PASTORS CORNER

His flock is the term our Psalm today uses for us, the People of God: "We are his people: the sheep of his flock." In our first reading Moses says we are God's special possession, and in the gospel when Jesus sees the crowd it says he sees them as sheep without a shepherd—the flock image again.

A flock is not an image we readily call to mind in our daily imagination, even less in reference to ourselves. Atomization is the trend today, each individual separating away from everyone else—the college student moving away from home and beginning an independent life, which increasingly appears more and more isolated. Even within the family we are losing our community, having fewer and fewer children, the old dynamics of marriage and siblings slowly evaporating.

The flock in contrast is a tight knit band (although knitting is actually what you do with the sheep's wool later). The sheep are easily identifiable as being of the same kind, and in Jesus' descriptions, they've formed a tight bond with their shepherd as well.

Who belongs to your flock? Would you see yourself as primarily alone? Are there family, friends, or coworkers who form a part of your story?

Is the parish of Saint Isidore a place where you recognize your brothers and sisters? Do you recognize that we have been called together, that God is bringing grace into your life through others, and they receive blessing through you?

In the decades of our parish's existence, many have given whole-heartedly, generously expending themselves for the flourishing of their loved ones. Sometimes we hear this gift of self referred to as gifts of Time, Talent and Treasure—ways that we support the building of God's people.

The Church gives to us our readings each week to form us into who we are meant to be: can we allow the Scriptures today to draw us in a new direction, into deeper connection with each other? Can we recognize that we belong?

REFLEXIÓN DEL PASTOR

«Su rebaño» es el término que utiliza el salmo de hoy para referirse a nosotros, el Pueblo de Dios: «Somos su pueblo, las ovejas de su rebaño». En la primera lectura, Moisés dice que somos la posesión especial de Dios, y en el Evangelio, cuando Jesús ve a la multitud, se dice que las ve como ovejas sin pastor: de nuevo, la imagen del rebaño.

Un rebaño no es una imagen que nos venga fácilmente a la mente en nuestra imaginación cotidiana, y menos aún en referencia a nosotros mismos. La atomización es la tendencia actual, cada individuo separándose de todos los demás: el estudiante universitario que se marcha de casa y comienza una vida independiente, que cada vez parece más y más aislada. Incluso dentro de la familia estamos perdiendo nuestra comunidad, teniendo cada vez menos hijos, mientras las antiguas dinámicas del matrimonio y los hermanos se desvanecen lentamente.

El rebaño, por el contrario, es un grupo muy unido (aunque tejer es en realidad lo que se hace después con la lana de las ovejas). Las ovejas son fácilmente identificables como de la misma especie y, en las descripciones de Jesús, también han formado un vínculo estrecho con su pastor.

¿Quiénes forman parte de tu rebaño? ¿Te ves a ti mismo principalmente solo? ¿Hay familiares, amigos o compañeros de trabajo que forman parte de tu historia?

¿Es la parroquia de San Isidoro un lugar donde reconoces a tus hermanos y hermanas? ¿Reconoces que hemos sido llamados a estar juntos, que Dios está trayendo la gracia a tu vida a través de los demás, y que ellos reciben bendiciones a través de ti?

A lo largo de las décadas de existencia de nuestra parroquia, muchos se han entregado de todo corazón, dedicándose generosamente al bienestar de sus seres queridos. A veces oímos referirse a esta entrega como los dones del tiempo, el talento y los bienes materiales: formas en las que contribuimos a la edificación del pueblo de Dios.

La Iglesia nos ofrece cada semana las lecturas para formarnos en lo que estamos llamados a ser: ¿podemos dejar que las Escrituras de hoy nos lleven por un nuevo camino, hacia una conexión más profunda entre nosotros? ¿Podemos reconocer que pertenecemos a este lugar?

Q When we worship together, why are we often called an *assembly*? How is a liturgical assembly different than any other sort of audience gathered for a public event?

A Humans are social creatures, and we gather together for a variety of purposes, such as to work or to witness an event. The Church tells us that when we gather for worship, something special happens: we are no longer just a crowd, but a liturgical assembly. When we gather for prayer, we become something more than the sum of our parts: we are the Body of Christ. The Church teaches that Christ is present at the Mass in four ways: in the priest celebrant, in the Word of God proclaimed, in a special way in the sacrament of Christ's Body and Blood, and in the assembly gathered for prayer. Truly, "where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them" (Matthew 18:20).

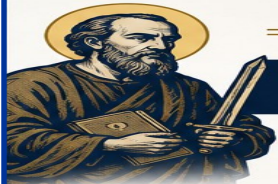
