THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



“From this day all generations will call me blessed: the Almighty has done great things for me and holy is his Name. He has cast down the mighty from their thrones, and has lifted up the lowly.”

PASTOR'S CORNER

It's been forty years since Indiana Jones first prevented the Nazis from stealing the lost Ark. Well, technically his adventures happened in 1936, but we saw them on the big screen in 1981. He goes on to further adventures, but the Ark ends up in a vast government archive.

The Ark in the film contains enormous power, while the original Ark described in the Old Testament was our physical connection to God. No other artifact in this world was tangibly connected to the all-powerful creator. The Ark of the Covenant alone held the stone tablets of the Law, God's Ten Commandments.

But in the New Testament something changes: the Word of God becomes physically present. Born of a woman, God is here to speak his words himself.

In the Old Testament the Ark disappears: it had been kept in the temple of Solomon, but after successive invasions it is lost to history. While Indiana Jones relocated it to D.C., the Bible describes a different destination. Revelation 11:19 reads, "Then God's temple in heaven was opened, and the ark of the covenant could be seen."

The Ark is taken up to heaven! The golden container that held God's word is lifted up into glory. This Sunday, August 15th, we celebrate this marvelous moment: the physical bearer of the Word of God taken up into heaven. Two verses after telling us the Ark is in heaven, Revelation continues saying: "A great sign appeared in the sky, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars."

We celebrate the original ark taken up to glory, and we celebrate the new bearer of the Word of God, his mother, being taken up into heaven.

Han pasado cuarenta años desde que Indiana Jones impidió por primera vez que los Nazis robaran el Arca perdida. Bueno, técnicamente sus aventuras ocurrieron en 1936, pero las vimos en la pantalla grande en 1981. Continúa con otras aventuras, pero el Arca termina en un vasto archivo gubernamental.

El Arca en la película contiene un poder enorme, mientras que el Arca original descrita en el Antiguo Testamento era nuestra conexión física con Dios. Ningún otro artefacto en este mundo estaba conectado tangiblemente al creador todopoderoso. Solo el Arca de la Alianza contenía las tablas de piedra de la Ley, los Diez Mandamientos de Dios.

Pero en el Nuevo Testamento algo cambia: la Palabra de Dios se hace presente físicamente. Nacido de una mujer, Dios está aquí para hablar él mismo sus palabras.

En el Antiguo Testamento el Arca desaparece: se había guardado en el templo de Salomón, pero tras sucesivas invasiones se pierde en la historia. Mientras Indiana Jones lo trasladó a D.C., la Biblia describe un destino diferente. Apocalipsis 11:19 dice: "Entonces se abrió el templo de Dios en el cielo y se pudo ver el arca del pacto."

¡El Arca es llevada al cielo! El recipiente de oro que contenía la palabra de Dios se eleva a la gloria. Este Domingo 15 de Agosto celebramos este maravilloso momento: el portador físico de la Palabra de Dios elevada al cielo. Dos versículos después de decirnos que el Arca está en el cielo,

Apocalipsis continúa diciendo: "Una gran señal apareció en el cielo, una mujer vestida del sol, con la luna debajo de sus pies, y en su cabeza una corona de doce estrellas."

Celebramos el arca original llevada a la gloria, y celebramos que la nueva portadora de la Palabra de Dios, su madre, sea llevada al cielo.





The Assumption

Question:

What lessons should I learn from the Assumption of Mary?

Answer:

Growing in holiness is similar to training in a sport. We need someone to show us how we can live our faith well. Mary is a model of sanctity. She shows us how to be faithful to God's will, living each day with confidence in God's mercy and love. At the Nativity, in Jesus' public ministry, and at the Crucifixion, we see her steadfast trust. She allows the Lord to use her life to accomplish his plan for her and for all of us. In the Preface of the Mass for the Assumption of Mary, we pray: "For today the Virgin Mother of God was assumed into heaven as the beginning and image of your Church's coming to perfection and a sign of sure hope and comfort to your pilgrim people."

It is this image of holiness that we strive to imitate. In the office, at home, or in our community, we look for signs of God's grace that call us to an ever greater love of him and each other. A greater awareness of God is a sign of our conversion of heart that lives the lessons Mary teaches.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

They are courageous, wise women who ground us, focus us, and inspire us. They are the good mothers who walk with us and light our way. They teach us life lessons and help us heal and navigate through challenges and difficulties. We need people to point the way. Sometimes, these wise ladies are not our biological mothers but women in our lives, who through their strong and faithful presence, anchor us and remind us that we are loved. We need these women. Human beings do their best when they have cheerleaders in their lives. They show us that even when facing despair there is always a brighter tomorrow.



EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS WWMD?

WWJD bracelets were all the rage about 25 years ago in Christian circles. I've always wondered if a WWMD bracelet might not make just as much sense, and maybe more. **What Would Mary Do?**

I would argue that Mary was the most exemplary steward who ever lived. Her answer was always "Yes." Yes, Lord, I am Your handmaiden. Yes, I will visit Elizabeth, and help her in the last difficult months of pregnancy. Yes, I will bring my son up in the Mosaic law and present him at the Temple of Jerusalem. Yes, I will give him to the crowds and to public ministry. Yes, I will offer him on this Cross, if it is Your will. Yes, yes, yes.

Well, I can't be like Mary, we think to ourselves. There's an intimidation factor with the Blessed Mother and Catholics sometimes — one that almost exceeds that of Christ. Perhaps it's because we are in awe of the fact that she was not divine in any way — she was a mere creation, like us — but somehow, she always had the courage to say yes. How could she do it, when we find it so hard?

Well, God certainly lavished on Mary extraordinary graces. Her lack of original sin liberated her to conform her will to God's.

But God is impatient to give us, too, all the graces we need to be a steward in the example of Mary. He's waiting for us simply to ask. Just as in Adam we died, so in Christ — through Mary — we live.

What can we say yes to today, in Mary's example?
