

PASTOR'S CORNER

But why spit?

Even the blind man himself, when he recounts the miracle Jesus did, describes the mud on his eyes, but doesn't mention (didn't know?) what was mixed with the dirt.

With all of Jesus' other miracles, Jesus speaks, perhaps he lays hands on the person, but here he looks like a 3 year old making mud pies.

And of course, that image recalls a long ago moment. It was his dad at the creation of the universe, who also sat down in the dirt and formed something from mud.

Back then, it was when God had created a wondrous garden filled with delightful things, that he takes clay, forms the first human, and then breathes his spirit into him.

But in Jewish tradition, they recognized that dust on its own doesn't mold well. So together with the breath that God breathes into man's nostrils, they recognized that God's spit (in the rest of the Bible, the Holy Spirit is often described as water) is mixed with the dust to make it moldable.

God as creator puts himself into his beloved creation. The human person, created in God's image and likeness, is revealed as God's child. Genesis 5 echoes this when the birth of Seth is announced as being a child in Adam's image and in his likeness.

So when Jesus uses spit and mixes clay, when he smears mud on the blind man's eyes, he is revealing himself not as physician only, but as the original creator. He's the one who made us in the first place as God, and he has authority to remake us.

Be recreated. God made you, calling you into existence. Now he wants to remake you, calling you from darkness into light.

REFLEXIÓN DEL PASTOR

¿Pero para qué escupir?

Incluso el propio ciego, cuando relata el milagro que hizo Jesús, describe el lodo en sus ojos, pero no menciona (¿no sabía?) qué se mezcló con la tierra.

Con todos los demás milagros de Jesús, Jesús habla, quizá pone las manos sobre la persona, pero aquí parece un niño de 3 años haciendo pasteles de lodo.

Y, por supuesto, esa imagen recuerda a un momento lejano. Fue su padre en la creación del universo, quien también se sentó en la tierra y formó algo a partir del lodo.

En aquel entonces, fue cuando Dios creó un jardín maravilloso lleno de cosas deliciosas, cuando toma lodo, forma al primer humano y luego le infunde su espíritu.

Pero en la tradición judía, reconocieron que el polvo por sí solo no se moldea bien. Así que, junto con el aliento que Dios sopla en las fosas nasales del hombre, reconocieron que la saliva de Dios (en el resto de la Biblia, el Espíritu Santo suele describirse como agua) se mezcla con el polvo para hacerla moldeable.

Dios, como creador, se pone a sí mismo en su amada creación. La persona humana, creada a imagen y semejanza de Dios, se revela como hija de Dios. Génesis 5 hace eco de esto cuando se anuncia el nacimiento de Set, como un hijo a imagen de Adán y conforme a su semejanza."

Así que cuando Jesús usa saliva y mezcla lodo, cuando unta lodo en los ojos del ciego, se revela no solo como médico, sino como el creador original. El es quien nos hizo en primer lugar como Dios, y tiene autoridad para rehacernos.

Ser recreado. Dios te hizo, llamándote a la existencia. Ahora quiere rehacerte, llamándote de la oscuridad a la luz.

St. Vincent de Paul

The St. Isidore Conference of Saint Vincent de Paul is dedicated to serving all families in Sutter County regardless of their religious affiliation, race, or ethnicity. We help those who need assistance with food, rent, utilities, furniture and household goods.

Our food locker provides both fresh and non-perishable food once a month. Over the past year, we have served 1600 families with food, 137 families with rent and utility assistance, 200 with furniture, and 240 with household goods.

We are staffed only by volunteers. Currently we have about 30 members who come on a rotating basis. The various jobs include helping at the food locker (including translation), furniture delivery, home visit teams of 2 to assist with financial aid, and sorting donations.

Volunteers come according to the time they are available and their interests. Since the food locker is open 2 hours per day, 3 days a week, any other work is done when needed.

We are very grateful for the generosity of our parishioners and invite you to visit the Food Locker for a tour, for more information, or (hopefully) to volunteer.

The building is open Tues-Thurs from 9:15-11:15, but we would be happy to have you come by appointment. The phone is (530) 671-5154.



Q What happens at the
Rite of Election or
Enrollment of Names?



A On the First Sunday of
Lent, the Church celebrates
this rite with the catechumens.

It is celebrated at the diocesan cathedral during Mass or
a Liturgy of the Word. After the homily, the catechumens
are presented to the bishop. As their names are called,
the catechumens may stand in their place or move into
the sanctuary near the bishop so the assembly can see them.
Once they are called, the bishop questions the godparents
and the assembly to ensure the catechumens' readiness
to be admitted to the sacraments of initiation. Then the
bishop invites the catechumens to inscribe their name in
the Book of the Elect. After everyone has signed the book,
the bishop declares the catechumens to be members of the
elect, who will celebrate initiation at the next Easter Vigil.
The liturgy continues with intercessions for the elect,
a special prayer over them, and a dismissal.
