



BALANCE

Today's scriptures emphasize the fundamental link between love of God and love of our neighbors, especially those who are most in need. Love of God should compel us to love the people whom God cherishes. Conversely, work for justice and charity for those in need should be rooted in our love of God.

That connection and balance, however, isn't always easy to maintain in our lives. Even in religious orders we find that some Christians are more oriented toward contemplation and prayer, while others are more active in reaching out to those who are oppressed. Today Jesus reminds us of the necessity for both in the life of faith.

The Pastor's Corner

Whole Life Sunday.

Today Jesus gives us the greatest commandment, our highest priority, and it turns out it's not convenience. It's not control or even happiness. So many of the things we value as individuals, that we focus on as a society, turn out not to be what really counts.

The bishops of California gave this Sunday a special designation, Whole Life Sunday, because they recognize that here in California we're at particular risk of losing sight of our priorities and therefore our identity.


Society offers us the chance to control our own destiny, to manage our present and future, through the tools that technology brings us. Once we were at the mercy of our environment, but now we're being told we can gain power over both our beginning and our end.

Science now gives us the ability to choose when life enters this world and when it departs, with tools like abortion (and the contraceptives that precede it) and California's newly legalized euthanasia.

Of course, the basic action hasn't changed: Cain killed Abel with his bare hands. But we have a new guise now that allows us to feel like we're being offered something new and different.

This is why our California bishops have chosen this Sunday as a reminder: convenience, control or comfort are not what identify us, and our contemporary technologies do not change what our responsibilities to ourselves and others are.

Tragically, when we remove the first commandment and sever ourselves from our creator, we discover that our respect for our neighbor also collapses. Untethered, we find that our center of gravity collapses inward, and like Cain we are ready to manipulate our world to our own liking, even at the cost of our neighbor's life.

Domingo de Vida

Hoy Jesús nos da el mandamiento más grande, nuestra máxima prioridad, y resulta que no es algo que nos convenga. No es control ni felicidad. Muchas de las cosas que valoramos como individuos, en las que nos enfocamos como sociedad, no son lo que realmente importa.

Los obispos de California dieron este domingo una designación especial, Domingo de Vida, porque miran que aquí en California corremos un riesgo particular, el riesgo de perder de vista nuestras prioridades, nuestra identidad.

La sociedad nos ofrece la oportunidad de controlar nuestro destino, administrar nuestro presente y futuro, a través de las herramientas que nos brinda la tecnología. Una vez que estuvimos a merced de nuestro entorno, pero ahora nos dicen que podemos obtener poder tanto en nuestro comienzo como en nuestro fin.

La ciencia ahora nos da la capacidad de elegir cuándo la vida entra en este mundo y cuando termina, con herramientas como el aborto (y los anticonceptivos que la preceden) y la eutanasia recientemente legalizada de California.

Por supuesto, la acción básica no ha cambiado: Caín mató a Abel con sus propias manos. Pero ahora tenemos una nueva apariencia, permitiendo que sintamos que nos ofrecen algo nuevo y diferente.

Esta es la razón por la que nuestros obispos de California han elegido este domingo como un recordatorio: la conveniencia, el control o la comodidad no son lo que nos identifican, la tecnología contemporánea no cambia nuestras responsabilidades con nosotros mismos ni con los demás.

Trágicamente, cuando eliminamos el primer mandamiento y nos separamos de nuestro creador, descubrimos que el respeto por nuestro vecino también colapsa. Sin ataduras, descubrimos que nuestro centro de gravedad se colapsa hacia adentro y, como Caín, estamos dispuestos a manipular nuestro mundo a nuestro gusto, incluso a costa de la vida de nuestro prójimo.



Catechesis of the Good Shepherd



Hemos estado muy emocionados estas últimas semanas por el inicio del nuevo año en el atrio.


