

DIVINE WISDOM

The Lord's message, through Moses, was to "take no revenge and cherish no grudge . . . love your neighbor as yourself" (Leviticus 19:18). We might think, "Great in theory, but not always realistic!"

Then Jesus in today's Gospel goes even further. Take a slap in the face and then turn the other cheek? Treat enemies the same as friends? Again, we're tempted to think that those are nice ideals, but not very practical in the "real world."

Paul echoes Jesus when he tells the Corinthians that what passes for human wisdom is absurdity to God. Divine wisdom casts sunshine on the good and the bad, showers rain on the honest and the dishonest—without distinction. We must examine our wisdom and common sense to see how they compare to the wisdom of God, and make adjustments accordingly.



SABIDURÍA DIVINA

El mensaje del Señor, por medio de Moisés, fue "no te vengarás ni guardarás rencor . . . , ama a tu prójimo como a ti mismo" (Levítico 19:18). Podríamos pensar, "Excelente enseñanza pero no es muy realista".

Y en el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús se adelanta. ¿Si te golpean, pon la otra mejilla? ¿Tratar a los enemigos como si fueran amigos? Y así otra vez, estamos tentados a pensar que son bonitos ideales, pero no muy prácticos en el "mundo real".

Pablo hace eco a las palabras de Jesús cuando les dice a los corintios que lo que parece ser sabiduría de los hombres es absurdo para Dios. La sabiduría divina brilla sobre los buenos y los malos, llueve sobre los honestos y deshonestos, sin distinción. Debemos examinar nuestra sabiduría y sentido común para ver cómo estos se comparan con la sabiduría de Dios, y hacer los ajustes correspondientes.



Our first reading today opens with the words: "The LORD said to Moses, 'Speak to the whole Israelite community and tell them: . . .'"

Even before we hear what it is that God has to say, the intro confirms an astonishing reality: God has spoken directly to us. The whole gift of our faith is founded on this reality of revelation, Divine Revelation, that our God wanted to reach out and share himself with us. The beauty of this treasure is confirmed in the Prophet Baruch when he says, "Blessed are we, O Israel, for what pleases God is known to us!" Our God has chosen to bring us into closeness with him.

This heavenly intervention continues in our Gospel as we hear Jesus affirm: "You have heard that it was said . . . but I say to you . . ." Where we have experienced confusion, where we have known uncertainty, our God intervenes to build us again upon his word of truth.

Our God loves us, our God knows us, and he knows we so often find ourselves broken, find ourselves lost, and he refuses to leave us adrift. Matt Maher in his song *Alive Again* proclaims this incredible reality: "You shattered my darkness, Washed away my blindness, . . . You called and You shouted, Broke through my deafness, Now I'm breathing in and breathing out, I'm alive again."

Alive Again. No matter what murk we've wandered into, what conflict or turmoil we find ourselves in, the piercing word of truth can restore us to a vitality we may have thought forever lost, or never before had known.

Our God saves, and he saves by sharing himself with us. As he reveals himself, as he speaks to us, his word gives to us the new experience of life grounded on solid rock. Don't let any lie, any negativity keep you from opening your ears to this amazing renewal. Let his word bring you to life again.



La primera lectura de hoy comienza con las siguientes palabras: "El Señor dijo a Moisés: 'Habla a toda la comunidad israelita y diles:'"

Incluso antes de escuchar lo que Dios dice, la introducción confirma una asombrosa realidad: Dios nos ha hablado directamente. El don total de nuestra fe se basa en la realidad de la revelación, la revelación divina, que nuestro Dios quiso compartir con nosotros. La belleza de este tesoro se confirma en el Profeta Baruch cuando dice: "¡Bienaventurados nosotros, oh Israel, porque lo que a Dios le agrada, se nos ha rebelado!" nuestro Dios ha elegido acercarnos a él.

Esta intervención celestial continúa en el Evangelio cuando oímos a Jesús afirmar: "Ustedes han oído que se dijo ... pero yo les digo ..." Donde hemos experimentado la confusión, donde hemos conocido la incertidumbre, nuestro Dios interviene para renovarnos nuevamente en su palabra que es verdad.

Nuestro Dios nos ama, nuestro Dios nos conoce, y él sabe que tan a menudo nos encontramos derrotados, perdidos, y él se niega a dejarnos a la deriva. Matt Maher en su canción *Alive Again* (*Vivo de Nuevo*) proclama esta increíble realidad: "Has destrozado mi oscuridad, Has lavado mi ceguera, ... Tú llamaste y gritaste, atravesaste mi sordera, ahora estoy respirando y respirando, estoy vivo de nuevo."

Vivo de nuevo. No importa en qué oscuridad nos hayamos metido, en qué conflicto o tumulto nos encontramos, la penetrante palabra de la verdad puede restaurarnos a una vitalidad que podríamos haber pensado estaba perdida para siempre, o que nunca antes habíamos conocido.

Nuestro Dios salva, y él salva al compartirse con nosotros. A medida que se revela, al hablar con nosotros, su palabra nos da la nueva experiencia de la vida basada en roca sólida. No dejes que ninguna mentira, ninguna negatividad te impida abrir tus oídos a esta renovación asombrosa. Que su palabra te vuelva a la vida.



TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In brushing up for "Catholic Jeopardy," it might help to know that there is only one feast on the calendar for a thing, rather than a person or mystery. It's for a chair: Saint Peter's chair in fact

After the Resurrection, there can be no doubt that the disciples reserved a special place for Simon Peter in the upper room. Later, Peter became the bishop of Antioch in today's Syria, the place where we were first called "Christians." From there, he went to Rome, the center of the Empire, where it is said that Peter sat in a chair in the house of Priscilla and Aquila to instruct his flock. Jesus, in entrusting the keys of the Kingdom to Peter and his successors, entrusted his compassion and mercy to them, and charged them with pointing to the Kingdom of God. Compassion and mercy are to resonate through their teaching.

Since the ancient sign of a teacher is the chair ("disciple" literally means one who sits at the feet of a teacher), Peter's chair has long been treasured. Today there is a symbolic shrine of Peter's chair above the main altar of St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. This monument is the last work of Bernini, a huge bronze throne supported by four doctors of the Church: Augustine and Ambrose from the Western Church, and Chrysostom and Athanasius from the East. High above it is the alabaster window of the descent of the Holy Spirit.

Eran gitanas, esas a las que mi mamá y mis tías me iban a dar si no me portaba bien. Los gitanos no tienen una buena reputación entre las naciones. Tienen la misma reputación de los pastores de Palestina que vivieron en tiempos de Jesús. Se piensa que son ladrones e inmorales, gente a la que hay que tenerle miedo.

Sin embargo, decimos que Jesús es nuestro Buen Pastor. En Jesús, todas las personas que jamás creíamos capaces de alcanzar la santidad, lo logran. Tal es el caso del Pelé o Zeferino Jiménez, un gitano que en 1936 fue fusilado por militares españoles. El motivo de su muerte fue la enseñanza y difusión de la fe en Cristo. Su muerte fue la cumbre de una vida de fe como franciscano seglar. El ejemplo de vida que este gitano nos dio, logró hacer que los españoles lo respetaran y olvidaran sus prejuicios en contra de su gente. Además de eso, evangelizó a sus hermanos gitanos.
