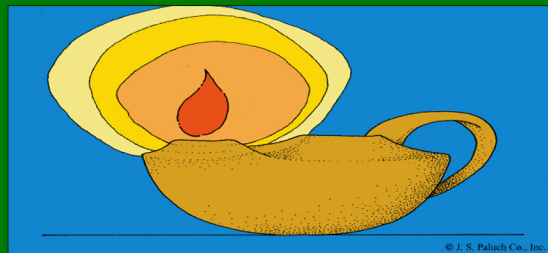

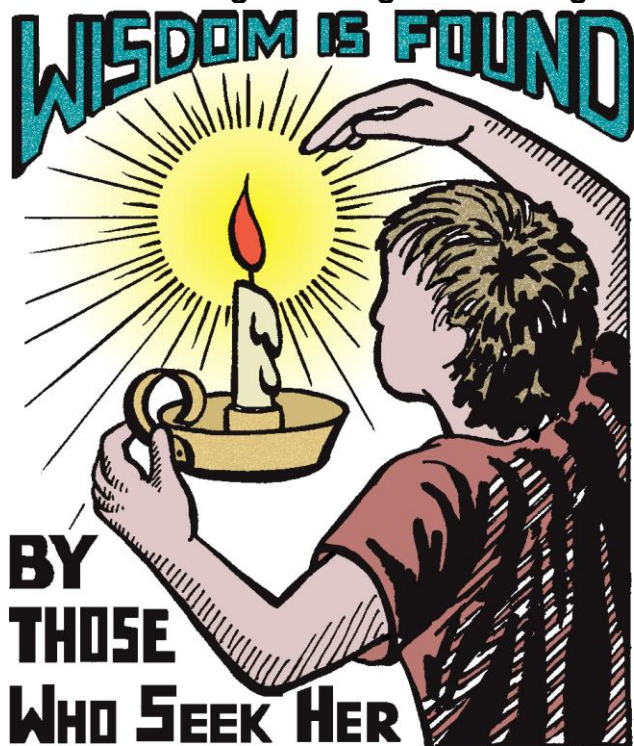

WISDOM

We consider wisdom today. The first reading from the book of Wisdom presents this precious gift as a feminine spirit, a very desirable virtue sought by many and graciously present to all who seek her. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable to illustrate wisdom in a practical, measurable way. The wise will conserve their resources, use them prudently, and mark the passing of time. The foolish, on the other hand, not planning ahead, will be in the dark. Both of these readings tell us how accessible wisdom is to all who simply and honestly seek it.

Paul's words to the Thessalonians are not about wisdom, but describe one result of true wisdom: To the wise person of faith even death holds no terror. Our faith in Jesus' resurrection tells us we will all one day rise to new life in Christ.

The Pastor's Corner

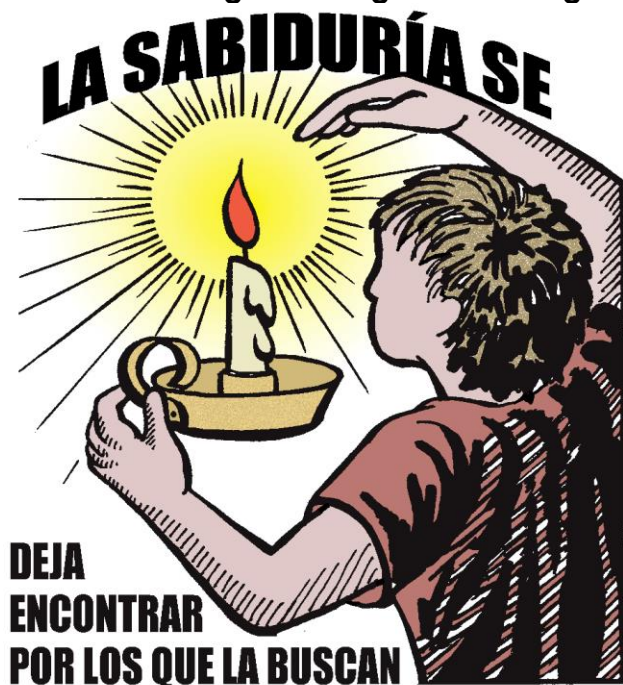
One of the changes in our society in the last few decades is the shift from valuing a person's character to valuing the personality. 60 years ago, a person was known by the character they had, the virtues and values they embodied. Then with the growing importance of television, we became attracted to personalities, even when they didn't reflect a deeper virtue rooted behind them.

Perhaps, following from our first reading today, we could notice a similar shift in valuing data and information over wisdom. While we often describe both knowledge and wisdom as being gifts of the Holy Spirit, our culture today prizes knowing things, knowledge, and has lost touch with the way of knowing we used to call wisdom. As our computers and phones develop more and more memory, linked by the cloud to larger and larger data vaults, we assume all you need is a fast processor to know all you need to know.

