



GOD'S WATCHERS

In the ancient world watchmen were extremely important people. They kept communities safe, and were there to alert them to any impending danger or attack. Before locks, alarms, and security systems, watchmen were the protectors, the safety measure. So when the Lord charges Ezekiel as a watchman today, it is a weighty charge. So weighty, we learn, that if Ezekiel fails to sound the alarm for those around him and they perish in a state of wickedness, Ezekiel will be held responsible! This profound connection between God's will on earth and in heaven is repeated in today's Gospel, where Jesus instructs us that we are to be the security force, the watchers placed on alert that nowhere in the Body of Christ, the church, will there be any two members of the one Body who are not reconciled. Scripture tells us that Jesus reconciled all things in heaven and on earth through the blood of his cross. But we are given the mission to continue that reconciliation on earth as in heaven through our ceaseless efforts to be, as Paul would write, ambassadors of reconciliation. Let us not get too comfortable thinking that we are responsible only for keeping our own lives from the path of wickedness and disagreement. We are also held accountable for the lives of the members of Christ's body around us.

CENTINELAS DE DIOS

En el mundo de la antigüedad los centinelas eran gente de gran importancia. Mantenían la seguridad de las comunidades y su deber era alertarles sobre cualquier peligro o ataque inminente. Antes de que hubiera cerrojos, sistemas de alarma y seguridad, los centinelas eran los protectores, la medida de seguridad. Así que cuando hoy el Señor le encarga a Ezequiel ser centinela, es un cargo de peso. Tan pesado, se nos hace conocer, que si Ezequiel falla y no da la voz de alarma a los que le rodean y ellos mueren en estado de maldad, ¡Ezequiel será el responsable! Este profundo vínculo entre la voluntad de Dios en la tierra y en el cielo se repite en el Evangelio de hoy, donde Jesús nos instruye que tenemos que ser la fuerza de seguridad, los centinelas colocados en estado de alerta para que, en ninguna parte del Cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia, haya dos miembros del único Cuerpo que no estén reconciliados. La Sagrada Escritura nos dice que Jesús reconcilió todas las cosas en el cielo y en la tierra mediante la sangre de su cruz. Pero se nos da la misión de continuar esa reconciliación en la tierra por medio de nuestros incessantes esfuerzos de ser, como escribiera Pablo, embajadores de reconciliación. No nos quedemos muy cómodos pensando que nuestra única responsabilidad es mantenernos fuera del camino de la maldad y la discordia. También hemos de responder por la vida de los miembros de Cristo que nos rodean.

Oh, that today you would hear his voice.

Our responsorial Psalm at Mass today is well known by the Church because she prays it each morning in her *Invitatory*, the first prayers of the day. Psalm 95 is prayed each morning around the world wherever the Catholic community is present, beginning with places like Fiji and New Zealand and ending with us in California, living on the edge of the Western World.

Oh, that today you would hear his voice. This plea from millennia ago rings loudly today as the grace God intends for us floods out, but we risk oblivion by missing completely the blessing he wants to share.

Oh, that today you would hear his voice. The Psalm continues remembering those before us who could not repent in time, who chose the things that rejected God: "Harden not your hearts as at Meribah, as in the day of Massah in the desert, where your fathers tempted me; they tested me though they had seen my works." Our Psalm is talking about the generation that knew God best, the generation that had seen the ten plagues in Egypt and had walked through the Red Sea with the water like a wall to their right and to their left. Nevertheless, when under pressure in the desert, they decided they knew better than God, and shut him out.

For us, everything is on the line: hearing God means life, shutting him out means death. Like passengers asleep in the terminal, if we sleep through the boarding call, we'll awaken to discover we've missed what we were waiting for. Ezekiel in our first reading describes for us one of the ways God can call out to us: "You, son of man, I have appointed watchman for the house of Israel; when you hear me say anything, you shall warn them for me." God can put a word of warning into the mouth of a brother or sister. In particular, he can choose a spokesman like a prophet, his designated mouthpiece.

Jesus points to the urgency of this voice when he places this call on each one of us: "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone." This warning is so important, however, that Jesus places it ultimately in the Church, repeating his words from two Sundays ago: "whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." With the Church, this word of warning, this correction, is so powerful in Jesus' eyes, that what the Church mandates on earth is mandated in heaven, what the Church forgives on earth is forgiven in heaven.

Oh, that today you would hear his voice. Jesus knows how urgently we need correction, and how likely it is we'll resist it. Together with the Church around the world, we can daily make this prayer our own: "If today you hear his voice, harden not your heart."

Nuestro Salmo responsorial de hoy es muy bien conocido por la Iglesia acabo de que lo reza cada mañana en su *invitatorio*, los primeros rezos del día. El Salmo 95 es rezado cada mañana en todos los rincones del mundo doquiera que se encuentre la comunidad católica, empezando en lugares como Fiji y Nueva Zelanda y terminando con nosotros en California, viviendo al borde del Mundo Occidental.

Ojalá pudieran hoy oír su voz. Esta plegaria de milenarios atrás resuena fuerte hoy al disminuirse la gracia que Dios nos destina, pero corremos el riesgo del abismo al errar por completo las bendiciones que Dios nos ofrece.

Ojalá pudieran hoy oír su voz. El Salmo continúa recordando aquellos que no se arrepintieron a tiempo y escogieron las cosas que repulsa a Dios. "*No endurezcan sus corazones como en Meriba, como en el día de Masa en el desierto, allí me desafiaron sus padres y me tentaron, aunque veían mis obras.*" Este Salmo nos habla de la generación que más conoció a Dios, la generación que vio las Diez Plagas en Egipto y aquellos que caminaron por el Mar Rojo con paredes de agua a su izquierda y derecha. Sin embargo, cuando bajo presión en el desierto decidieron que sabían más que Dios y los hicieron al lado.

Para nosotros todo está a en la raya: el escuchar a Dios significa vida, el darle la espalda, la muerte. Como pasajeros durmiendo en la terminal, si seguimos durmiendo durante el anuncio de abordar, al despertar descubriremos que hemos perdido lo tanto esperábamos.

En la primera lectura de hoy Ezequiel nos describe una de las maneras en que Dios nos habla: "Hijo de hombre, te he puesto como un vigía para la casa de Israel: si oyés una palabra que salga de mi boca, inmediatamente se lo advertirás de mi parte." Dios os puede poner una palabra de aviso a la boca de un hermano o hermana. En particular puede elejir un portavoz como un profeta, su portavoz designado.

Jesus nos hace tomar nota de la urgencia en su voz cuando nos hace el llamado a cada uno de nosotros: "Si tu hermano llega a pecar, vete y repréndele, a solas tú con él." Este aviso es tan importante, que, no obstante, Jesús al final le otorga este aviso a la Iglesia, repitiendo sus palabras de hace dos Domingos; "Yo os aseguro: todo lo que atéis en la tierra quedará atado en el cielo, y todo lo que desatéis en la tierra quedará desatado en el cielo." Con la Iglesia, esta palabra de aviso, esta corrección es tan poderosa en los ojos de Jesús, que lo que la Iglesia manda en la tierra en mandato el cielo, lo que la Iglesia perdone en la tierra es perdonado en el Cielo. Ojalá pudieran hoy oír su voz. Jesús conoce nuestra urgente necesidad de corrección, y que tan probable lo resistiremos. Juntos con la Iglesia por todo el mundo, podemos hacer este rezo nuestro: "Oh, sí escucháis hoy su voz, No endurezcáis vuestro corazón "




