don del Cuerpo y de la Sangre de Jesús nos llama ahora a que nos deshagamos de nuestros pequeños horizontes y a entrar en la vida de la libertad.


