PASTOR'S CORNER

In 1777 Samuel Johnson wrote: “Depend upon it, sir, when a man knows he is to be hanged in a fortnight, it concentrates his mind wonderfully.” He was writing to win pardon for a friend condemned to execution, but his words still speak to us today: nothing grabs our attention like dying.

This is true whether it's our own death or the end of the world we're facing. But unlike those facing execution, we don't know the date we're counting down to. We pass the anniversary of our death each year unaware.

We could ask why God doesn't share these dates with us. Coaches and teachers know what that would cause: knowing how long till the end, we would get flabby. Then three weeks before the final, we start cramming—and the heart, like mind or body, can't undo years of a junk diet.

We're one week away from the end of our Church year, and endings can give us the best of what Samuel Johnson noticed. Remembering the end is coming, and coming sooner than we think, lets us refocus today. Who are we? Who do we want to be? Are we living today the way we want to be remembered for eternity?

You are going to die. Are you ready?

Esto es cierto si es nuestra propia muerte o el fin del mundo al que nos enfrentamos. Pero a diferencia de los que se enfrentan a la ejecución, no sabemos la fecha hasta que pasa. Pasamos el aniversario de nuestra muerte cada año sin darnos cuenta.

Podríamos preguntarnos por qué Dios no comparte estas fechas con nosotros. Los entrenadores y maestros saben lo que eso causaría: sabiendo cuánto tiempo hasta el final, nos volveríamos flácidos. Luego, tres semanas antes de la final, comenzamos a abarrotarnos, y el corazón, como la mente o el cuerpo, no puede deshacer años de una dieta de comida chatarra.

Estamos a una semana de el final de nuestro año de la Iglesia, y los finales pueden darnos lo mejor de lo que Samuel Johnson notó. Recordar que se acerca el final, y llegar antes de lo que pensamos, nos permite reenfocarnos hoy. ¿Quiénes somos? ¿Quiénes queremos ser? ¿Estamos viviendo hoy de la manera que queremos ser recordado por la eternidad?

Parishes in the Sacramento Diocese have reported recent texting and email attempts to scam parishioners into making purchases of gift cards. Individuals falsely representing themselves as members of our clergy have texted or emailed parishioners asking those parishioners to buy gift cards for the sick or to make contributions to a special cause. Some of these bad actors will make a strong effort to make these messages appear to originate from the pastor. The scammer will write messages using very personal greetings and indicate there is a need to get the cards or funds quickly to create a sense of urgency. These types of scams are not new.

The Diocese Information Technology Unit has sent out warnings about other similar recent events.

El estafador escribirá mensajes usando saludos muy personales e indicará que es necesario obtener las tarjetas o los fondos rápidamente para crear una sensación de urgencia. Estos tipos de estafas no son nuevos. Por favor ignoren estos mensajes.

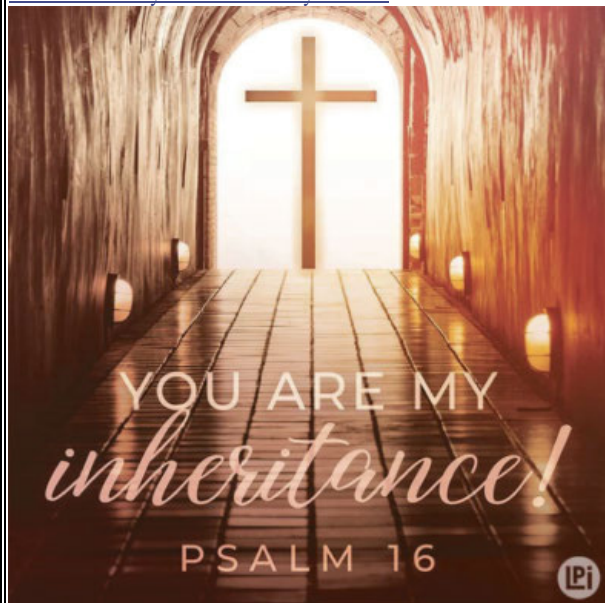

Daniel 12:1-3; Hebrews 10:11-14, 18; Mark 13:24-32

On Thanksgiving Day, I decided to attend Mass. It had only been a few months since returning to the Church after an extended absence; however, I would not classify participation before the break as faithful. I thought it made perfect sense to attend the celebration of the Eucharist, whose very meaning is — thanksgiving. Unaware of the liturgical calendar, I went expecting joyful readings about gratitude and, well, thanksgiving. However, that is not what I heard, not even close. Hello, doom and gloom!