In contrast, the form of wisdom we find described in Wisdom chapter 6 today points to a person who has invested oneself, has endured patiently, has gained through trial a deeper insight. "Whoever watches for her at dawn," the author writes, "shall not be disappointed." The author describes an affinity between Wisdom and the individual: "she is readily perceived by those who love her," but as Proverbs and the other Wisdom Literature of the Old Testament describe, if you take her for granted you'll discover she's gone.

Jesus as well in the Gospel presents wisdom as a challenge: the five prudent virgins are the ones who undertook extra preparation, who thought through the responsibility they carried. For us who hear these passages today, we can recognize that wisdom for us also involves going deeper, choosing a path different from our peers who are content to follow the trends of society.

And as character goes deeper than personality, so wisdom goes deeper than head knowledge, or all the data our digital world offers us today. And ultimately, for us who have discovered that the Word of God is more than information, and is himself a person, this Wisdom, this Word, draws us into an encounter that changes who we are completely.

Nuestro tema de hoy es la sabiduría. La primera lectura del Libro de la Sabiduría presenta este valioso regalo como un espíritu femenino, una virtud muy deseable buscada por muchos y posible, por la gracia de Dios, para todos los que la buscan. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús relata una parábola para ilustrar de una manera práctica y concreta qué es la sabiduría. Los sabios conservan sus recursos, los usan prudentemente, con atención al paso del tiempo. Los tontos, por otro lado, por no planear su futuro, quedarán en la oscuridad. Las dos lecturas indican lo accesible que es la sabiduría a todos los que la buscan de manera sencilla y sincera.

Las palabras de Pablo no tocan directamente el tema de la sabiduría, pero describen un resultado de la verdadera sabiduría: A la persona sabia de fe ni la muerte le asusta, porque nuestra fe en la resurrección de Jesús nos dice que todos vamos a despertar a una vida nueva en Cristo.

El Rincón del Párroco

Uno de los cambios en nuestra sociedad en las últimas décadas ha sido el cambio de valorar la personalidad de la persona y no el carácter. Hace 60 años, las personas eran conocidas por el carácter que tenían, las virtudes y sus valores. Con crecimiento de la televisión, nos sentimos atraídos por las personalidades, que no reflejan virtudes profundas.

Quizás, siguiendo la primera lectura de hoy, podríamos notar un cambio similar al valorar datos e información por encima de la sabiduría. A menudo describimos el conocimiento y la sabiduría como dones del Espíritu Santo, la cultura de hoy, sin embargo, premia el conocimiento y ha perdido el sentido a la sabiduría. A medida que nuestras computadoras y teléfonos celulares desarrollan más y más memoria, asumimos que todo lo que necesitamos es un procesador más rápido para saber todo lo que necesitamos saber.

Por el contrario, la sabiduría que se nos describe en el capítulo 6 del libro de Sabiduría señala a una persona que se ha dedicado a sufrir pacientemente, que a través de las pruebas a adquirido una visión más profunda. "Quien por ella se desvela pronto se verá libre de preocupación" escribe el autor. El autor describe una afinidad entre la Sabiduría y el individuo: "con facilidad la contemplan quienes la aman", pero como describen Proverbios y la otra Literatura de Sabiduría del Antiguo Testamento, si no la valoras, descubrirás que ya no está.

En el Evangelio, Jesús también nos presenta la sabiduría como un desafío: las cinco vírgenes prudentes son las que se prepararon más, las que pensaron en la responsabilidad que tenían. Los que escuchamos estos pasajes, podemos reconocer que la sabiduría implica tener que profundizar, y elegir un camino diferente al de nuestros prójimos quienes son felices siguiendo las tendencias de la sociedad.

Y a medida que el carácter va más allá que la personalidad, la sabiduría también va más allá del conocimiento intelectual o de todos los datos que nuestro mundo digital nos ofrece hoy en día. Finalmente, para nosotros que hemos descubierto que la Palabra de Dios es más que información, y él mismo es una persona, esta Sabiduría, esta Palabra, nos lleva a un encuentro que cambia por completo quienes somos.

NEW HOSPITALITY MINISTRY!

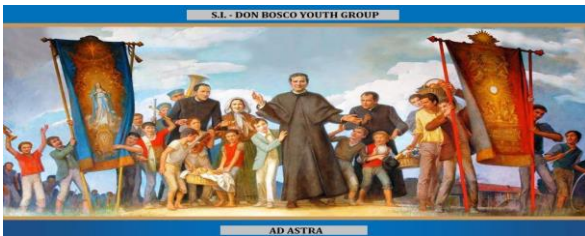

¡NUEVO MINISTERIO DE HOSPITALIDAD!

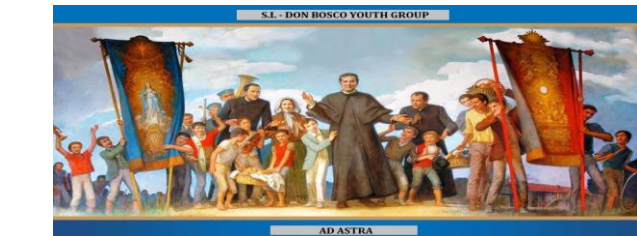
