PASTOR'S CORNER

Our celebration today puts a bow on our Christmas Season. For people who don't know Christmas too well, it can seem a little strange that we're seeing Jesus as a grownup: we finish Christmas by celebrating Jesus' baptism. Most Catholics are babies when they're baptized, so the theme would be consistent for us, but Jesus had a slightly different tempo in his timeline.

Baptism of course marks the bridge between Jesus' hidden life in infancy and Nazareth, and his beginning of public ministry. What is it that introduces Jesus onto the public scene?

We find ourselves at the water's edge, here at the Jordan River. Water is definitely a familiar place for God to kick things off. When he decided to create a beautiful new world, he began with water—back in Genesis, we find the Spirit of God hovering over the waters, from which God calls forth all the marvelous things of our ordered world. And then, perhaps most famously when it comes to water, he washes the entire earth in the flood of Noah, foreshadowing the washing away of our sins in baptism. And of course when he forms the new people of Israel, he brings them through the waters of the Red Sea to enter into a new covenant with their creator and redeemer.

Our Psalm today proclaims God's power revealed through the waters. It is the voice of the Lord that we encounter with power over the waters, a voice of power that the angels have known from the beginning. Psalm 29 knows this is the place of God's dominion: "The Lord sits enthroned over the flood." We have encountered the place where God is revealed.

Just as last week we celebrated the revelation of God in Jesus' Epiphany, so today in the waters we are in the presence of the Holy Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are manifested together as our world is transformed into the place where God abides: no longer foreign terrain remote from the light of salvation, now God is revealed among us.

As we sign ourselves with holy water entering church, we can remember that we also are temples of the Lord, washed in the same waters that make the Lord ruler of our lives in power. Jesus now is revealed publicly; we also can live openly in his grace.

RINCÓN DEL PASTOR

Nuestra celebración de hoy pone el broche final a la temporada navideña. Para quienes no conocen muy bien la Navidad, puede resultar un poco extraño que veamos a Jesús como un adulto: terminamos la Navidad celebrando el bautismo de Jesús. La mayoría de los católicos son bebés cuando se bautizan, por lo que el tema sería coherente para nosotros, pero Jesús tuvo un ritmo ligeramente diferente en su línea temporal.

El bautismo, por supuesto, marca el Puente entre la vida oculta de Jesús en su infancia y Nazaret, y el comienzo de su ministerio público. ¿Que es lo que introduce a Jesús en la escena pública?

Nos encontramos a orilla del agua, aquí en río Jordán. El agua es sin duda un lugar familiar para que Dios ponga en marcha las cosas. Cuando decidió crear un nuevo y hermoso mundo, comenzó con el agua: en el Génesis, encontramos al Espíritu de Dios revoloteando sobre las aguas, desde donde Dios crea todas las cosas maravillosas de Nuestro mundo ordenado. Y luego, quizás lo más famoso en lo que respecta al agua, lava toda la tierra en el diluvio de Noé, presagiando el lavado de nuestros pecados en el bautismo. Y, por supuesto, cuando forma el nuevo pueblo de Israel, lo lleva a través de las aguas del Mar Rojo para entrar en una nueva alianza con su creador y redentor.

El salmo de hoy proclama el poder de Dios revelado a través de las aguas. Es la voz de Señor que encontramos con poder sobre las aguas, una voz de poder que los ángeles han conocido desde el principio. El salmo 29 sabe que este es el lugar de dominio de Dios: "El Señor se sienta entronizado sobre el diluvio.". Hemos encontrado el lugar donde se revela Dios.

Así como la semana pasada celebramos la revelación de Dios en la Epifanía de Jesús, hoy, en las aguas, estamos en presencia de la Santísima Trinidad: el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo se manifiestan juntos mientras Nuestro mundo se transforma en el lugar donde Dios habita: ya no es un terreno extraño alejado de la luz de la salvación, ahora Dios se revela entre nosotros.

Al santiguarnos con agua bendita al entrar en la Iglesia, podemos recordar que también nosotros somos templos del Señor, lavados en las mismas aguas que hacen al Señor gobernante de nuestras vidas con poder. Jesús ahora se revela públicamente; nosotros también podemos vivir abiertamente en su gracia.

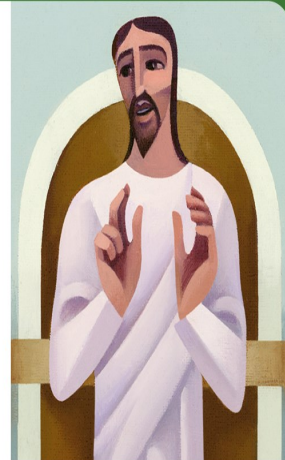

Q What happens in a session for candidates?

A Needs will differ; each candidate's situation must be evaluated to determine the formation that would be most helpful. A candidate's baptism must be honored, since it makes them part of our household even though they are not fully initiated. Depending on their catechetical needs, they might participate in sessions with the catechumens and participate in some of the rites. They would not participate in rites belonging only to the unbaptized such as the scrutinies. If the candidates have been living an active Christian faith, their preparation would be briefer and address specific Catholic doctrines and practices not held in common with other faith traditions.

In your planning you can choose readings, songs, celebrant, etc. Remember, a funeral Mass is not a "celebration of life"; rather, it is a primarily a prayer for the dead. It is a time to pray for the soul of the deceased and to give mourners the grace to endure and hope.

Putting your wishes in writing is like leaving a last gift to your family.

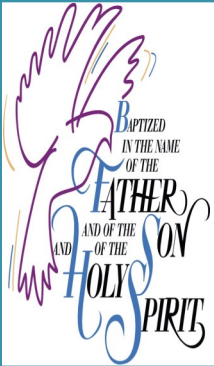

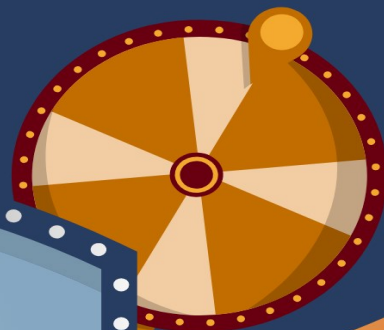