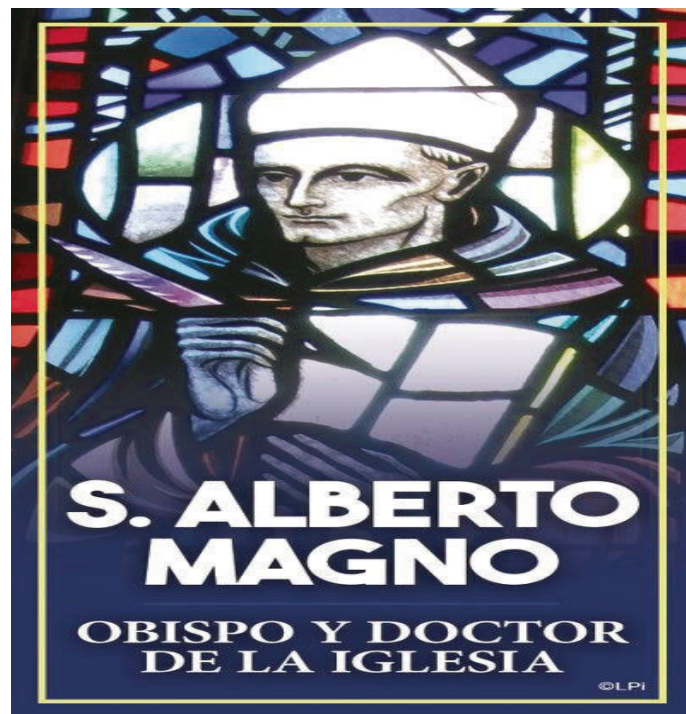
The liturgical calendar spans from the First Sunday of Advent to the Solemnity of Christ the King. I have discovered the alignment of the end of the liturgical calendar with readings focused on the end times. At first glance, the weeks' readings leading up to Advent become foreboding, ominous, and even a little depressing. One has to search really hard to find the hope, but it is there. Thanks to the Resurrection, one can always find hope!

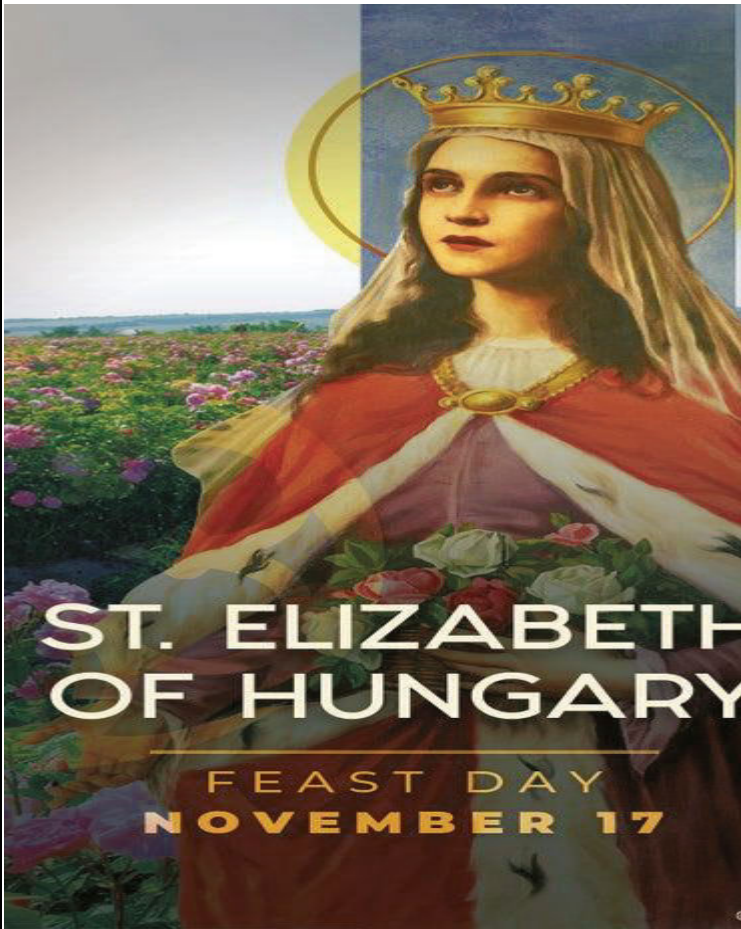
While Daniel sets up the doom, the Responsorial Psalm dispels the gloom. Here we find the words, "I set the LORD ever before me; with him at my right hand I shall not be disturbed." Then, the author of Hebrews records, "For by one offering he has made perfect forever those who are being consecrated." Once, for all. Alleluia, what could be more hopeful than that!

