Pastor's Corner

245! Our nation celebrates its birthday, and we now have quite a few. With our own birthdays, hopefully we learn as time goes by. Wisdom comes with age, we say.

Our nation's birthday comes with a specific theme: Independence! Born to be free, we can ask what we have learned about freedom as we celebrate this milestone.

In our history, freedom has always been interwoven with war. While Jefferson's Declaration was adopted on the Fourth of July, the Continental Congress' stand for freedom had to be followed up by resisting Britain in the Revolutionary War.

Our war of greatest sacrifice followed only 78 years after the War of Independence ended. As a nation, we asked if freedom extended to everyone, and how far were we willing to go in holding that belief. No war has surpassed the Civil War in cost in lives, and more blood was shed in that fight to free the enslaved than in any other American conflict.

President Abraham Lincoln recognized the value of standing for freedom even if it comes at great cost. In his Second Inaugural Address he confirmed that we are responsible for each human life and each person's freedom: "Fondly do we hope, fervently do we pray, that this mighty scourge of war may speedily pass away. Yet, if God wills that it continues until all the wealth piled by the bondsman's two hundred and fifty years of unrequited toil shall be sunk, and until every drop of blood drawn with the lash shall be paid by another drawn with the sword, as was said three thousand years ago, so still it must be said 'the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether.'"

245! Nuestra nación celebra su cumpleaños y ahora se han celebrado bastantes. Con nuestros propios cumpleaños, ojalá aprendamos a medida que pasa el tiempo. Decimos que la sabiduría viene con la edad.

El cumpleaños de nuestra nación viene con un tema específico: ¡Independencia! Nacidos para ser libres, podemos preguntarnos qué hemos aprendido sobre la libertad mientras celebramos este hito.

En nuestra historia, la libertad siempre se ha entrelazado con la guerra. Si bien la Declaración de Jefferson fue adoptada el 4 de Julio, la posición de libertad del Congreso Continental tuvo que ser seguida por la resistencia de Gran Bretaña en la Guerra Revolucionaria.

Nuestra guerra de mayor sacrificio se produjo solo 78 años después de que terminó la Guerra de la Independencia. Como nación, preguntamos si la libertad se extendía a todos y hasta dónde estábamos dispuestos a llegar para mantener esa creencia. Ninguna guerra ha superado a la Guerra Civil en costo de vidas, y en esa lucha para liberar a los esclavos se derramó más sangre que en cualquier otro conflicto estadounidense.

El presidente Abraham Lincoln reconoció el valor de defender la libertad incluso a un gran costo. En su segundo discurso inaugural, confirmó que somos responsables de cada vida humana y de la libertad de cada persona: "Con cariño esperamos, oramos fervientemente, que este poderoso flagelo de la guerra pase pronto. Sin embargo, si Dios quiere que continúe hasta que toda la riqueza acumulada por los doscientos cincuenta años de trabajo no correspondido del siervo se pierda, y hasta que cada gota de sangre extraída con el látigo sea pagada por otro extraído con la espada, como se dijo hace tres mil años, así que aún debe decirse 'los juicios del Señor son verdaderos y justos en conjunto' ".





BRINGING GLAD TIDINGS WITH AN OPEN HEART

For Sunday, July 4, 2021

[14th Sunday in Ordinary Time](#)



Ezekiel 2:2-5

2 Corinthians 12:7-10

Mark 6:1-6

Could you be described as “hard of face and obstinate of heart” ([Ezekiel 2:4](#)), particularly in matters of faith? What aspects of the Catholic faith have you yet to embrace with an open heart? Do you question God’s plan of sheer goodness ([Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1](#)) for you, a loved one, or the world? In Mass, do you believe what you cannot see, as you witness ordinary bread and wine become the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ? Does the Word of God dwell in you richly? When people spend time with you, do they “know that a prophet has been among them” (Ezekiel 2:5)?

At Baptism, each of us receives an anointing with sacred chrism oil, at which time the priest or deacon prays these words, “As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet, and King, so may you live always as a member of his body, sharing everlasting life.” In our Baptism, we are called to “play [our part] in the mission of the whole Christian people in the Church and in the World” ([CCC 897](#)). Since today’s readings specifically mention “prophet,” let’s take a little deeper look at what it means to live out our call to and share in Christ’s prophetic office.

Christ establishes the lay faithful “as witnesses and provides them with the sense of the faith [sensus fidei] and the grace of the word” (CCC 904). His grace, as we learn from St. Paul in [2 Corinthians 12:9](#), “is sufficient for you.” Even more incredible, it is our very weaknesses, those moments of doubt, uncertainty, and even troubles, that burst forth His astonishing power. Our witness is perfected by grace, especially when we are honest about our struggles of faith but still willing to continue to seek His truth. Regardless of what we fail to understand, we still know Jesus is our Lord and Savior. If we could see and understand all, then what would be the purpose of faith?

Witnessing, is not always as easy as sharing what Jesus has done for us or our reason to believe. The most compelling witness comes from the things people see us do over the words we choose to speak. There can be a great difficulty for us to be an evangelizing disciple to our friends, family, or neighbors — possibly the very people we most wish to know the goodness of our God. There is some consolation knowing Jesus himself faced such difficulty, and to know he could be “amazed at [the] lack of faith” some people exhibit. He, however, did not give up, and neither should we.

Instead of becoming discouraged or trying to force our desire for all to believe, perhaps this is when we pray that someone else will bring the Good News to those we cannot. Then use our energy to learn how to better lean on the grace of God to both grow stronger in our faith and to live out our call as Priest, Prophet, and King. To pray the Spirit of the Lord falls upon us so we may bring glad tidings to those willing to have their obstinate hearts softened too.
