THIS LITTLE LIGHT OF MINE

As children we sang the lively song *This Little Light of Mine*. The words, of course, are based on today's Gospel, in which we are called as disciples to be salt and light for the world. Children are uninhibited about sharing their faith. It's only when we grow older that we prefer to hide our light under a bushel basket because our culture tends not to emphasize discipleship. The message in this week's readings is clear: in order to give glory to God through our discipleship, we must show the light of Christ in our words and deeds. Not an easy thing for inhibited adults. Often we may think of salt and light in terms of what we do for others, but it can be just as important not to do something, such as getting angry with the stranger on the road, or telling an offensive joke.

MI PEQUEÑA LUZ

Cuando éramos niños cantábamos efusivamente la canción *Mi pequeña luz (This Little Light of Mine)*. La letra de la canción, desde luego, está basada en el Evangelio de hoy, en este estamos llamados como discípulos a ser la sal y la luz del mundo. Los niños no tienen dificultad para compartir su fe; solo es cuando crecemos que preferimos esconder nuestra luz bajo un tazón porque nuestra cultura tiende a no enfatizar el discipulado. El mensaje en las lecturas de esta semana es claro: para poder dar gloria a Dios por medio del discipulado, debemos mostrar la luz de Cristo en nuestras palabras y obras. No es algo fácil para adultos inhibidos. A menudo podemos pensar en la sal y la luz en términos de lo que hacemos por los demás, pero puede ser tan importante como el no hacer nada, ya sea como enojarse con un desconocido en la carretera o decir una broma ofensiva.

When Jesus looked out at his 12 disciples, when he looks at us, how does he envision our presence in this world? What's our engagement with others supposed to be?

It would have been great if he envisioned a ticker-tape parade, a bandwagon where we threw the candy and confetti, at the heart of a groundswell that saw banners overlaid with streamers affirming us as the winning team.

Instead, it appears that rather than fanfare and fame, today's Gospel indicates that Jesus anticipates a stealth approach, or at least our being the minority report against a vast backdrop.

What are the two images he uses to identify us today? Salt. Light. Last time I checked, when you're throwing together a recipe, salt is the minuscule ingredient in the mix. Light, whether coming from a candle, a light bulb, or an extraordinarily distant sun, is the anomaly in a room, shining on a multitude of objects of which none intrinsically share its illuminating qualities.

Later on in this same Gospel of Matthew, Jesus also uses the image of yeast, which, whether used in bread or beer making, is the teensiest part of the overall batch.

If we're going to take on the identity of Christians, it seems we should take on the mindset of our frontrunner, particularly since it looks like it means we're not destined to win popularity contests. In learning to be different, in being the distinctly distinct person on the block who affects everyone by standing out, we will get a lot closer to what Jesus originally envisioned.

This becomes particularly apparent if we scroll back a few lines from today's passage. Our Gospel today opens at Matthew 5:13, but if we return to 5:11-12, we find Jesus saying, "Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you falsely because of me. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven." Jesus anticipates that we're not going to fit in, which often can lead to some bumps and bruises along the way.

Jesus calls us to be the light of the world. In a terrain full of shadows, we are not called to fit in, or accept the darkness. Jesus calls us to be different, to be so different that those around us notice that everything has changed now that we've shown up. Be salt. Be light. Make a difference.



Cuando Jesús miró a sus 12 discípulos, cuando nos mira a nosotros, ¿cómo se imaginara nuestra presencia en este mundo? ¿Cuál es nuestro compromiso con los demás?

Hubiera sido estupendo si nos hubiera imaginado en un desfile, en un carro alegórico del cual lanzábamos dulces y confeti, y una corriente de banderas y letreros que nos afirmaran como el equipo ganador.

Mas bien, parece que ende ves del espectáculo y la fama, en el Evangelio de hoy Jesús indica que seamos pequeños oh por lo menos insignificantes en un mundo distraído.

