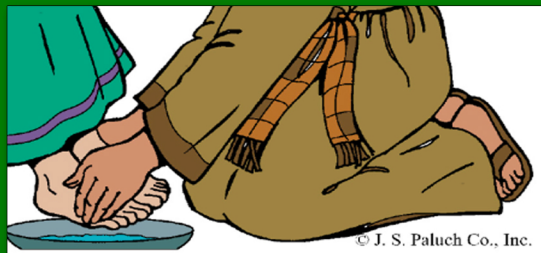

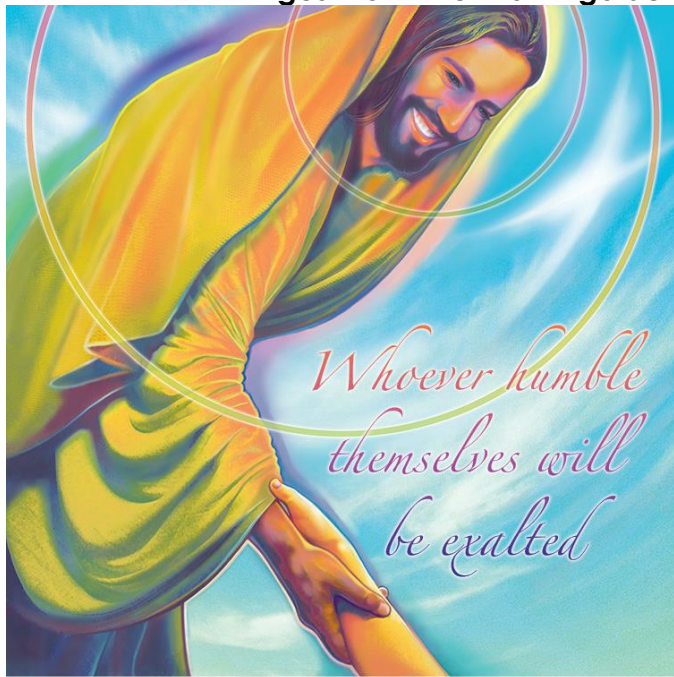

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THE GREATEST AMONG US

Whom do you admire? Is it the President of the United States or a movie star or a billionaire? These are people whom the world exalts as great. Like the Pharisees in today's Gospel, they have places of honor wherever they go. Would you like to follow in their footsteps?

The scriptures for today offer different examples for us to follow. Jesus tells us that the greatest among us are the servants. These are the people we are to honor and imitate. We are called to be like Paul, who worked hard to serve the needs of his communities, and Jesus, who gave his life in service to the world.

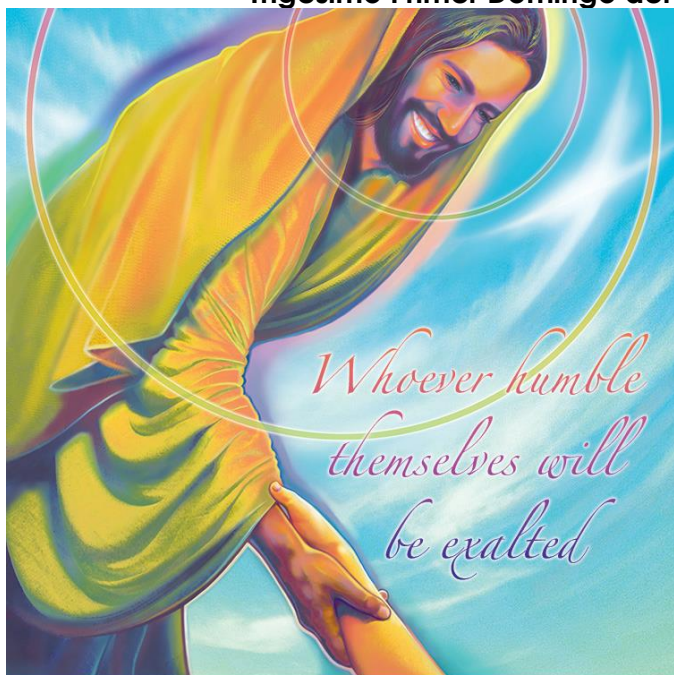
The Pastor's Corner

In beginning the month of November this last week we celebrated the beautiful solemnity of All the Saints, followed by the commemoration of All Souls November 2nd. Throughout this month the veil to heaven will remain thin, as those who have gone before us remain on our hearts. Our prayers for the souls of the departed in November confirms that the separation of this life from the next is not definitive, and that we eagerly anticipate crossing the threshold of eternity even as we intercede for the departed to experience the fullness of God's peace.

Paul today reminds us of this urgency of reuniting the Body of Christ, the urgency of ensuring no one is left out of this communion of life. Ultimately, our concern that our brothers and sisters be fully united with Jesus becomes much more than a task and becomes our entire identity. Saint Paul today writes: "With such affection for you, we were determined to share with you not only the gospel of God, but our very selves as well." Whether we are praying for the departed, or reaching out to a neighbor, we are sharing our heart with others.

This vigor can truly reflect who we are, but Jesus warns us today how easy it is for religion to become just a shell that forgets God's original call to us and our call to others. Condemning the scribes and Pharisees he says, "They tie up heavy burdens hard to carry and lay them on people's shoulders, but they will not lift a finger to move them." It's so easy for us to allow our vision to slip and to start to see the Faith as an external imposition, something that restricts from the outside, but not something that revitalizes us from within: like a heavy backpack we feel duty bound to carry, or which we shrug off in disdain, religion becomes a shell on the outside.