Fast forward many years after that eye-opening Thanksgiving Mass, my life relationship with the Lord

and the Church has grown significantly. This winding down of both calendars has become my chosen time to consecrate myself to Jesus through Mary using [St. Louis de Montfort's Total Consecration](#) method. I love preparing for the coming of Christmas by devoting time to the scriptures, Marian prayers, and spiritual reading. I tend to get caught up in the secularism of the holidays, hence my assuming the "Thanksgiving" themed Mass! Soon we'll be entering the season of Advent, a time to prepare for the coming of Christ, not just in remembrance of his first coming in the Feast of his Nativity but also in the understanding he will come again. We need to prepare our hearts and homes not only for our company (yeah, finally!) but for the greatest guest of all: Christ.

In Mark's Gospel, Jesus explains what to expect when he returns — "And then they will see 'the Son of Man coming in the clouds' with great power and glory." Furthermore, it reminds us to heed these warnings, so we are not caught unaware. To remember, though heaven and earth pass away — his words, his teaching, he, himself, does not. Be alert, be prepared. Although we know not the hour, every year, the Church provides us a time to pause, reflect, and prepare with the cycle of the liturgies and the great devotions of our faith. From the darkness comes a great light. As we pass from Advent to Christmas, let us enjoy the celebrations, careful not to leave Jesus out of them, and most importantly, ready our homes and our hearts to receive him.

