

The responsorial psalm continues to paint a picture of a place where only goodness and kindness flourish. These readings describe the heavenly banquet, to which God calls each of us through baptism and continues to call us throughout our lives. Let us "RSVP" to God's invitation and live our lives consistent with gospel values so that one day we will be welcomed to the table of the kingdom.

## The Pastor's Corner

Do you remember how our first reading last week matched the Gospel? Isaiah told us a story--sang us a song, actually--about his friend who planted a vineyard, and then in the Gospel Jesus told us a story about a landowner who did the same thing.

Today again, we find Isaiah preparing us for what Jesus will teach us in the Gospel. Amazingly, Isaiah is telling us about an incredible feast, but a feast that is stronger than death. This feast is in a special place, 'this mountain', which we can recognize as Mount Zion where Jerusalem is built. On this mountain, Isaiah says, the Lord will destroy death forever.


If we were to discover a way we could have power over death, a way we could keep death from having power over us, it would completely change who we were. When we are afraid of death so many things can have power over us. Over and over again, around the world, we see if a group threatens someone saying, "We're going to kill you!", they can manipulate the person how they want.

If instead we were unstoppable, if not even death could trap us, we could live in a new way: we could be fearless. That's a good reason to find out what this mountain is, where this banquet is being held.

Jesus also tells us about this banquet, but he adds in two more descriptions. He says it's a wedding party, and he mentions a kingdom, the kingdom of heaven. Jesus, who is fearless, Jesus, who is not afraid of death, points us to a marriage and a realm that can completely change our identity, and like Isaiah, he shows it to us hidden in a meal.

Every Sunday, we gather for a meal, we gather for the Lord's Supper. When Jesus shared this meal with us, he said he was giving us his own body to eat, his own blood to drink: he said he had come from heaven and whoever ate his body and drank his blood would live forever: that person would never have to be afraid again.

Today, as we hear these passages, as Isaiah and Jesus allow God's light to shine in our lives, we can bring to God our fears, bring to this feast the ways we are anxious and pressured, and allow life in abundance to completely change who we are.

## El Rincón del Párroco

¿Recuerdan cómo la primera lectura de la semana pasada coincidía con el Evangelio? Isaías nos contó una historia - nos cantó una canción - acerca de su amigo que plantó una viña, y luego en el Evangelio Jesús nos contó una historia acerca de un propietario que hizo lo mismo.

Hoy de nuevo encontramos a Isaías preparándonos para lo que Jesús nos enseñará en el Evangelio. Sorprendentemente, Isaías nos está contando sobre una fiesta increíble, un banquete que es más fuerte que la muerte. Esta fiesta está en un lugar especial, "esta montaña", que podemos reconocer como el Monte Sión, donde se construye Jerusalén. En esta montaña, dice Isaías, el Señor destruirá la muerte para siempre.

Si hubiera una manera en que pudiéramos tener poder sobre la muerte, una forma en que pudiésemos evitar que la muerte tuviera poder sobre nosotros, cambiaría completamente quiénes somos. Cuando tenemos miedo de la muerte, muchas cosas se apoderan de nosotros. Una y otra vez, en todo el mundo, vemos como un grupo puede amenazar a alguien diciendo: "¡Vamos a matarte!" y manipulan a la persona como quieran.

Si en cambio fuéramos imparables, si ni siquiera la muerte pudiera atraparnos, podríamos vivir de manera diferente: podríamos ser destemplados. Esa es una buena razón para averiguar qué es esta montaña, donde se celebra este banquete.

Jesús también nos habla de este banquete, pero agrega en dos descripciones más. Él dice que es una fiesta de bodas, y menciona un reino, el reino de los cielos. Jesús, quien no tiene miedo, Jesús, quien no tiene miedo a la muerte, nos señala un matrimonio y un reino que puede cambiar completamente nuestra identidad, y como Isaías, nos lo muestra escondido en una comida.

Cada domingo, nos reunimos para una comida, nos reunimos para la Cena del Señor. Cuando Jesús compartió esta comida con nosotros, dijo que nos estaba dando su propio cuerpo para comer, su propia sangre para beber: dijo que había venido del cielo y quien comía su cuerpo y bebiera su sangre viviría para siempre: esa persona jamás temería.

Hoy, mientras escuchamos estos pasajes, como Isaías y Jesús permiten que la luz de Dios brille en nuestras vidas, podemos traerle a Dios nuestros temores, traer a esta fiesta nuestras ansiedades y permitir que la vida en abundancia cambie completamente quienes somos.



RCIA (*Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults*): Q & A  
Q. What are the stages a person goes through to become Catholic?

A. The first stage is called the Pre-Catechumenate, or Inquiry. In this stage, those who are inquiring about the Catholic faith are welcomed and receive answers to their questions about God and His Church. As they begin to establish or to deepen their relationship with Christ, a foundation is placed in this process from which to build upon.

If and when a person is ready to move forward on the path to becoming a disciple of Christ, they are invited to go through the RCIA Rite of Acceptance and Welcoming. This is the rite that moves them into the next stage, called the Catechumenate, where the foundation they were given in the Pre-Catechumenate will be built upon and their relationship with Christ will be strengthened and deepened.

The third stage is called the Period of Purification and Enlightenment, which coincides with Lent. Before Lent begins, prospective disciples will discern if they are ready to move forward and if so, they will participate in the Rite of Sending at the parish and attend the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion with the Bishop at the Cathedral. There are many liturgical rites during this stage that are designed to give grace and spiritual strength to the participants as they near the reception of their sacraments at the Easter Vigil.
