PASTOR'S CORNER

Today as Christmas ends we celebrate Jesus' baptism. While a part of Jesus' grown up story and not the beautiful infancy accounts, his baptism shares the theme of his being revealed to the world.

Our Church reads from Isaiah 42 to show what is happening in this moment. While Isaiah includes the powerful words of love that a father speaks over his son, just like at the Jordan, he also includes an important prophecy of what Jesus' ministry will be.

This is the one, "upon whom I have put my spirit" (remember the dove descends at Jesus' baptism); "he shall bring forth justice to the nations." The arrival of God's anointed means there's a new sheriff in town. What does this look like? Like Jesus declares at the synagogue in Nazareth, Isaiah 42 says he is here "to open the eyes of the blind, to bring out prisoners from confinement, and from the dungeon, those who live in darkness."

If you go to prisons and dungeons and break people out, you make the jailer angry. And that's exactly what we find. Introducing a breakthrough message of deliverance brings hostility from the old boss, and Satan, who as they say is on the wrong side of history, knows his clock is ticking.

Don't be intimidated by shadows. As we celebrate Jesus' baptism today, if you want freedom, ask God for it. He comes with one purpose, and he is here for you.

Hoy, al final de la Navidad, celebramos el bautismo de Jesús. Si bien es parte de la historia adulta de Jesús y no los hermosos relatos de la infancia, su bautismo comparte el tema de su revelación al mundo.

Nuestra Iglesia lee Isaías 42 para mostrar lo que está sucediendo en este momento. Si bien Isaías incluye las poderosas palabras de amor que un padre pronuncia sobre su hijo, al igual que en el Jordán, también incluye una importante profecía de lo que será el ministerio de Jesús.

Este es "en quien he puesto mi espíritu" (recuerde que la paloma desciende en el bautismo de Jesús); "Él traerá justicia a las naciones". La llegada del ungido de Dios significa que hay un nuevo alguacil en la ciudad. A qué se parece esto? Como Jesús declara en la sinagoga de Nazaret, Isaías 42 dice que él está aquí "para abrir los ojos de los ciegos, para sacar a los presos del encierro y del calabozo a los que viven en tinieblas".

Si vas a prisiones y mazmorras y sacas a la gente, haces enojar al carcelero. Y eso es exactamente lo que encontramos. La introducción de un mensaje revolucionario de liberación trae hostilidad por parte del antiguo jefe, y Satanás, quien, como dicen, está en el lado equivocado de la historia, sabe que su reloj no se detiene.

No se deje intimidar por las sombras. Al celebrar el bautismo de Jesús hoy, si quieres libertad, pídelo a Dios. Viene con un propósito y está aquí para ti.





EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

"Who is this Christ? Is he like you?"

Perhaps you've heard this story, often attributed to the life of St. Teresa of Calcutta. A sick man asked her this question, as he marveled at her tireless service to himself and others in the name of someone named Jesus Christ.

"He is nothing like me," the saint is said to have answered. "But I hope I am like him."

Though the authenticity of this exchange cannot be verified, its message rings perfectly true: all the value of our stewardship lies in its relativity to the one in whose name we perform it.


Consider the figure of John the Baptist — a magnificent, towering character even purely from a literary or historical perspective. A martyr who fed on wild locusts and boldly spoke truth to power — a man so great some mistook him for the Messiah.


But why is he great? Because he prepared the way. All his accomplishments and escapades mean nothing if they are taken out of the context of salvation history. He only makes sense relative to Christ — and this is exactly as he wanted it. "One worthier than I is coming," he insists. And because of that humility and that total embrace of God's will, he is given one of the greatest honors in the New Testament — he baptizes the Son of God.

Let's examine our lives in the light of their relativity to Christ. How do we prepare the way? When Christ comes to us, what do we do? How do we leave ourselves open to be actors in God's plan?