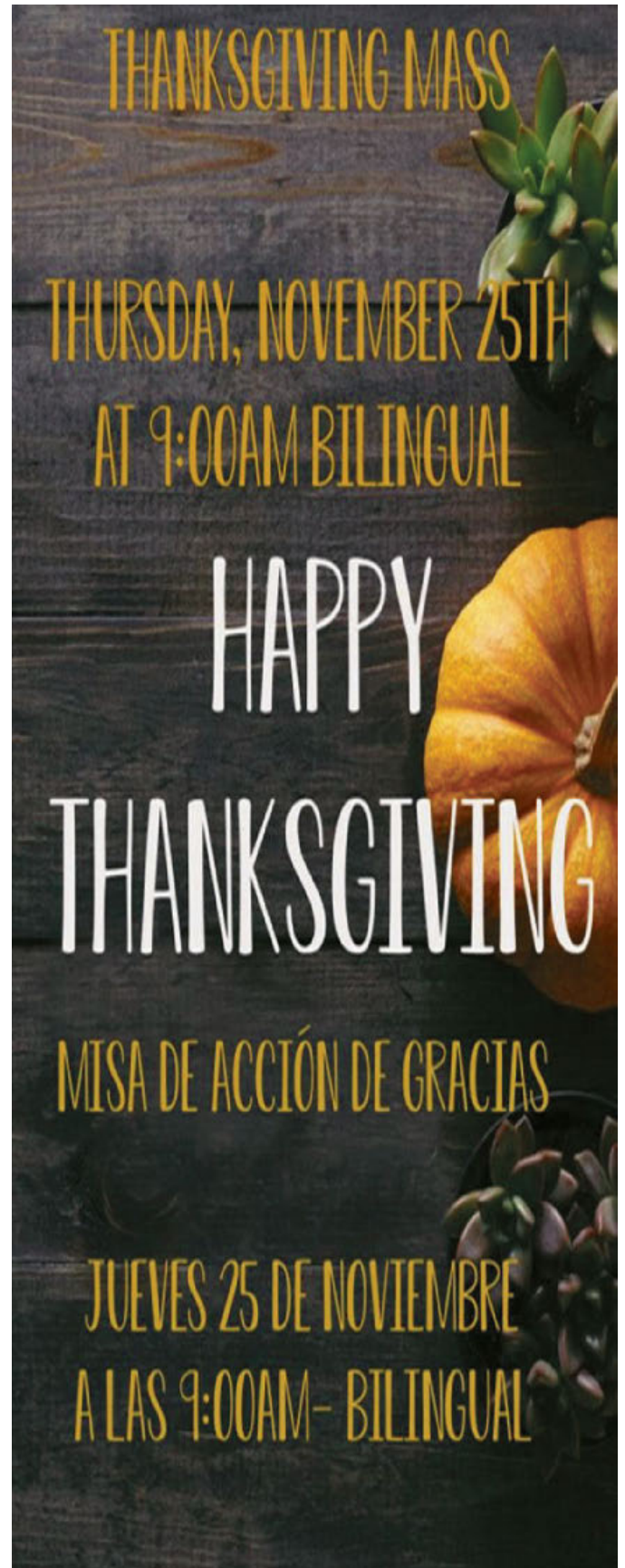
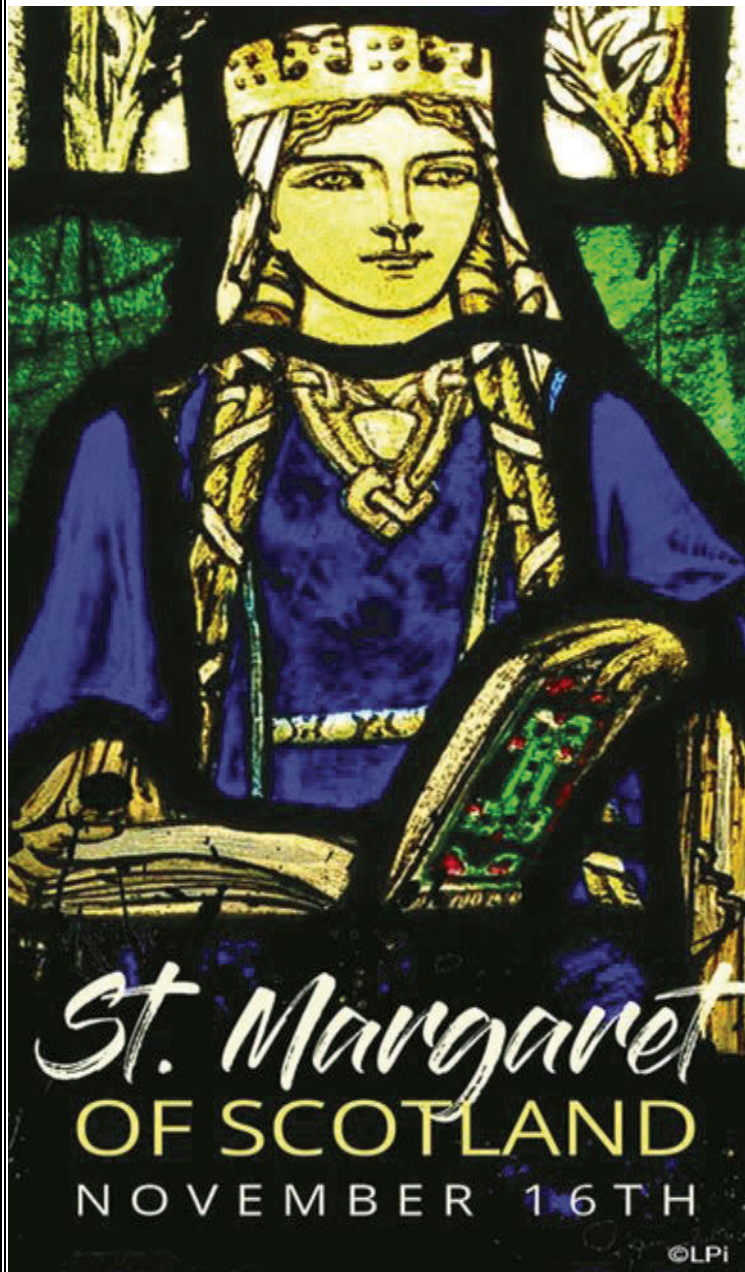
