Pastor's Corner

What is Jesus' favorite theme in the Gospel of Matthew? Today as with so many previous Sundays this year, Jesus speaks to us about the Kingdom of Heaven. While it's home for him, and the thing he wants to introduce into our lives, he knows that so many of this kingdom's dynamics are foreign to us, and will take us a while to discover. Like we hear in our first reading today, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are my ways your ways, says the Lord."

One thing they don't seem to be good at in the Kingdom of Heaven is basic math. Terrifying accountants everywhere, Jesus describes payroll, with part time employees getting as much as the folks with double overtime.

What is Jesus trying to draw us into, besides flunking second grade math? As a comparison, we're familiar with the limitations of our first nine months of life. Before we're born, our five senses don't register much. We can't imagine strawberries or sunsets, puppies or pianos because they exist on spectra we haven't experienced yet.

The little baby is a real person before being born, but hasn't experienced much yet. Jesus knows us the same way: we're real people who truly exist, but we haven't experienced much yet. So many aspects of reality aren't accessible to us in our current level of existence.

Jesus knows there is so much abundance in reality, and that our current vision is so constrained. So he uses parables to try to awaken our imagination, to try to invite us into a new way of living, a new freedom today. Are you ready to discover the Kingdom of Heaven?

Reflexión del Pastor

¿Cuál es el tema favorito de Jesús en el Evangelio de Mateo? Hoy, como tantos otros domingos de este año, Jesús nos habla del Reino de los Cielos. Aunque para él es su hogar y lo que quiere introducir en nuestras vidas, sabe que muchas de las dinámicas de este reino nos son ajenas y tardaremos en descubrirlas. Como oímos en nuestra primera lectura de hoy: "Porque mis pensamientos no son vuestros pensamientos, ni mis caminos vuestros caminos, dice el Señor".

Una cosa en la que no parecen ser buenos en el Reino de los Cielos es en matemáticas básicas. Aterrorizando a los contables de todo el mundo, Jesús describe las nóminas, en las que los empleados a tiempo parcial cobran tanto como los que hacen horas extras dobles.

¿Qué es lo que Jesús está tratando de atraernos, además de reprobar matemáticas de segundo grado? A modo de comparación, estamos familiarizados con las limitaciones de nuestros primeros nueve meses de vida. Antes de nacer, nuestros cinco sentidos no registran gran cosa. No podemos imaginarnos fresas o puestas de sol, cachorros o pianos porque existen en espectros que aún no hemos experimentado.

El bebé es una persona real antes de nacer, pero aún no ha experimentado gran cosa. Jesús nos conoce del mismo modo: somos personas reales que existen de verdad, pero aún no hemos experimentado gran cosa. Muchos aspectos de la realidad no son accesibles para nosotros en nuestro nivel actual de existencia.

Jesús sabe que hay tanta abundancia en la realidad, y que nuestra visión actual es tan limitada. Por eso utiliza parábolas para intentar despertar nuestra imaginación, para intentar invitarnos a una nueva forma de vivir, a una nueva libertad hoy. ¿Estás preparado para descubrir el Reino de los Cielos?

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults

Q What is the right time of year for inquiry (the period of evangelization and precatechumenate)?



A Whenever a person is awakened to the Spirit's presence in his or her life and chooses to respond, the initiation process begins (*Order of Christian Initiation of Adults*, 1). This beginning is the first period of the process, the period of evangelization and precatechumenate, informally known as inquiry. So whenever a person is awakened and chooses to respond—that is the right time for inquiry. The rite envisions that a parish would be ready to accompany any adult who approaches the parish. Ideally, this time of inquiry is open throughout the year.

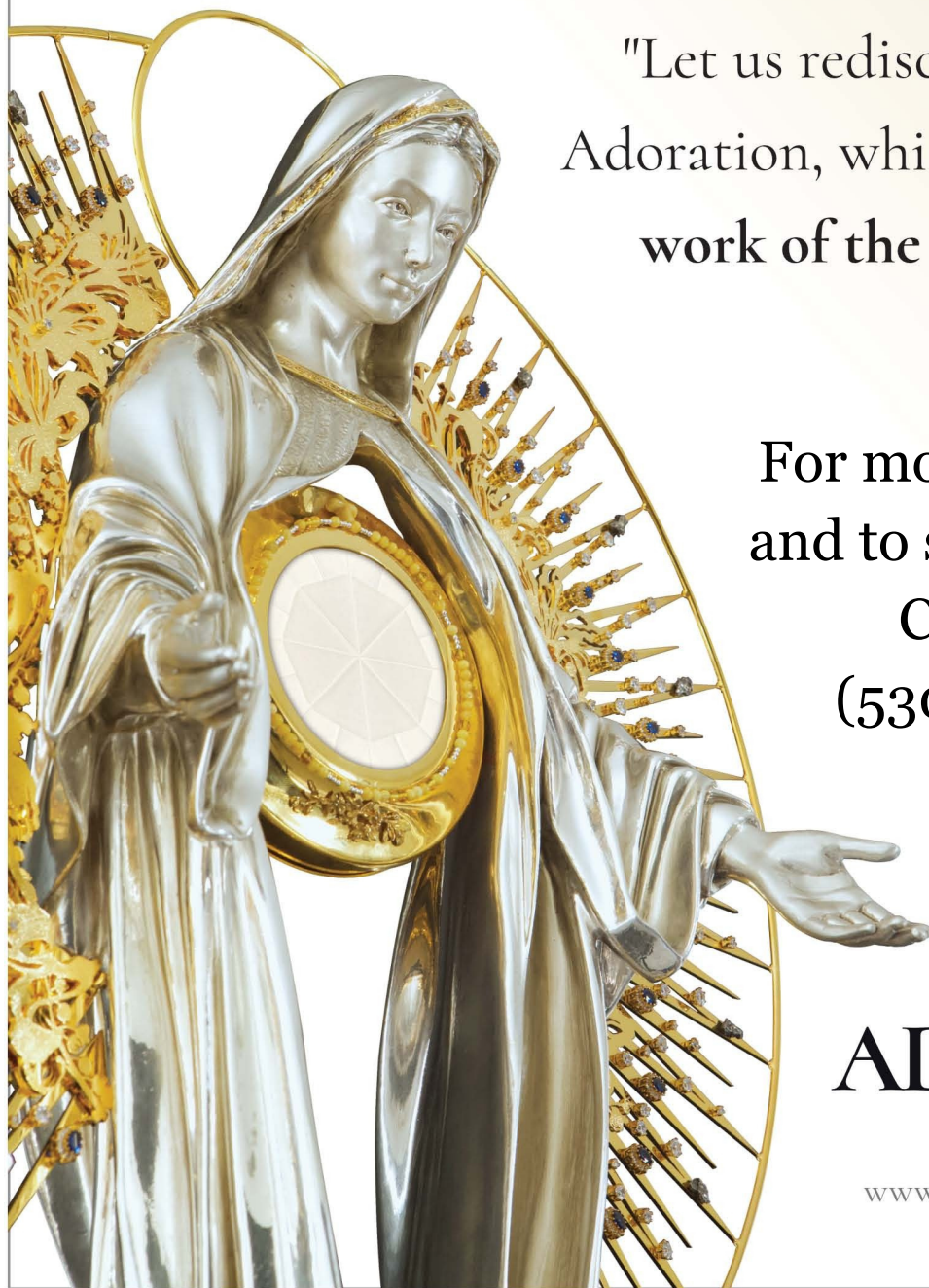