As we pray for the departed this month, as we witness the closeness of the saints to us, our prayers can also change our hearts, so we are reignited with the passion that allows us to plunge into the fullness of God's life and word and bring it to others.

El Rincón del Párroco

Al comienzo de este mes de noviembre celebramos la hermosa solemnidad de Todos los Santos, seguida por la conmemoración de Todos los fieles difuntos el 2 de noviembre. A lo largo de este mes, estaremos recordando a aquellos que nos precedieron y permanecen en nuestros corazones. Nuestras oraciones por las almas de los difuntos en noviembre confirman que la separación de esta vida y la siguiente no es definitiva, y que anticipamos ansiosamente cruzar el umbral de la eternidad incluso mientras intercedemos por los difuntos para experimentar la plenitud de la paz de Dios.

Hoy, Pablo nos recuerda esta urgencia de reunir el Cuerpo de Cristo, la urgencia de asegurar que nadie quede fuera de esta comunión de vida. En última instancia, nuestra preocupación de que nuestros hermanos y hermanas estén totalmente unidos a Jesús se convierte en mucho más que una tarea y se convierte en nuestra identidad completa. San Pablo escribe hoy: "Tan grande es nuestro afecto por ustedes, que hubiéramos querido entregarles, no solamente el Evangelio de Dios, sino también nuestra propia vida". Ya sea que estemos orando por los difuntos, o actuando con solidaridad con nuestro prójimo, estamos compartiendo nuestro corazón con los demás.

Este vigor realmente puede reflejar quiénes somos, pero Jesús nos advierte hoy sobre lo fácil que es olvidar el llamado original de Dios para nosotros y nuestro llamado a los demás. Al condenar a los escribas y fariseos, dice: "Hacen fardos muy pesados y difíciles de llevar y los echan sobre las espaldas de los hombres, pero ellos ni con el dedo los quieren mover". Es muy fácil para nosotros permitir que nuestra visión se deslice y comenzamos a ver la fe como una imposición externa, algo que restringe desde el exterior, no algo que nos revitaliza desde adentro: como una pesada mochila que nos sentimos obligados a llevar, incluso con desprecio, la religión se convierte en un cascarón.

Al orar por los difuntos este mes, y ser testigos de la cercanía de los santos y nosotros, nuestras oraciones pueden cambiar nuestros corazones, ya que somos reavivados con la pasión que nos permite sumergirnos en la palabra de Dios y en la vida plena y así atraer a otros.

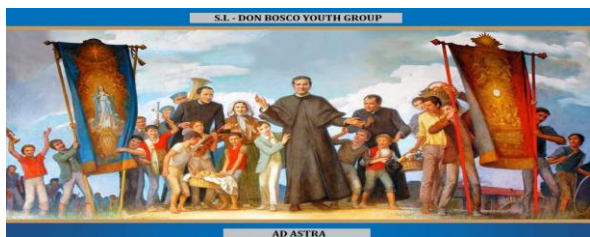

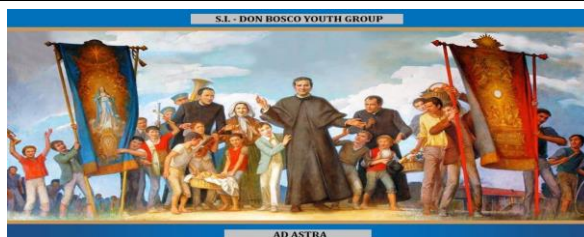
Catequesis Del Buen Pastor

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TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

What is the name of the pope's cathedral? If you said the Vatican, or St. Peter's, you were off by a few miles, since the answer is the Basilica of St. John, the Lateran, the "Mother Church" of all the churches of the world and the cathedral of the Diocese of Rome. It takes its name from the Lateran family, the Trumps of their day, who somehow ran afoul of the Emperor Nero. He seized all their property, including their vast Roman palace and estate. We don't know how Plautius displeased Nero so badly, but eventually all the Lateran property came to Constantine, the first Christian emperor, through his wife, Fausta. Early in the fourth century, when Christianity was at last legalized, Constantine gave the property to the church. Soon the great meeting halls were expanded and adapted.

Over the centuries, the church building has been sacked by armies, ruined by fire, torn down, and rebuilt. The oldest and most unchanged part of the Lateran is a vast, separate baptistery with steps leading down to a huge green basalt pool. Imagine what a triumphal moment the dedication of this public church building was for a community that had worshiped in secret for so long! This Thursday's feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica is really about the tradition of consecrating space for worship, and so by extension, a feast for your parish church building and, given the beautiful second reading, for its baptistery as well.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Esta semana celebramos la memoria de la Iglesia madre de la cristiandad. Por extraña coincidencia, no está en Jerusalén donde nació la Iglesia, tampoco es la Basílica de San Pedro en el Vaticano, donde está el sepulcro (o la tumba) de san Pedro. Esta iglesia es la Basílica que está dedicada a la memoria del Divino Salvador, a san Juan Bautista y a san Juan Evangelista. Fue la primera basílica consagrada en el año 324 al culto cristiano en Roma.

De allí ha tenido una larga trayectoria, y aunque es la catedral del obispo de Roma, el Papa se trasladó al Vaticano en 1377, luego de que el papado estuvo durante un período de 100 años en Francia.

Al recordar la consagración de la Basílica de Letrán no debemos olvidar lo que dice san Pablo: "Cada uno de nosotros somos un templo del Espíritu Santo" (1 Corintios 6:19). En un sueño, Inocencio III vio que Letrán estaba por caerse, pero san Francisco pudo sostenerla en pie. Ojalá que cada vez que nosotros estemos por caer, llegue alguien que nos pueda sostener como templos de Dios.
