PASTOR'S CORNER

Saint Bernard of Clairvaux, when asked what three most important virtues were, responded: "Humility, humility, and humility."

We won't have any influencers or talk show hosts reminding us of his words today, because Saint Bernard's insight into spiritual freedom is completely unwelcome in our secular culture. Because we have completely rejected God and his care for us, all of us are left to fend for ourselves, to defend ourselves: strength, power, control would be much more helpful virtues.

You may remember two Sundays ago when in the homily I foresaw what would be God's gift to Saint Isidore in 2026, and what his gift to each of us would be. I named it as being peace: the fruit of the Holy Spirit that we were most invited into for this year.

Peace is a supernatural gift from God that illuminates every aspect of our life: what it reveals is that everything is provided for, God has everything taken care of for us. As our hearts come to trust in God's providence, we experience an extraordinary (supernatural) rest and refreshment as we come to discover that the emergencies of life aren't piled up on our own shoulders.

As our Scriptures today speak to us of the poor in spirit, the humble of the earth, we are given the key into this peace of the Lord. As long as our next steps are determined by our own strategy, our human efforts, our scope of control, we remain burdened by the enormous risks that a collapsing world flings at us. But when we recognize that we are poor, that we don't have what it takes, and that we do have to rely on, hand things over to, God—then we experience the outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

Blessed are the poor in spirit, the kingdom of heaven is theirs! The refrain of our Psalm today does not only refer to a grace received in the next life: we are called into the peace of the Lord today. Ask God for true humility, true reliance on him, a true handing over of our possessions and self to him. In that humility is our peace.

RINCÓN DEL PASTOR

Cuando le preguntaron a San Bernardo de Claraval cuáles eran las tres virtudes más importantes, respondió: «Humildad, humildad y humildad».

Hoy en día, ningún influencer ni presentador de programas de entrevistas nos recuerda sus palabras, porque la visión de San Bernardo sobre la libertad espiritual es totalmente inaceptable en nuestra cultura secular. Como hemos rechazado por completo a Dios y su cuidado por nosotros, todos nos vemos obligados a valernos por nosotros mismos, a defendernos: la fuerza, el poder y el control serían virtudes mucho más útiles.

Quizás recuerden que hace dos domingos, en la homilía, preveía cuál sería el regalo de Dios a San Isidro en 2026 y cuál sería su regalo para cada uno de nosotros. Lo llamé paz: el fruto del Espíritu Santo al que más fuimos invitados este año.

La paz es un don sobrenatural de Dios que ilumina todos los aspectos de nuestra vida: lo que revela es que todo está provisto, que Dios se ocupa de todo por nosotros. A medida que nuestros corazones llegan a confiar en la providencia de Dios, experimentamos un descanso y un refresco extraordinarios (sobrenaturales) al descubrir que las emergencias de la vida no se acumulan sobre nuestros hombros.

Cuando nuestras Escrituras nos hablan hoy de los pobres de espíritu, los humildes de la tierra, se nos da la clave para alcanzar esta paz del Señor. Mientras nuestros próximos pasos estén determinados por nuestra propia estrategia, nuestros esfuerzos humanos, nuestro ámbito de control, seguiremos agobiados por los enormes riesgos que nos lanza un mundo en colapso. Pero cuando reconocemos que somos pobres, que no tenemos lo necesario y que debemos confiar en Dios y entregarle las cosas, entonces experimentamos el derramamiento del Espíritu Santo.

¡Bienaventurados los pobres de espíritu, porque de ellos es el reino de los cielos! El estribillo de nuestro salmo de hoy no solo se refiere a una gracia recibida en la otra vida: estamos llamados a la paz del Señor hoy. Pidamos a Dios verdadera humildad, verdadera confianza en él, una verdadera entrega de nuestras posesiones y de nosotros mismos a él. En esa humildad está nuestra paz.

St. Vincent de Paul

The St. Isidore Conference of Saint Vincent de Paul is dedicated to serving all families in Sutter County regardless of their religious affiliation, race, or ethnicity. We help those who need assistance with food, rent, utilities, furniture and household goods.

Our food locker provides both fresh and non-perishable food once a month. Over the past year, we have served 1600 families with food, 137 families with rent and utility assistance, 200 with furniture, and 240 with household goods.

We are staffed only by volunteers. Currently we have about 30 members who come on a rotating basis. The various jobs include helping at the food locker (including translation), furniture delivery, home visit teams of 2 to assist with financial aid, and sorting donations. Volunteers come according to the time they are available and their interests. Since the food locker is open 2 hours per day, 3 days a week, any other work is done when needed.

We are very grateful for the generosity of our parishioners and invite you to visit the Food Locker for a tour, for more information, or (hopefully) to volunteer. The building is open Tues-Thurs from 9:15-11:15, but we would be happy to have you come by appointment. The phone is (530) 671-5154.

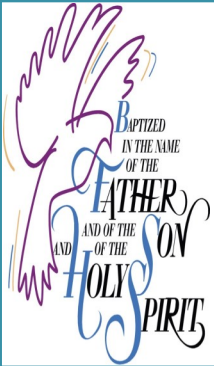

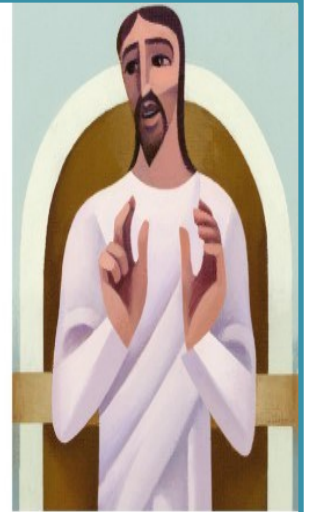

Q Where do the catechumens go, and what do they do when they are dismissed?



A The catechumens, along with their catechist, are dismissed to a space that has been prepared with a candle, a Bible, and perhaps a symbol or sacred object of the season. During this time, the catechist leads a reflection and discussion on the Liturgy of the Word that assists the catechumens to be nourished by the Word of God and the liturgy. The catechist may also use minor blessings and exorcisms as a means to support the catechumens' journey.