¿Cuáles son los dos conceptos que utiliza para identificarnos hoy? Sal y Luz. La última vez que me fijé , cuando estamos cocinando una receta, la sal es el ingrediente minúsculo de la mezcla. La luz, procedente de una vela, de un foco o de un sol extraordinariamente lejano, es la anomalía en una habitación, que brilla sobre una multitud de objetos que por naturaleza ninguno comparte sus cualidades iluminadoras.

Despues, en este mismo Evangelio de Mateo, Jesús también usa el concepto de la levadura, que se utiliza en la fabricación de pan o cerveza, es el ingrediente más pequeño del montón.

Si nos vamos a identificar como cristianos, debemos asumir la mentalidad de nuestro líder, sobre todo porque parece que no estamos destinados a ganar concursos de popularidad. Al aprender a ser diferente, al ser la persona claramente distinta de los demás aquella que afecta a todos al destacarse, nos acercaremos mucho a lo que Jesús originalmente imaginó.

Esto se hace particularmente evidente si nos regresamos a unas pocas líneas en el pasaje de hoy. Nuestro Evangelio se abre hoy en Mateo 5:13, pero si volvemos a 5: 11-12, encontramos a Jesús diciendo: "Bienaventurados sois cuando os insulta y os persiguen y pronuncian toda clase de mal contra vosotros falsamente por causa mía. Regocijaos y alegraos, porque vuestra recompensa será grande en el cielo." Jesús anticipa que no vamos a encajar, lo que a menudo puede conducir a algunos golpes y moretones a lo largo del camino.

Jesús nos llama a ser la luz del mundo. En un terreno lleno de sombras, no estamos llamados a encajar o aceptar la oscuridad. Jesús nos llama a ser diferentes, a que cuando lleguemos a un lugar todos los presente note un cambio a nuestra llegada. Sean Sal. Sean Luz. Hagan la diferencia.



TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

When the custom of the station liturgies was revived in the city of Rome in the early days of the twentieth century, the papal liturgy for Good Friday was appropriately housed in the station church of *Santa Croce in Gerusalemme*, the Holy Cross of Jerusalem. The church is off the tourist track today, but true pilgrims would never miss it. It stands on the grounds of the Sessorian Palace, the home of the Empress St. Helena, mother of Constantine. She dedicated her life to finding the true cross of Christ in Jerusalem, and desired to found a church in Rome for people who could not make the long and dangerous trip to the Holy Land. Eventually, it came to house relics of the cross. When the pope fled the city of Rome for Avignon, the religious institutions of Rome collapsed and the church was abandoned. Centuries later it was given into the care of monks. Amazingly, it concealed a forgotten treasure. In 1492 repairmen took down a brick wall and discovered a niche with the inscription "Title of the Cross," and within, an ancient wooden tablet on which was carved the inscription dictated by Pilate for the cross of Christ in Hebrew, Latin, and Greek. No one is certain that this is authentic, although its discovery was enough to give the church great prestige among pilgrims. The veneration of the relic of the cross located here was a factor in shaping our restored Holy Week.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

La primera santa americana fue Rosa de Lima, peruana de nacimiento. Murió en 1617 y fue canonizada en 1671, diez años después de la primera fundación inglesa en lo que hoy son Estados Unidos de América. Esta santa americana es acompañada por otros santos como san Felipe de Jesús (mexicano) canonizado en 1862 y Madre Francisca Cabrini (italoestadounidense y la primera santa de EE. UU.) canonizada en 1946.

Oficialmente hay 60 santos y 77 beatos que nacieron o trabajaron en América. La mayoría de estos son 50 mexicanos, 33 brasileños, 12 canadienses, nueve estadounidenses, ocho colombianos, siete peruanos, tres argentinos y tres chilenos. Guatemala, Cuba, República Dominicana, Uruguay y Venezuela tienen un santo(a) cada uno. Estados Unidos y Canadá comparten siete mártires. La mayoría de los santos o santas del continente americano fueron beatificados o canonizados durante los últimos 100 años. Sólo ocho de ellos fueron canonizados durante los últimos ocho años.

No todos estos santos nacieron en América, pero sí dedicaron su vida a evangelizarla. Estos 137 santos de la Iglesia universal son un testimonio de la obra del Espíritu Santo en el continente americano.


