PASTOR'S CORNER

How often do you have to state your current address? When you're giving directions for a friend to come visit? When you're filling out a form at the doctor's office or the DMV?

How long have you lived at your current residence? Have you been your home for the past 27 years? Are you renting an apartment you expect to move out of this summer?

To be human is to exist in a place—even if you're homeless, that forms a part of defining who you are. Leaving home for the first time as a college student or a young adult is a major transition; beginning to share a home with a spouse when you get married is another.

Does your current home feel like home? A significant part of that dynamic depends on how long you've lived there—but that's not the only factor.

Our feast day today brings the question of our home address to the fore. Before Jesus' passion, death and resurrection, earth was our only home before we faded into the shadow of death. But then the Son of God arrived as our brother, a human being like us—and when his time here concluded, he ascended into heaven.

For the first time in the history of humanity, a human being entered into eternal glory. Elijah and Enoch had departed this world without dying in the Old Testament, but the Church recognizes that heaven still wasn't accessible before Jesus' blood was shed.

But now that the first human has entered heaven, we see Jesus' mother swiftly following, as we celebrate her assumption body and soul into heaven. And it becomes apparent that God's intention for his children is very different from what we knew back in the days before Jesus.

Jesus descended to earth so that we could ascend to heaven. The true home of every baptized person is before the face of the Living God: our time here is a temporary—momentary—preparation.

Can you feel the Holy Spirit stirring in your heart? God's longing is to lift your soul to heaven today; we participate in the liturgy today, we pray daily, we receive the Bread of Heaven, so that even here and now we recognize that our true home is in the presence of God.

Already today your true zip code is found with the angels and the saints. While we still have a stretch to spend here on earth, allow today's feast day to reconfirm in your soul your heavenly identity.

REFLEXIÓN DEL PASTOR

¿Con qué frecuencia tienes que indicar tu dirección actual? ¿Cuándo das indicaciones para que un amigo venga a visitarte? ¿Cuándo llenas un formulario en la consulta del médico o en el DMV?

¿Cuánto tiempo llevas viviendo en tu residencia actual? ¿Has sido tu hogar durante los últimos 27 años? ¿Estás alquilando un piso del que esperas mudarte este verano?

Ser humano es existir en un lugar—aunque seas una persona sin hogar, eso forma parte de definir quién eres. Salir de casa por primera vez como estudiante universitario o joven es una transición importante; Empezar a compartir casa con un cónyuge cuando te casas es otra.

¿Tu casa actual se siente como un hogar? Una parte importante de esa dinámica depende de cuánto tiempo hayas vivido allí, pero ese no es el único factor.

Nuestra fiesta de hoy pone en primer plano la cuestión de nuestra dirección de casa. Antes de la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Jesús, la tierra era nuestro único hogar antes de que nos desvaneciéramos en la sombra de la muerte. Pero entonces llegó el Hijo de Dios como nuestro hermano, un ser humano como nosotros—y cuando su tiempo aquí terminó, ascendió al cielo.

Por primera vez en la historia de la humanidad, un ser humano entró en la gloria eterna. Elías y Enoc habían partido de este mundo sin morir en el Antiguo Testamento, pero la Iglesia reconoce que el cielo aún no era accesible antes de que se derramara la sangre de Jesús.

Pero ahora que el primer ser humano ha entrado en el cielo, vemos a la madre de Jesús siguiéndolo rápidamente, mientras celebramos su ascensión cuerpo y alma hacia el cielo. Y se hace evidente que la intención de Dios para sus hijos es muy diferente de lo que conocíamos en los días anteriores a Jesús.

Jesús descendió a la tierra para que pudiéramos ascender al cielo. El verdadero hogar de toda persona bautizada está ante la faz del Dios Viviente: nuestro tiempo aquí es una preparación temporal—momentánea—.

¿Puedes sentir el Espíritu Santo agitándose en tu corazón? El anhelo de Dios es elevar tu alma al cielo hoy; participamos hoy en la liturgia, rezamos a diario, recibimos el Pan del Cielo, para que incluso aquí y ahora reconozcamos que nuestro verdadero hogar está en la presencia de Dios.

Ya hoy tu verdadero código postal se encuentra con los ángeles y los santos. Aunque aún nos queda un buen rato aquí en la tierra, permite que la fiesta de hoy reconfirme en tu alma tu identidad celestial.

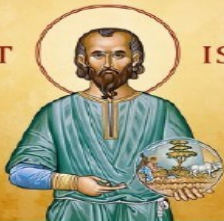
